SUNDERLAND & DISTRICT BOWLING ASSOCIATION

RULES & CONSTITUTION

(changes at A.G.M. 2025 are highlighted)

1. TITLE

The Association shall be called "Sunderland & District Bowling Association"

2. CONSTITUTION

The Association shall consist of, Hon Secretary, Asst Hon Secretary (Leagues), Asst Hon Secretary (Competitions) Hon Treasurer, Hon Life Members and clubs playing in Sunderland & District

3. OBJECTS

The objects of the Association shall be to promote, foster and safeguard the amateur game of bowls in every legitimate way and to encourage the growth of the game by holding various competitions in Sunderland & District

4. MEMBERSHIP

Membership to the Sunderland & District Bowling Association is open to all genders. It is a requirement of all clubs in membership of the Sunderland & District Bowling Association participating in it's leagues, competitions, representative and friendly matches, that the club and all of their playing members playing in the Sunderland & District Association must be affiliated members of "BOWLS DURHAM & BOWLS ENGLAND"

Clubs wishing to enter the Association shall make formal application to the Association Secretary in writing and the Annual General Meeting shall decide by a majority of votes whether or not they shall be accepted as members.

Application for new membership must be made before November 1st and must be accompanied by an entrance fee of £10 together with the first Annual Subscription to the Association. A club shall not compete in any league or tournament promoted by another governing body until it has fulfilled its obligations to this Association

4a. No player playing in the Earl Cup, Swan Cup, Storey Bowl, Harold Howey Trophy, Silver Jacks, Burkett Shield, or Inter - Club K.O. Triples, for any club must not play in the Club Championship or Veterans Club Championship for any other club.

ADMINISTRATION

The affairs of the Association shall be conducted by an Executive Council which will consist of a Chairperson, Hon Secretary, Hon Assistant Secretary (Leagues) Hon Assistant Secretary (Competitions) and Hon Treasurer, together with three members from clubs elected at each Annual General Meeting. All Officers will be elected for a two year term after which will be up for re-election. The Council shall meet as often as the business of the Association demands, and shall have full power to decide on any matter affecting the Association that may arise.

5b. The Tour Secretary and the Assistant Tour Secretary to be ex-officio members of the Executive.

6. The Annual Subscription fees and all Competition fees to be decided at the Annual General Meeting. Any club withdrawing from one or more of the Competitions (Earl Cup, Swan Cup, Storey Bowl or Veterans Trophy's) subsequent to declaring at the Annual General Meeting their intention to participate in one or more of the said competitions shall be fined a minimum of £10.00 in respect of each withdrawal. Subscriptions shall be paid to the Treasurer by April 1st, clubs failing to do so will have their membership terminated forth with.

6b. Any club failing to fulfil an AWAY fixture due to lack of players available have to reimburse the home club the relevant rink fees

6c. All teams must pay the full amount of the relevant rink fees to the HOME club regardless of how many players they have available.

7. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

The Annual General Meeting of the Association shall be held in November for the purpose of receiving the report of the Secretary, Assistant Secretary (Leagues), Assistant Secretary (Competitions), Treasurer and Auditors; to deal with applications for membership; to decide on what lines the various competitions for the next season shall be carried out; the election of officers and for the transaction of any other competent business. **Each club can send two representatives but will only have ONE VOTE** and act on behalf of their club.

Special General Meeting of the Association shall be called by the Secretary on receipt of a requisition signed by twelve member clubs or by the Executive Council, fourteen days notice shall be given of all such meetings. Any proposal to amend or rescind any of the foregoing rule(s) or bye-law(s) shall be given in writing to the Association Secretary not later than 15th September, and copies of such proposals shall be sent to all clubs within 14 days of that date. If at the Annual General Meeting a majority of those present vote in favour, the rules(s) or bye-law(s) shall be amended or rescinded accordingly or at any Special General Meeting.

8. AUDIT

The accounts shall be audited yearly by two members of clubs within the Association appointed at the Annual General Meeting.

9. TROPHIES

At the holder's expense, Trophies must be returned at the A.G.M. Trophy winners to be responsible for having Trophy engraved. All competition winners must take the appropriate trophy OR they will forfeit any prize money attached to that competition

10. At the discretion of the Competition Secretary players may be required to use bowls stickers supplied by the Association to distinguish the bowls for the marker or spectators

11. DRESS CODE

All league games and Association Competitions, dress for all team players shall be white or club colours above the waist, trousers or shorts or skirts to be grey OR black with correct bowling shoes. In knock-out Competition finals players will wear **black or grey** trousers, shorts or skirts or registered club colour's plus the above rule for shirts.

