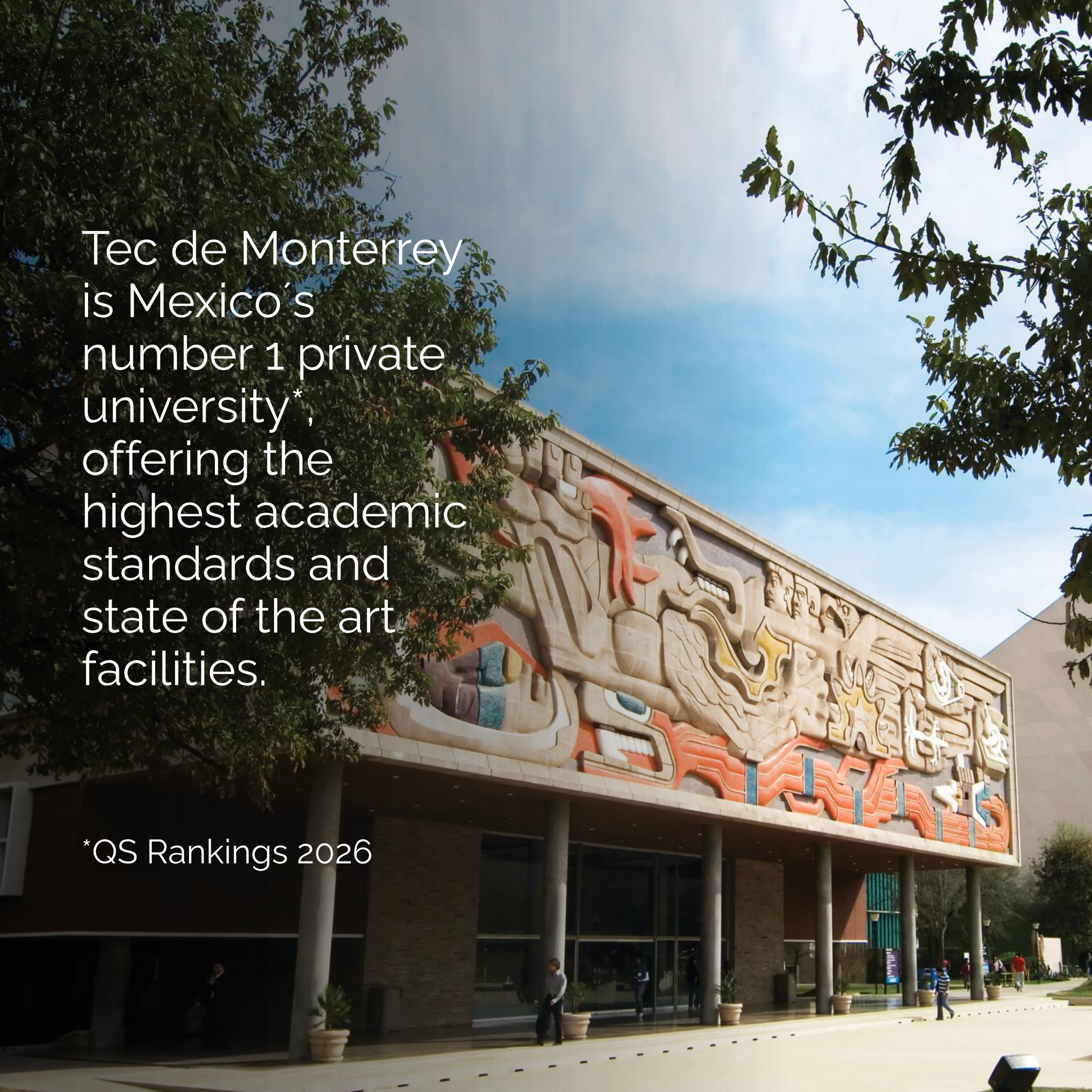

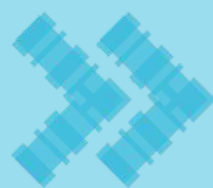

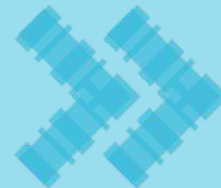
Our educational model is a **challenge-based learning educational model** which develops competencies that will enable student to face up the opportunities and challenges of the 21st century creatively and strategically.

