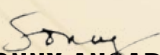

Congratulations, my dear graduates!

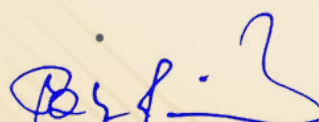

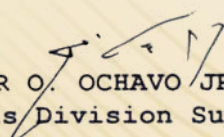
This is the restoration of normalcy - no extremes, but a neoconceptualization of the authenticity of relationships for existence. This is self-preservation, not annihilation.

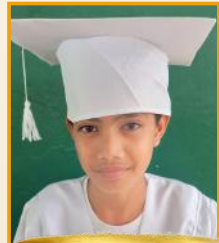

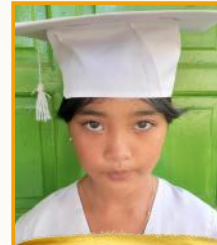