12. TRIAL ENDS

Clubs to have the following options – Play 2 trial ends, Play 1 trial end, Play no trial ends – however both clubs must agree, if they don't agree then the rule defaults back to Play 2 trial ends.

13. In the Earl Cup, Swan Cup, Storey Bowl or the Harold Howey Trophy, any club that declares it cannot get a team on the programme date, forfeits the points and they are awarded to the other club.

14. DISSOLUTION

If at any General Meeting a resolution for the dissolution of the Association is passed by a simple majority of club representatives present, such resolution shall be considered at a Special General Meeting held no later than 28 days thereafter. The resolution must be passed by two thirds majority of the club representatives present and voting . The Executive shall then or at any future date specified in the resolution wind up the affairs of the Association. Any assets remaining after the satisfaction of any proper debts and liabilities shall be charged towards charitable purposes for the benefit of residents in the immediate locality.

15. DISCIPLINARY REGULATIONS/MISCONDUCT/EXPULSION AND SUSPENSION OF MEMBERSHIP

It shall be competent to the Executive Committee after due investigation of the facts, and, if need be, the examination of witnesses and relevant documentary evidence, to suspend or determine the membership of any club or individual, but such club or individual shall have a right of Appeal to Sunderland & District Bowling Association against an adverse decision. The Appeal must be lodged with the Honorary Secretary of Sunderland & District within 21 days of the Executive Committee's decision and so far as a club is concerned is signed by its office bearers. Such Appeal shall state the grounds on which it is made. For this process the Association will adopt the Bowls England Disciplinary Regulations then pertaining as set out in Bowls England Regulation No 9, or any other subsequent Regulation thereof and these shall be used in all cases considered by Sunderland & District Bowling Association.

16. PROTECTION OF CHILDREN AND VULNERABLE ADULTS

Sunderland & District Bowling Association is committed to promoting a safe environment in which children and vulnerable adults can enjoy participating in the game of bowls. It acknowledges that it has responsibilities under child protection and disabled persons legislation. It will seek to underpin and fulfil these responsibilities by following and promoting the children and vulnerable adult's protection policies and regulations of Bowls England as detailed in its Rules and Regulations.

17. PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

All clubs within the Sunderland & District Bowling Association must adopt the Players Code of Conduct as stated in 17a.

17a CONDUCT AND DISCIPLINE

Players are expected to conduct themselves in a manner that will not be prejudicial to the reputation of the Association.

Players must demonstrate good manners, courtesy, language and consideration and abide by the etiquette policy at all times. There will be NO SMOKING or VAPEING on the Bowling Green during play.

Allegations of Misconduct

Complaints, concerns and allegations of misconduct must be made in writing OR E-Mail to the Association Secretary who will acknowledge receipt of the allegations within 24 hours.

If it is deemed that the complaint is a minor misdemeanour then the club concerned will be expected to address the matter and issued with a warning. If the matter is not addressed by the club then the Association will convene a meeting with the club to discuss the situation.

If the matter is still not addressed the procedures set out within the Association's Rules and Regulations and Bowls England Regulation No 9 will be implemented. Sunderland Bowling Association will abide by the Rules and Regulations laid down by Bowls Durham and Bowls England, including Disciplinary Regulation 9. However in such an event the Association will ensure that natural justice procedures are in place to replicate such appeals procedures.

Bye – Laws Governing the Ald George Swan Cup and the Earl Cup competitions

1. The method of playing the various competitions, i.e. in divisions or on Tournament lines, will be decided by the previous Annual General Meeting.

2. Teams in 4 x 4 rinks league shall consist of four rinks of four players, each player playing two bowls. Each game limited to 18 ends.

All matches to start at 6.30pm. All matches played up to and including the 17th May to be 15 ends.

All Matches after 17th May up to and including 7th August to be 18 ends. All Matches after 7th August to revert to 15 ends

The total scores of all the respective rinks shall decide the contest. Three points shall be awarded for a win, and one point awarded for each winning rink on either side, making a maximum of seven points in all. Rinks finishing with level scores, shall be awarded half a point each. Should a match end in a tie, by reason of the total scores of the respective rinks being level then one and a half points shall be awarded to each club, and one point for each winning rinks, but rinks finishing with level scores, shall be awarded half a point each. A player must be a bona-fide member of the club for which they are representing

2a. Teams in 3 x 4 rinks league shall also consist of three rinks of four players, each playing two bowls. Three points shall be awarded for a win, and one point awarded for each winning rink on either side, making a total of six points. All other details stated in rule 2 will apply to rule 2a

3. Any club not having a full team may play one player short in any rink, the first and second players playing three bowls each; but one fourth of the total shots scored by such rink or rinks shall be deducted from the score at the end of the game.

