STUDENT ROLES AT BSB

Library Helpers (Year 3-6)

Library Helpers assist with the smooth running of our school library by organising books, shelving returned books, helping keep the space organised, and encouraging other students to engage with reading resources during break and lunch times. Students regularly share their recommended reads in the BSB Buzz Newsletter.

Playground Monitors (Year 1-6)

Playground Monitors ensure that our outdoor play areas are safe, inclusive, and enjoyable for all. They help organise games between students and classes, support peers, and act as friendly role models during break times by reminding their peers to look after the equipment and return items to the correct places after using them.

Classroom Roles (Reception - Year 6)

Each class has its own system of rotating responsibilities, such as line leaders, equipment managers, eco monitors, and digital assistants. These roles build everyday leadership skills and allow students to contribute meaningfully to their learning environment.

How Students Are Chosen

Students are selected through a combination of teacher nominations and student applications, depending on the role. This process ensures that leadership is inclusive, fair, and based on character, commitment, and potential. All students in leadership roles receive guidance and support from staff mentors. They take part in regular meetings where they can reflect on their impact, plan upcoming events, and develop leadership, teamwork, and communication skills.

PROJECT BASED LEARNING



Project Based Learning (PBL) is an innovative approach to teaching and learning that provides students with the opportunity to engage in real-world, authentic tasks that promote critical thinking, collaboration, and creativity.

COMMUNICATION

E-Mail

The school email is our primary channel for official communication with parents. It is used to share important information regarding finances, school events, appointments, holiday reminders, and general office updates. Parents will also receive emails about extracurricular activities, school bus arrangements, school lunches, and any changes or notices relevant to their child's daily school experience. This ensures clear, consistent, and timely communication between the school and families. School letters are sent out by email to parent's registered accounts.

Welcome Back Letters

Class letters from teachers are sent out at the beginning of each term and again at half term. These newsletters provide parents with an overview of the topics and skills their child will be learning in class, as well as any key dates, special projects, or activities planned for the term. They serve as a valuable communication tool to help parents stay connected to their child's learning journey and support learning at home.

Google Classroom

At BSB, we use Google Classroom to support learning by sharing assignments, resources, and class updates, making it easy for students and parents to stay organised and informed. Communication with teachers is directed through Google Classroom via the Google Stream or e-Contact form, which serves as the main platform for sharing class information, updates, and messages between parents, students, and teachers. This helps keep all classroom-related communication organised and ensures a prompt response.

Class Updates

During the term, the Parents' Portal features brief updates from the teacher outlining what is being covered in class. These notes provide parents with a clear snapshot of the learning focus, helping them stay informed and engaged with their child's education. Additionally, class teachers will post a biweekly updates highlighting the topics being taught and upcoming events.

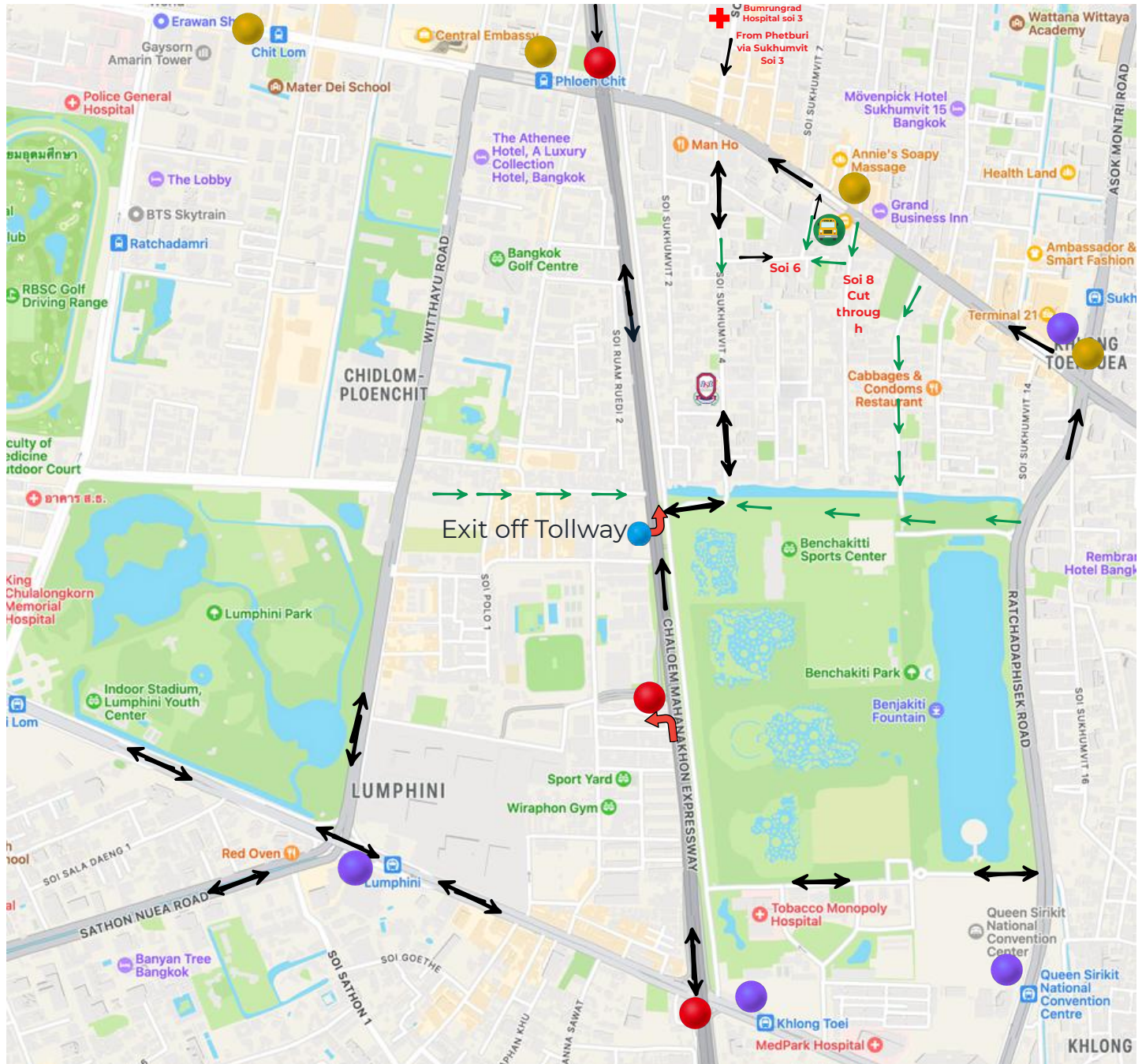