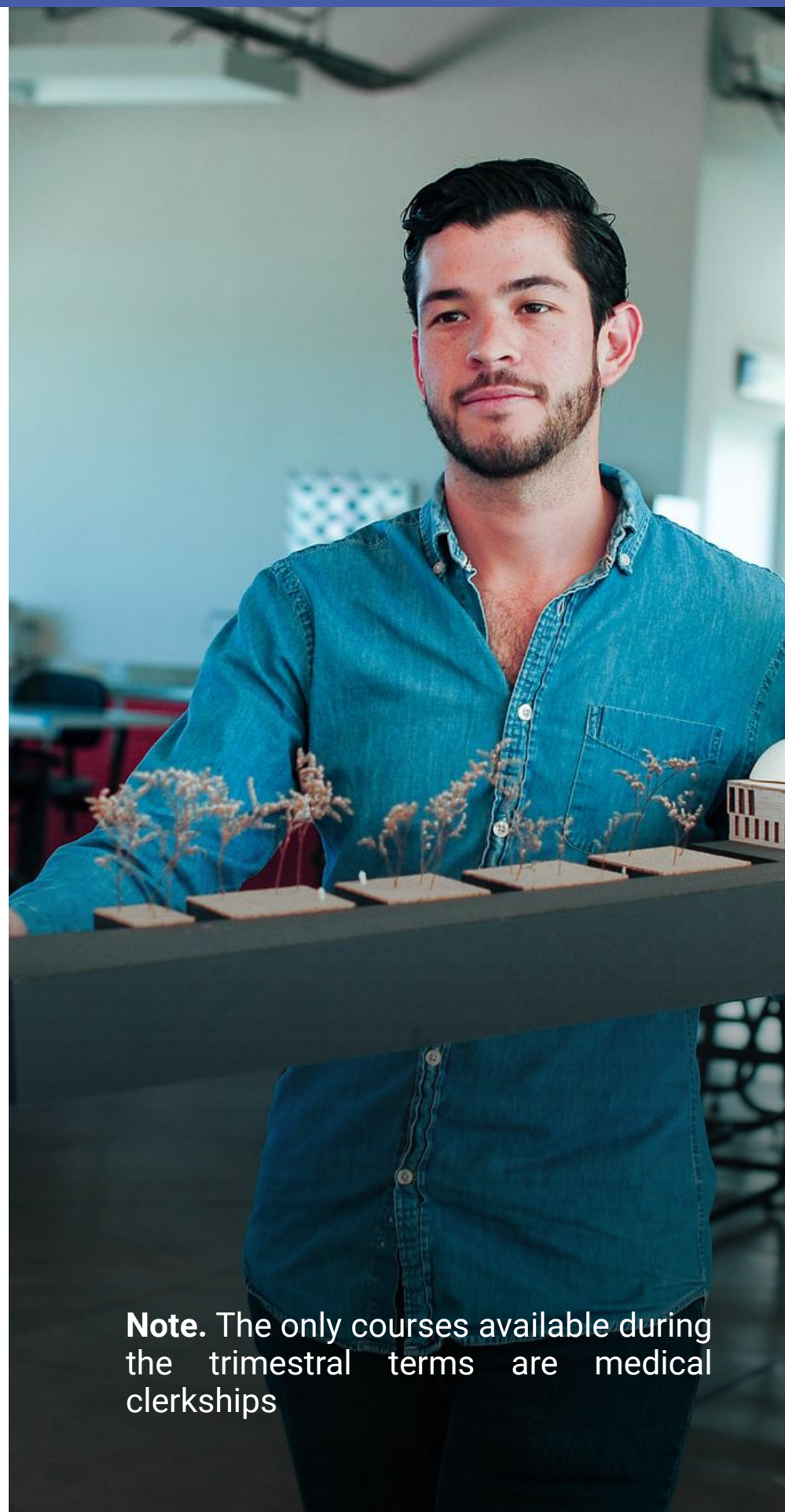

Our short term programs have a duration of 4 weeks, however, the regular courses offer during these terms have a duration of 5 weeks.

During the Summer and Winter terms, the regular courses offered are only taught in Spanish.



Note. The only courses available during the trimestral terms are medical clerkships

Academic Options



*To enroll in courses in the Health Science field an approval from the Medicine and Health Sciences school will be required.



Regular Undergraduate Courses

Taught in English and Spanish

Combine courses from different academic fields such as Engineering, Biotechnology, Information Technology, Business, Economics, Humanities, Social Sciences, Architecture, Arts and Design, Agriculture and Food Technology, Health Science*, and Political Science.



Spanish as a Second Language and Mexican Culture

Tec de Monterrey offers language and culture related courses through which you will **learn to speak Spanish** and obtain priceless knowledge about Mexico and Latin America's way of thinking and doing business.

Our Spanish courses range from beginner to advanced levels. To determine the appropriate level, you will need to take our Spanish placement test upon enrollment.

B1 Spanish and/or English level required to take courses taught in Spanish and/or English respectively

All health science courses and clerkships require approval from the School of Medicine and Health Sciences.



Medicine and Health Sciences

The Medicine and Health Science School offer courses taught in both Spanish and English during **semester periods** in study areas such as: Medicine, Nutrition, Psychology, Odontology, and Biosciences.

Medical Clerkship

During **trimester periods**, the Medicine and Health Science School provide clerkships in: Medicine, Psychology, Nutrition, and Odontology.

Clerkships are only available in Spanish, so is necessary to have B1 level in Spanish.



Specializations that offer courses related to a specific academic discipline, providing a total of 18 Tec credits (30 ECTS or 18 American credits).



Concentrations (Specializations)

Taught in English and Spanish

An **academic specialization** in a certain discipline that can be completed in one semester, providing a total of 18 Tec credits (30 ECTS).

We provide concentrations across various academic fields, such as: Architecture, Art, Bioengineering, Computer Science, Design, Economics, Education, Industrial Engineering, Mechanics, Mechatronics, Media and Culture, Political Sciences, Sustainable Tech, and Civil Engineering.

Upon completing the concentration, you will receive a diploma of recognition, provided your final grade is 85 or higher, along with your transcript.



Undergraduate Research Projects

Tec de Monterrey offers you the possibility to develop your **research skills** by participating in a research project at any of our research centers. Obtain valuable experience while **being advised by research specialists** in any of our many research groups. Each project offer academic credits.

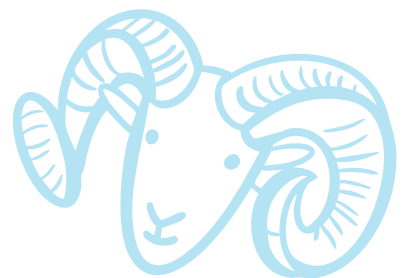
Artistic and Cultural Activities