4. The failure of a team to appear at its scheduled match shall cause the side at fault to forfeit the maximum points to the opposing side and render itself liable to a maximum fine of £10.

5. If fewer than twelve players in the 4 x 4 rinks or nine players in the 3 x 4 rinks appear on either side, the side at fault shall be held as "Failed to appear"

6. 4 x 4 rink The introduction of an ineligible player shall cause the offending side to forfeit the match together with an additional deduction of seven points plus a fine of £10.00 if both sides be party to such an infringement the game shall be null and void. Both clubs shall have an additional seven points deducted and a fine of £10.00 each imposed.

6a. 3 x 4 rink The introduction of an ineligible player shall cause the offending side to forfeit the match together with an additional deduction of six points plus a fine of £10.00 if both sides be party to such an infringement the game shall be null and void. Both clubs shall have an additional seven points deducted and a fine of £10.00 each imposed. A player transferring from one club to another during the season, shall not be eligible to play for his new club in any competition.

6b. Any player holding membership of two or more clubs shall be allowed to play for two clubs but only one club per cup competition

7. The Executive Council shall have full power to act in matters relating to Bye-Laws 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6.

8. If and when a competition is played in two or more divisions, the team in each division having the highest number of points shall be declared the winner of that division. In case of a tie in the number of points, and the ratio of shots for and against being equal, a deciding match shall be played on a neutral green.

9. All matches to commence not later than the times stated in current fixture list.

9b. Clubs have a 15 minute window for a player to arrive; if a sub has already played the trial ends then the late player cannot play.

Bye – Laws Governing the Ald George Swan Cup and the Earl Cup competitions (continued)

10. In case of a dispute, the respective Captains together shall decide, or have the power to call in an umpire.

11. For matches affected by unfavourable weather the following will apply - For 15 end games the minimum number of ends played per rink will be 12.

For 18 end games the minimum number of ends played per rink will be 15.

11a. Any fixture that has been cancelled and ultimately will decide either the league winners, promotion or relegation must be rearranged and played. All cancelled games to be played before 8th September. In the event of a dispute the Association League Secretary is empowered to fix a date for the match.

12. The order of players shall not be changed after the first end has been played. In the event of a player having to leave, a substitute from the same club may complete the game or the game shall be finished by the remaining players, the first and second players playing three bowls each, but one fourth of the shots scored by such rink or rinks from that stage of the game, shall be deducted from the total.

13. The Executive Council shall have full power to deal with any circumstances not provided for in these by-laws.

14. The home club shall submit the results of the matches via the Bowls Sunderland website and confirm that both captains agreed the result before leaving the venue. **All clubs must submit a list of players after each league fixture.**

By-laws Governing the Samuel Storey Bowl Competition

1. The team shall consist of four triples with each player playing three bowls. The game shall consist of eighteen ends and the total scores of the respective triples shall decide the contest. Three points will be awarded for a win and one point awarded for each winning triple on either side making a maximum of seven points. Triples finishing with level scores shall be awarded half a point each. Should a match end in a tie then each team will be awarded one and a half points. A player must be a bona fide member of the club for which he is playing.

2. Any club not having a full team may play one man short in any triple with each remaining player, playing with three bowls and the full triple using two bowls each (six bowls per side). One third of the score of the triple playing short must be deducted from the score at the end of the game.

2b. Clubs have a 15 minute window for a player to arrive; if a sub has already played the trial ends then the late player cannot play.

3. The failure of a team to appear at its scheduled match shall cause the side at fault to forfeit the maximum points to the opposing side and render itself liable to a maximum fine of £10. If fewer than eight players appear on either side the side at fault shall be held as having failed to appear.

4. The introduction of an ineligible player shall cause the offending side to forfeit the match together with an additional deduction of four points, plus a fine of £10.00. If both sides be party to such infringement the game shall be null and void, both clubs shall have an additional four points deducted and a fine of £10.00 each imposed.

