FOUNDATIONS FOR LIFELONG LEARNING

Preceding their first day as Falcons, freshmen attend a comprehensive, community-building retreat designed to form friendships, encourage academic interest, and prepare them for the transition to high school.

Support continues throughout the academic year, with resources like our newly designed “Learning How to Learn” course. Required for all freshmen, this course tackles the neuroscience behind learning, introducing students to higher-level thinking tools, personal learning systems, and the power of collaborative learning.

Counselors deliver grade-specific curriculum during homeroom, offering tailored resources for navigating high school. Freshmen seeking academic assistance may visit the library for peer tutoring, connecting with experienced 10th through 12th-grade students who excel in various subjects. Teachers are available during academic flex periods and before and after school.

Our proactive educational approach empowers students to be self-directed, lifelong learners and strong advocates for their own success.

Lasallian education empowers students to discover their strengths and talents, inspiring them to use those gifts to serve the world. 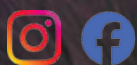
