Families closer to our private bus routes often choose the convenience of day enrolment. Families further afield sometimes discover boarding is an option they had not previously considered, providing access to all the opportunities of Loreto Normanhurst without the demands of a lengthy daily commute.

Day Students (Year 5-12)

- Easy access from Greater Western Sydney with private bus services from Marsden Park and Box Hill.
- A thriving Primary School with small classes, personalised support, specialist teaching and exceptional facilities.
- Guided by the award-winning Student Growth Model and FACE Curriculum (Faith, Academic, Community, Extra-Curricular).
- Girls develop confidence, leadership and a strong sense of belonging.
- A seamless transition into secondary school, supported by dedicated wellbeing programs, strong relationships and a deep sense of connection to the Loreto Normanhurst community.
- Growing in 2027 with additional Year 5 and Year 6 classes, followed by Year 3 and 4 in 2028.
- Year 5 entry guarantees a pathway to Year 7, with fewer direct Year 7 places available as the Primary School expands.

Boarding Students (Year 7-12)

- Newly opened McCabe House provides a convenient boarding option for families beyond our transport network.
- Sydney's largest girls' boarding school, with more than 200 boarders, offering outstanding opportunities in academics, sport, music, leadership and service.
- A boarding community that is large enough for opportunity, yet structured so every girl is known, valued and supported.
- Everything in one place: academic support, sport, rowing, rehearsals, extra-curricular activities and friendships are all within easy reach.
- Enjoy the best of both worlds with independence and community during the week, while many boarders return home on weekends for family time.