5. Seven teams or less to be played Home and away basis. Eight teams or more Home or Away only.

6. Any fixture that has been cancelled and ultimately will decide either the league winners, promotion or relegation must be rearranged and played. All cancelled games to be played before 8th September. In the event of a dispute the Association League Secretary is empowered to fix a date for the match.

7. The home club shall submit the results of the matches via the Bowls Sunderland website and confirm that both captains agreed the result before leaving the venue. All clubs must submit a list of players after each league fixture.

HAROLD HOWEY TROPHY VETERANS COMPETITION (Thursday at 1:30pm)

The Executive Council shall have full power to deal with any circumstances arising in the administration of the Competition,

1. Open to all clubs in the Association.
2. Teams shall consist of two rinks of four players each. A club may submit more than one team.
3. Limited to all club members aged 55 and over.
4. Each game limited to 18 ends. Two trial ends

4b. Clubs have a 15 minute window for a player to arrive; if a sub has already played the trial ends then the late player cannot play..

5. The failure of a team to appear at its scheduled match shall cause the side at fault to forfeit the maximum points to the opposing side and render itself liable to a maximum fine of £10. Should a team realize it cannot meet its commitments on the scheduled date the match may be brought forward, the League Secretary must be informed of this decision. If fewer than six players appear on either side the side at fault shall be held as having failed to appear. Matches cancelled due to bad weather to be played within one month.

6. Trophies to be held yearly.

6a. The introduction of an ineligible player shall cause the offending side to forfeit the match together with an additional deduction of four points, plus a fine of £10.00. If both sides be party to such infringement the game shall be null and void, both clubs shall have an additional four points deducted and a fine of £10.00 each imposed.

6b. Any player holding membership of two or more clubs shall be restricted to playing for one club in anyone season.

7. No member of any club to play for more than one team in anyone season.

8. Two points shall be awarded for a win, one point for each winning rink, making a maximum of four points. Rinks finishing level shall be awarded half a point each. Matches ending in a tie by reason of the total scores of the respective rinks being level, one point will be awarded to each club and one point for each winning rink, but rinks finishing with level scores shall be awarded half a point each.

9. Any match affected by unfavourable weather, the score at the 15th end to decide the result.

9a. Any fixture that has been cancelled and ultimately will decide either the league winners, promotion or relegation must be rearranged and played. All cancelled games to be played before 8th September. In the event of a dispute the Association League Secretary is empowered to fix a date for the match.

10. The home club shall submit the results of the matches via the Bowls Sunderland website and confirm that both captains agreed the result before leaving the venue. **All clubs must submit a list of players after each league fixture.**

11. The Executive Council have power to equalize the number of teams in each division on an annual basis.

SINGLE-HANDED CHAMPIONSHIP (Four bowl scratch Competition)

1. The Competition (open to the respective single-handed Champions of the current season of all clubs affiliated to the Association) shall be played each year. The winner shall hold the Championship Cup for one year and prizes shall be awarded to the winner and runner up.

2. All clubs must notify the Competition Secretary in writing not later than the 10th day of August, the name of the winner of their club Championship. Failure on the part of a club to comply will result in the club representative not being included in the draw.

3. All games shall be played as per "Bowls England" rules subject to any locally applied rule

4. Abandoned ties shall be recommenced with the scores as they were when the game was abandoned.

5. All ties preceding the Quarter Finals, the first named player shall offer two days.

6. Semi Finals & Finals to be played on neutral greens

7. The Executive Council shall fix the dates of the various rounds and shall have the power to deal with any circumstances not provided for in these bye-laws.

VETERANS CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS

1. Open to any member who qualified to participate in the Harold Howey Trophy, to be run on the same lines as the Association Champion of Champions.

2. All ties preceding the Quarter Finals, the first named player shall offer two days.

INTER CLUB K. O. TRIPLES

1. Each team shall consist of four rinks of three players, each player playing three bowls. Players must be bona-fide members of the same club. Points to be awarded - three for shot bowl; two for second bowl; one for third bowl. In the event of bowls from opposing sides being equal distance from the jack the value of the two bowls to be shared i.e. three and two points or two and one point.

2. **All ties to be 15 ends plus 2 trial ends.** Any match affected by unfavourable weather, the score at the 12th end to decide the result.

Both Secretary's/Captains must agree on the question of the weather conditions justifying the abandonment. If less than 12 ends have been played the game can be rearranged with the current scores carried over.

