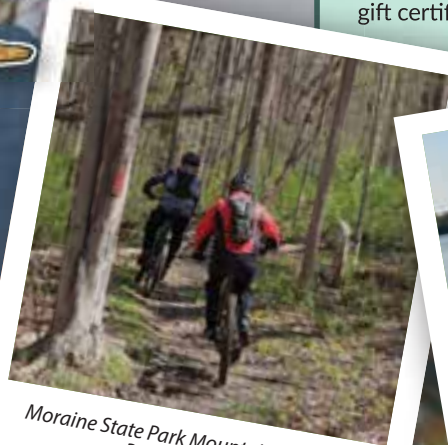

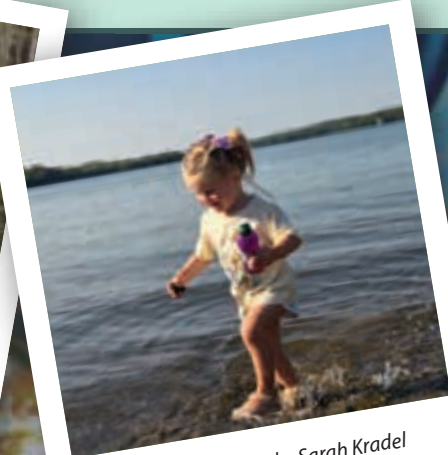

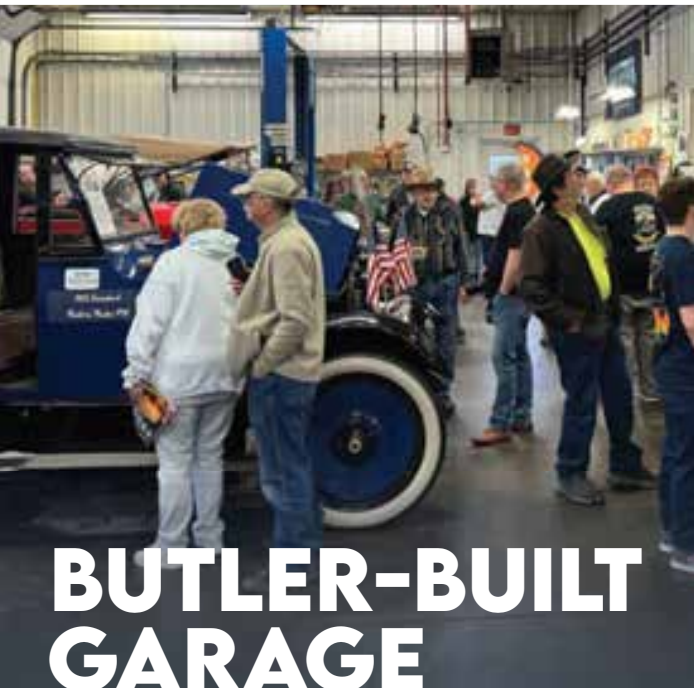
WASHINGTON'S TRAIL 1753

A HISTORIC DRIVING TRAIL

Everyone knows his name, but not all know the story of how America's first president almost lost his life in Butler County, PA.

Washington's Trail 1753 is a self-guided driving trail marked by bright blue road signs with the namesake's silhouette. It marks the approximate path he took on an expedition to deliver a message to the commanding officer at Fort LeBoeuf demanding the French depart from the Ohio Country.

Along the way, Washington was confronted by a Native American—acting as his guide—who shot at him from 15 steps away. How different our history would have been if this shot had been accurate!

Outside of events, car shows, and parades, the Butler Old Stone House Region Chapter of the Antique Automobile Club of America (AACA) hosts monthly open houses, giving the public access to the collection and its history.

SAXONBURG

Have you ever walked across the Brooklyn Bridge in New York? That historic structure has its origins in the Butler County town of Saxonburg. The town's co-founder, John Roebling, was the lead architect on the project, inventing the wire rope cable that would enable suspension bridges to exist across the country. He also designed this town, evident in the shops housed in historic buildings built in the style of a German hamlet.

