PRESIDENT'S WELCOME

Welcome to the 2026 UK Men's & Mixed National Championships.

Another brilliant year has passed, with men's and mixed netball continuing to grow at a remarkable pace. We can see that growth in the number of teams competing, the standard of competition, the international opportunities now available to our players and, of course, the scale of Nationals.

The 2026 competition calendar began with our second Men's Netball Winter Championships. Fifteen men's teams competed for the title in a brilliant day of netball, with AO Manchester Thunder emerging as worthy champions. The Winter Championships have already become an important part of our calendar, giving more players the opportunity to play competitive men's netball while also supporting talent identification for our England programmes.

One of the clearest signs of our growth has been the continued expansion of the EMMNA league competitions. New categories, increased entries and further regionalisation have created more opportunities for clubs across the country. More than 260 league fixtures took place this season, which is a huge achievement. Delivering a programme of that size would not be possible without the work of our League Committee, clubs, team managers, umpires, officials and volunteers.

I cannot thank them enough for the time and effort they put in throughout the season. The connection between the league and Nationals is also important. Thursday's regional play-offs carry the league season directly into this weekend, making Nationals the culmination of months of competition rather than simply one standalone event.



The inaugural Mixed National Premiership could not have showcased mixed netball any better. All six clubs demonstrated quality, consistency and growth across a full season, with every team capable of competing against one another. There were close games, draws and results that kept changing who sat at the top and throughout the table.

Neither the title nor the final placings were determined until the last round. London Giants eventually took the title by just 0.01 on goal average, with only three goals separating the goal differences of the top two teams in the final standings. That is exactly what you want from a premiership competition, and I am extremely excited to see what season two brings.

This year also saw the launch of the first Men's Super League, with four leading teams competing in a new showcase competition. A key part of the format allowed clubs to recruit players from other clubs, helping ensure that more of the country's best men's players could take part in regular, high-level competition.

From NSL curtain-raisers to double-headers in London and Loughborough, the league created more opportunities to put elite men's netball in front of an audience. It is also an important part of the continued development of our England programme, providing more competitive matches for our England players.

One team stood out across the season, with Knights Netball becoming our inaugural Men's Super League champions. This is only the beginning. The Men's Super League is here to stay, and we hope it will continue creating opportunities to showcase the very best of elite men's netball.



The past year has also been an incredibly exciting one internationally. Just weeks after Nationals 2025, we hosted Australia for a three-match U23 and Mixed series in Norwich, Peterborough and London. The sold-out final matches at The Score were a fitting end to an incredible series and showed the appetite that exists for international men's and mixed netball.

In January, England A travelled to Singapore to compete in the 2026 Men's Netball Nations Series. They returned home with a silver medal after an outstanding tournament. Seeing an England team travel across the world, compete with confidence and finish on the podium was another special moment for everyone involved in our programme.

There is plenty more on the horizon. Later this autumn, we will welcome New Zealand for a three-match Mixed and U23 Men's Test series. It will be the first time a New Zealand Men's & Mixed side has toured England, with matches taking place in London, Bromsgrove and Guildford.

That will be followed by another historic moment in November, when the England Thorns take on the Jamaica Suns at the Copper Box Arena as part of the Horizon Series. To see men's international netball included in an event of this scale is a huge step forward for our sport, and it is one not to be missed.

And now we come to Nationals.

This year, 48 teams, and more than 800 athletes will compete in over 180 games across four days culminating in the spectacle that is Finals Sunday, this will be our biggest Nationals yet.



Nationals is always a pinch-me moment for me. Walking into the venues and seeing so many players, coaches, umpires, officials, volunteers and supporters together shows just how far we have all grown this sport. What was once an ambitious idea has become the biggest event in the men's and mixed netball calendar.

None of this happens without the people behind it. Thank you to our EMMNA Board of Directors, committees, events team, volunteers, umpires, technical officials, clubs, partners and England Netball for everything you contribute. Most importantly, thank you to every player who steps onto court and continues to push the standard of our game forward.

I am incredibly proud of what we have achieved together, but I am even more excited about where we are going next.

Enjoy Nationals, compete hard, support one another and make the most of what promises to be another unforgettable weekend.