3. Any team failing to field 12 players will forfeit the game.

4. In the event of a tie extra ends will be played by all rinks until a result is determined.

BYE-LAWS GOVERNING THE SILVER JACKS, THE BURKETT SHIELD & MIXED PAIRS.

1. Entrance fees to be agreed at the Association Annual General Meeting

2. Entries for the competition must be sent to the person appointed by the Association on or before the appointed day for closing of entries.

3. The first named pair or triple shall arrange for the playing of the tie by offering their opponents at least two dates, Neither the last day of the period of the round nor Sunday shall be one of the dates offered. Matches may be played on a Sunday by mutual agreement. The opponents shall within 48 hours of the receipt of two dates reply accepting one of the dates offered.

4. Any pair or triple failing to attend within 15 minutes of the time arranged may forfeit the tie if a claim be made by their opponents

4b. All ties to be 15 ends plus 2 trial ends. The Home player has the choice of rinks.

5. Abandoned games shall be re-commenced with the scores as they were when the game was abandoned.
6. The winning pair or triple shall submit the result either verbally to the competition secretary or via the Bowls Sunderland Website within 48 hours of the completion of the tie.
7. The Executive Council shall have the power to deal with any circumstances not provided for in these by-laws.
8. There will be no extensions given on any set date, ties maybe brought forward provided both parties agree. Competitors will be expected to utilise substitutes or concede the tie. If a tie is not played due to bad weather then a toss of the coin will take place, the only exception will be the final. The competition secretary will have the final say on any disputes.
9. Semi Finals & Finals to be played on neutral greens

SILVER JACKS (PAIRS) COMPETITION

1. Each game shall consist of fifteen ends, four bowls each player, in the event of a tie an extra end or ends must be played, the shots to count in the final score until a result is achieved.
2. Each pair shall consist of two men who must be playing members of the same member club of the Association.
3. The two players taking part in the first game shall constitute the pair. One additional and the same player from the club may be used as a substitute at any time provided he has not already played in the competition.
4. The winning pair shall hold the "Silver Jacks Trophy" for one year and prizes to be awarded to the winning pair and runner up pair.

BURKETT SHIELD (TRIPLES) COMPETITION

1. Each game shall consist of fifteen ends, three bowls each player, in the event of a tie an extra end or ends must be played, the shots to count in the final score until a result is achieved.
2. Each triple shall consist of three men who must be playing members of the same member club of the Association.
3. The three players taking part in the first game shall constitute the triple. One additional and the same player from the club may be used as a substitute at any time provided he has not already played in the competition.

4. The winning triple shall hold the "Burkett Shield" for one year and prizes to be awarded to the winning triple and runner up triple.

DAVID MORGAN MIXED PAIRS COMPETITION

1. Each game shall consist of fifteen ends, four bowls each player, in the event of a tie an extra end or ends must be played, the shots to count in the final score until a result is achieved.

2. Each pair shall consist of one man and one woman who must be playing members of the same member club of the Association.

3. The two players taking part in the first game shall constitute the pair. One player from the club may be used as a substitute at any time provided he OR she has not already played in the competition. However one of the original pair MUST play and NOT a brand new pairing.

4. The winning pair shall hold the "David Morgan Mixed Pairs Vase" for one year and prizes to be awarded to the winning pair and runners up pair

“New” Vet’s “SUPER 5’s” Competition Rules

This is a straight **KNOCK OUT** Competition that will take place on a set Friday afternoon (1.30pm start) over the season.

Please note a toss of the coin will decide who gets the jack on the first end.

The Semi Finals & Final will be played at a selected neutral venue.

A club can enter as many teams as they want.

As per our other competitions there will be an entry fee applied, payable by the club for the number of teams entered. (£5 each)

The winning club will receive a cash prize plus a maximum of **SEVEN** medals.

Each team will consist of 5 players, you are allowed 1 sub in both the Pair and Triples so basically it is a **SEVEN** player squad.

If you progress in the competition you can alter the line ups up the Pair & Triple. It can be all men, all women or mixed. The only caveat is they must be **Over 55**.

Players can only play for one entered team and all must be members of the **CLUB**.

The format is as follows -:

2 Trial Ends

1 Pair – 3 Bowls – 15 ends

1 Triple – 2 Bowls – 15 ends

The winner will be decided by the overall score, should it end in a draw then **both** the Pair & Triple will play extra ends until a winner has been decided.

Please note one toss of the coin will decide who gets the choice of taking the jack or having the last bowl on the extra end. If more than one extra end is needed then another toss of the coin takes place.