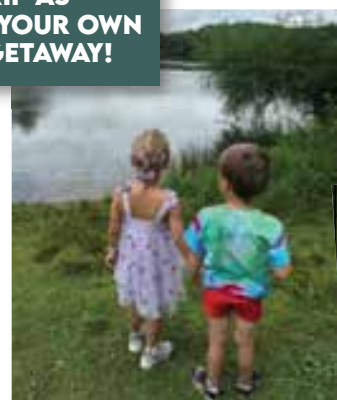

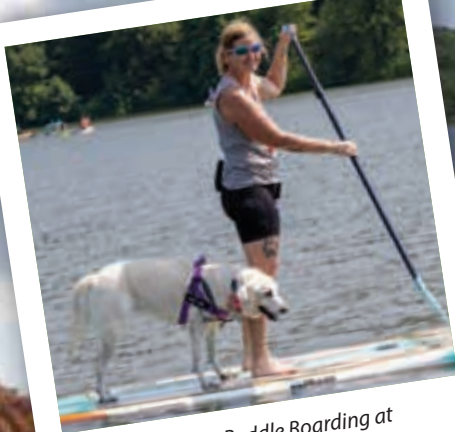

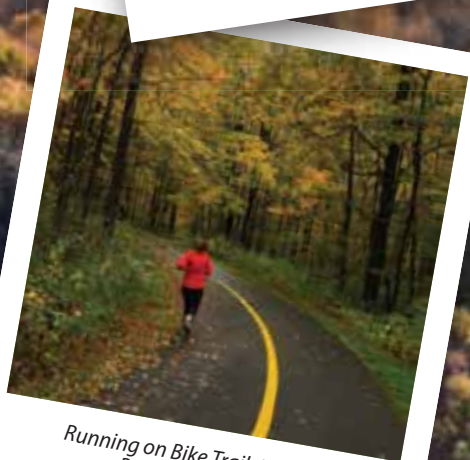

The Main Attraction

The history of Moraine State Park is one of perseverance, revitalization, and a deep commitment to rehabbing our native land and wildlife.

“Moraine” is a term used to describe debris left behind from glacier movement, which is how the topography of the park was formed. The land was restored to recreate and preserve the glacial landscape.

Moraine Preservation Fund, a nonprofit group, has continued that conservation work, creating programs that restored the population of barn owls, bats, and osprey in the park. They also developed an educational boat tour experience, Preston’s Pearl.

The Moraine, McConnells Mill, and Jennings Commission (3MJC) is another supportive nonprofit organization, organizing volunteer opportunities to maintain the park and educational outreach programs and events for park visitors.

Today, Moraine State Park stands as one of Butler County's most beloved attractions, drawing over a million visitors annually. With a wide range of activities available year-round—from swimming in the warmer months to ice-fishing in winter—there's an adventure waiting for everyone. 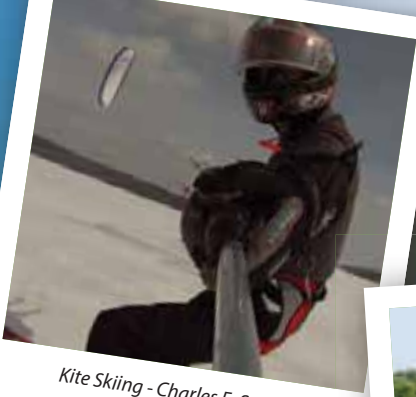

On the Land

HIKING

Explore the 29.2 miles of trails winding through forests and grassy areas, along lake edges, and past wetlands. Trails of varying lengths and difficulty provide a variety of experiences for all adventurers. These include the Glacier Ridge Trail and a section of the North Country Trail.

WILDLIFE WATCHING

Frogs, newts, turtles, and white-tailed deer live along the edges of Lake Arthur. Look to the shorelines to spy great blue herons, green herons, and belted kingfishers. Flying above are osprey and bald eagles.

BIKING

Seven miles of paved bike path are located between Davis Hollow and the Bike Rental Building in the northwest corner of the park. If mountain biking is more your speed, hit the trails near Davis Hollow Marina and enjoy the beauty of Moraine. Experienced riders will relish the challenge of these technical trails.

CABINS

Have a relaxing and memorable getaway by staying at one of the 11 modern cabins that are available to rent year-round. Cabins sleep up to six.

DISC GOLFING

Test your skills on the park's 18-hole course. It features two par 5s, eight par 4s, eight challenging par 3s, and beautiful views. Hole #15's view is outstanding!



On the Water

SWIMMING

Swimming is permitted at two beaches along the shores of Lake Arthur: Pleasant Valley Beach on the South Shore and Lakeview Beach on the North Shore. Pleasant Valley Beach has an accessible, paved path into the water, a sand volleyball court, and a playground. Lakeview Beach is a 656-foot sand beach. Both beaches are open daily from Memorial Day Weekend to Labor Day.

FISHING

There are abundant fishing opportunities with 42 miles of shoreline and numerous boat launches. McDanel's Boat Launch has an ADA-accessible fishing pier. Bring your fishing license or plan to visit on select "Fish for Free" days.

BOATING

Lake Arthur has nine public boat launches. Visitors can use the nearby boat rental for a variety of pontoon boat sizes and 15-foot tiller boats. Ice and fishing bait are available at the park's Owllet Gift Shop.

SAILING

Sailing lessons and races are held throughout the summer. On any summer day you'll see several multi-colored sails gliding across the lake.

KAYAKING

A relaxing way to enjoy Lake Arthur and take in all the sights and sounds of the park. Rentals are available through Crescent Bay Boat Rentals.

STAND-UP PADDLE BOARDING

SurfSUP is your guide to paddle boarding, with friendly instructors and classes for all experience levels. For more adventurous paddlers, try out the evening tour featuring LED-lit boards.

CAN'T-MISS ANNUAL EVENTS

When the summer sun is shining and Lake Arthur is full of swimmers and sails, the park celebrates the annual Moraine State Park Regatta that takes place the first weekend of August. Visiting in the winter? Not to fear, recreation continues and is highlighted during Winterfest, a January event that encourages visitors to embrace the cold and maybe even walk across the frozen lake.