KNIGHTS SWORDS CO-CAPTAIN



2025 WAS YOUR FIRST YEAR WITH KNIGHTS SWORDS AND YOU WALKED AWAY WITH A CHAMPIONSHIP TROPHY! HOW DO YOU REFLECT ON THE SUCCESS OF LAST YEAR'S COMPETITION?

It was an incredible way to start my journey with Knights Swords. Winning the Championship in my first year was something I'm incredibly proud of, but more than the trophy, I'm proud of the work, commitment, and teamwork that went into achieving it. For me, when I'm enjoying my netball, that's when I play my best, and last year was all about enjoying the game, embracing the experience and

having fun with the team. I think that really showed in the way we played and ultimately in the success we had. Looking back, it was a fantastic year, and one that gave me even more motivation heading into this season.



YOU ARE HUGELY EXPERIENCED IN TOP FLIGHT WOMEN'S NETBALL, WHAT WAS IT ABOUT MIXED NETBALL THAT EXCITED YOU?

I think the different challenge it brings. Mixed netball has a different dynamic to the women's game, with a different pace, physicality and style of play, and I really enjoy having to adapt to that. There's a lot of variety in Mixed netball, and you're constantly having to read the game, adjust to your teammates and opponents, and find different ways to work together as a team. I think that challenge is what attracted me to it.

WITH THE SUCCESS OF 2025, KNIGHTS ARE NOW LOOKING TO RETAIN RATHER THAN RE-GAIN THEIR TITLE - DOES BEING THE HUNTED RATHER THAN THE HUNTER BRING A DIFFERENT TYPE OF PRESSURE?

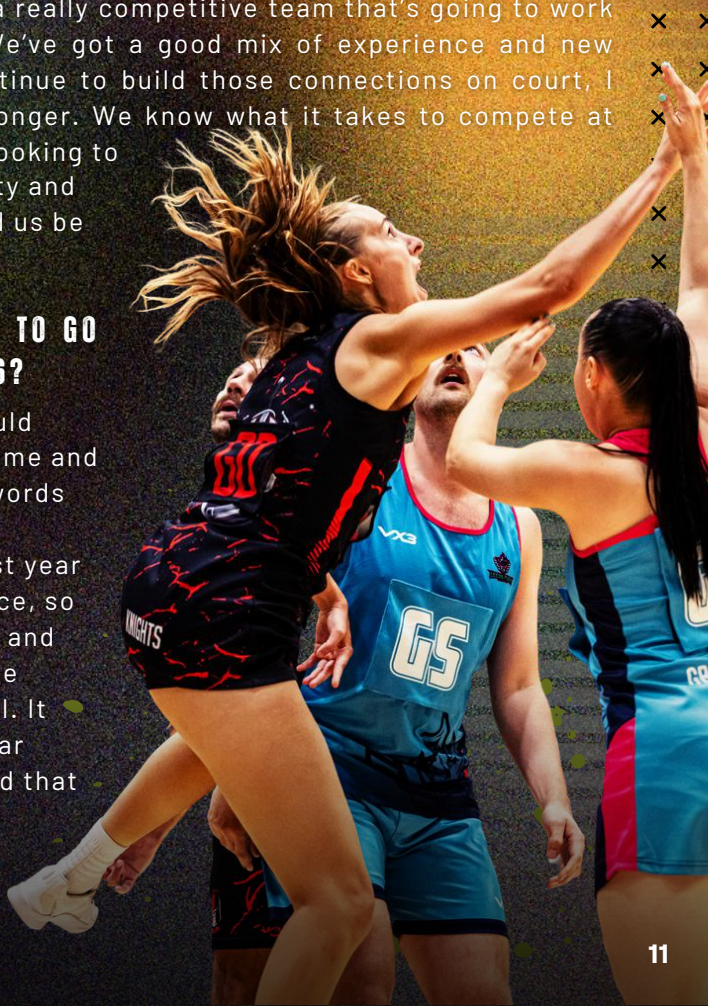
I think there is definitely a different type of pressure when you're the team everyone wants to beat. Last year, we were going in with something to prove and could focus on taking each game as it came, whereas this year there's an expectation that we can go all the way again. For us, it's about not getting caught up in that pressure and staying focused on our own performance. We know every team will be coming at us, so we have to be prepared for that and make sure we're bringing the same intensity and commitment every time we step on court. Ultimately, we still want to play our game, trust the team and not get too caught up in being the defending champions.

