What to bring with you

Please ensure you bring with you a copy of your latest school report, including attendance details. Feel free to bring with you anything else that you would like to show or discuss at your Course Discussion that is relevant to the subjects you have chosen to study.

What to expect

The discussion will be an opportunity for us to chat to you, ask about what you enjoy doing, why you think the course will suit you and if you know what your longer-term goals are (for example what type of job, what type of university or course). It's important for you to think about this before starting college to make sure the courses you choose will help you achieve your goals.
