

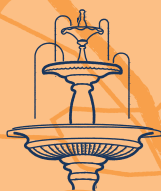

Dining



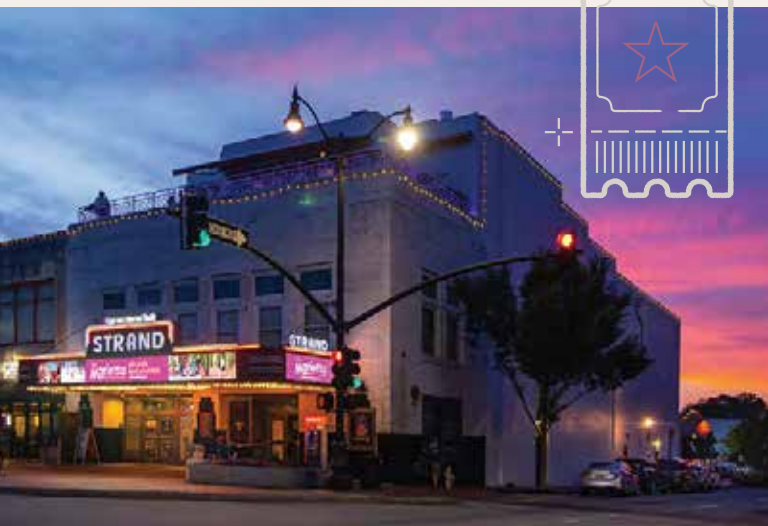

Directions:



From Hartsfield–Jackson International Airport

Getting to and from Atlanta Hartsfield–Jackson International Airport is easy! It's located just 45 minutes (29.9 miles via I-75) from Marietta Square. The airport is served by major rental car companies and other options like MARTA and Cobb County transportation or Lyft, Uber, taxi cabs, shuttles, and public transit options.



Ground Transportation

While there is no direct connection from Hartsfield–Jackson International Airport (ATL) to the Marietta Transfer Center, you can take the subway to Arts Center Station and then take the CobbLinc Route 10 bus to Marietta Transfer Center.

Alternatively, you can then take a taxi to Marietta Transfer Center.



By Car

Marietta is an easy drive from most of the eastern United States. It is centrally located in the epicenter of numerous major cities and accessible from multiple interstates and highways.

Northbound

Take I-75N to Exit 263, South Marietta Parkway 120. At the exit, turn left and go west about five miles. Turn right onto Atlanta Street, and the Square is two blocks ahead.

Southbound

Take I-75S to Exit 265, North Marietta Parkway 120. At the exit, turn right and go west about two miles. Turn left onto Church Street, and the Square is two blocks ahead.



From Cobb Airport

We recommend taking a taxi, Lyft, or Uber, as there are no ground transportation options to get from Cobb Airport to Marietta.