THERE'S A FEW CHANGES TO THE TEAM THIS YEAR, TALK US THROUGH THEM AND WHAT WE CAN EXPECT TO SEE FROM KNIGHTS SWORDS.

I think you can expect a really competitive team that's going to work hard for each other. We've got a good mix of experience and new energy, and as we continue to build those connections on court, I think we'll only get stronger. We know what it takes to compete at this level, and we'll be looking to bring that same intensity and consistency that helped us be successful last year.

WHAT WOULD IT MEAN TO GO BACK-TO-BACK IN 2026?

Going back-to-back would mean a huge amount to me and to the whole Knights Swords team. Winning the Championship in my first year was a brilliant experience, so to be able to do it again and defend the title would be something really special. It would show that last year wasn't just a one-off and that we've been able to build on that success and continue to perform at a high level.

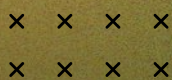


THE FIRST (YEAR OF) NOEL



Since taking over the England Thorns in October 2025, we have worked to establish a clear identity and a strong foundation for the programme, with a focus on developing a squad capable of competing at the highest level of international men's netball. A key part of that approach has been working with a smaller squad and creating a broader tracked-athlete group, ensuring that we focus on our current top performing athletes while continuing to identify and develop the depth we will need for the future. Across our training camps and performance opportunities, we have continued to build a greater understanding of our athletes, their strengths and how they can contribute within an England environment.

We worked hard behind the scenes to create our very own Commonwealth Games UK Tour where we faced the NZ Silver Ferns, Malawi, England Roses and Australian Diamonds which provided us invaluable opportunities to



experience different styles, tempos and approaches to international netball, while testing ourselves against some of the best players and programmes in the world. These experiences have accelerated our learning and, importantly, allowed us to develop our combinations and connections on court. Every camp and international opportunity has contributed to building a team that understands how we want to play, while also developing the adaptability required to compete against different opponents.

Our next challenge is the upcoming series against the Jamaica Suns, where we have an exciting opportunity to make history for the England Thorns. We are aiming for our first-ever wins against a top-four nation, and the series represents another important step in the growth of the programme. We know the challenge Jamaica will present, but we also recognise the progress we have made over the past year. Our goal is to take everything we have learned, trust the work we have put in, and play our game with confidence as we look to secure a landmark result for the England Thorns.

LONDON GIANTS CLUB CAPTAIN



GIANTS HAVE PROVEN THEMSELVES TO BE A POWERHOUSE IN MENS NETBALL, HAVING WON 4 OF THE LAST 5 NATIONAL TITLES. HOW MUCH DID THE WIN LAST YEAR MEAN TO YOU?

Obviously the expectation at Giants is always to win the men's title, so after a successful 2024 there was a lot of pressure for us to live up to that success. With 6 new players (including myself) no one expected us to get it done, so it was really special to not only win but to go undefeated. From a personal perspective, the campaign was a big learning curve for me which I hope will allow me to have a much bigger impact on the team this year.

TELL ME A BIT ABOUT THE TEAM THIS YEAR

This year we have a lot of familiar faces in the team. We have a good mix of international experience and young, hungry talent. Although our team is largely the same, we will have a few new tricks up our sleeve. You can expect us to bring the usual flare, hard contest and fiery match ups, as well as some clinical and high-level netball.

THERE'S SOME INCREDIBLY STRONG MEN'S SIDES THIS YEAR, WHAT ARE YOUR EXPECTATIONS OF THE COMPETITION IN 2026?

Yeah, this entire season has been strong for men's netball and the introduction of the MSL has contributed to that. We know our rivals have all bolstered their squads with some top international talent for nationals... we see ourselves as underdogs, which we love, but we back the talent we have in our squad 100% and believe we can be a problem for anyone on our day.

THE LAST 12 MONTHS HAVE BEEN HUGE FOR YOU PERSONALLY, WITH SELECTION FOR THE HISTORY-MAKING AUSTRALIA MIXED SERIES AND THE THORNS A TOUR TO SINGAPORE. HOW HAVE THOSE EXPERIENCES HELPED TO SHAPE WHO YOU ARE AS A PLAYER TODAY?

The last 12 months have been a real breakthrough for me, and I'm very fortunate that my netball career has typically trended upwards, though I have worked hard to get to where I am today. The two series were both challenging for me in their own way. I didn't get as much court time as I would have liked in the mixed series, but I believe it gave me the motivation to get even better and work harder.

The Singapore tour was my first time in a leadership role for England and it gave me a taste of what representing your country really feels like. We went through many tough moments as a squad, but I loved the togetherness we showed, and it gave a lot of us the motivation to come back and push for positions in the current Thorns squad.

I see myself as a student of the game and genuinely want to continue to improve and learn from everyone around me. These two experiences, as well as other significant experiences, have really contributed to my growth in the sport, and I'm just excited to see where I can get to in the next 12 months.

WHAT ARE YOU MOST LOOKING FORWARD TO AT NATIONALS THIS YEAR?

I'm excited to see the level of competition grow, across both men's and mixed. Nationals has become increasingly more competitive year on year, and a spectacle that people are genuinely excited to be a part of/come and watch. Most importantly, I'm excited for finals day, where we will hopefully have the chance to go for the first ever three-peat.





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HORIZON SERIES PREVIEW

**WITH JAMES THOMSON-BOSTON
ENGLAND THORNS CAPTAIN**

THE THORNS WILL BE TEAMING UP WITH THE VITALITY ROSES TO TAKE ON JAMAICA IN THE UPCOMING HORIZON SERIES IN NOVEMBER. HOW IMPORTANT IS IT FOR THE GROWTH OF THE MEN'S GAME TO BE SHOWCASED ALONGSIDE THE WOMEN'S INTERNATIONAL GAME AT AN EVENT LIKE THIS?

First off, what an opportunity! To showcase our game alongside the Roses in the Vitality Horizon Series is something we have worked towards since the Thorns was first created. We have previously showcased men's games before Netball Superleague matches and we always get the same two responses from the crowd who came to watch. Firstly, they didn't know about men's netball and secondly, how exciting and different the game can be. Having the opportunity to do it at an international series will allow more people to see this style of netball in action.

THERE'S A FANTASTIC RIVALRY BETWEEN THE THORNS AND THE JAMAICA SUNS THAT HAS REALLY BUILT OVER THE LAST FEW YEARS, WITH ENGLAND STILL SEARCHING FOR THAT HISTORIC FIRST WIN. WHAT WOULD IT MEAN TO YOU AND THE TEAM TO FINALLY GET THAT VICTORY ON HOME SOIL?

It would be mean the world. The Jamaica Suns are a fiercely competitive and internationally recognised side who have been a fantastic benchmark for where we are as a squad over the last 3 years. Each time we've met we've managed to close to gap a little bit more. It would be a testament to the growth of men's netball in the UK for us to get the historic first win.

WHAT IS IT ABOUT PLAYING JAMAICA THAT MAKES THE MATCH-UP SO EXCITING? WHAT PARTICULAR CHALLENGES DOES THE SUNS' STYLE OF PLAY POSE TO THE THORNS?

Jamaica play fast and score fast, their ball speed and athleticism is worth the ticket price alone. You'll see a lot of aerial play and long feeds into the shooting circle. We will have our job cut out for us dictating them away from play to disrupt their ball speed. It should be a fantastic match-up!

THERE'S BEEN PLENTY OF CHANGE FOR THE THORNS OVER THE LAST 12 MONTHS, WITH A NEW-LOOK PLAYING GROUP AND JO NOEL COMING IN AS HEAD COACH. HOW WOULD YOU DESCRIBE THE TEAM'S EVOLUTION, AND WHAT CAN FANS EXPECT TO SEE FROM THE THORNS IN NOVEMBER?

The fans can expect a more polished brand of netball from what we've previously put out. Jo came in and instantly fed back key points of the game that were holding us back so we have been building back up from basics over the last 12 months and the connections are really starting to build all through court. There will still be the exciting, fast paced play but we now have a level of maturity and consistency in our locker too.

FOR ANYONE WHO MIGHT BE CONSIDERING COMING ALONG TO WATCH, WHAT WOULD YOU SAY TO THEM ABOUT WHY THEY SHOULD GET A TICKET AND EXPERIENCE THE HORIZON SERIES LIVE?

I've never met someone who has come to watch netball and left bored. The sheer athleticism, excitement and atmosphere at the top level is something that needs to be experienced. You get two matches, same sport, different styles. Two fierce rivalries that have built over the years. One iconic venue, The Copper Box at Olympic Park in London.
