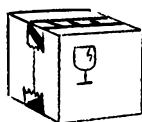

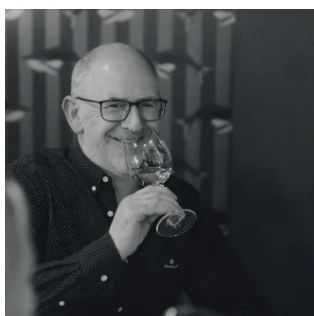

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Argentina

Argentina doesn't whisper its presence in the wine world — it announces itself from the foothills of the Andes with altitude, attitude, and intensity. Stretching from the desert landscapes of Mendoza to the windswept vineyards of Patagonia, Argentina has become one of the most exciting wine regions on the planet, producing wines that are bold, vibrant, and unmistakably expressive.

At the heart of its success is Malbec: a grape once overshadowed in France, now transformed into Argentina's global calling card. Here, under fierce sunshine and cool mountain nights, Malbec delivers wines packed with dark fruit, velvety texture, and remarkable freshness. Offering bright, fruity and soft examples like the **Conejo Verde Malbec** through to the intense and structured **Hermended Malbec**. But Argentina is far more than a one-grape story. Crisp Torrontés, elegant Cabernet Franc, high-altitude Chardonnay, and increasingly refined Pinot Noir reveal a country pushing boundaries with confidence and style.

What makes Argentina truly unique is its extreme geography. Some vineyards sit over 3,000 metres above sea level, where intense sunlight and dramatic temperature swings create wines with concentration, purity, and natural balance. Add passionate winemaking, old vines, and a culture built around food, fire, and hospitality, and Argentina offers something irresistible: wines with both power and soul.

Bordeaux

Bordeaux is a heavyweight classic with a colourful past — once under English rule for 200 years and still producing more AOC wine than anywhere else in France.

Loire Valley

The Loire is France's longest river, rising in the Massif Central and meandering over 1,000km to the Atlantic at Nantes. Along the way, its vineyards stretch for around 500km and fall into three distinct zones.

Upstream, the Upper Loire is Sauvignon country — home to crisp, mineral-driven Sancerre and Pouilly-Fumé. At the river's mouth, Muscadet delivers zesty, sea-breeze freshness. In between, the Central Loire around Tours and Anjou offers real diversity: from elegant Chenin Blanc and Cabernet Franc to rosé, fizz and even luscious, sweet wines.

Rhône Valley

The Rhône Valley is one of France's best-kept secrets for value — especially when stacked up against Bordeaux and Burgundy. In the north, it's all about pure, peppery Syrah. In the south, it opens up into bold, generous blends of Grenache, Syrah, Mourvèdre and friends, delivering everything from easy-drinking Côtes du Rhône to the richly layered Châteauneuf-du-Pape.

There's more too — fresh, tropical-tinged whites and crisp, savoury rosés that often fly under the radar but absolutely shouldn't. Big character, serious quality, and plenty of bang for your buck.

Austria

Over the past 30 years, Austria has transformed into one of the world's most exciting wine producers. Following the wine scandals of the 1980s, a new generation of winemakers has driven a quality revolution, creating fresh, modern and characterful wines.

Most vineyards lie in eastern Austria, where cool mountain air meets warm breezes from the Hungarian plains – ideal conditions for growing expressive wines.

Grüner Veltliner, Austria's signature grape, accounts for nearly a third of all plantings alongside Riesling. We proudly list outstanding examples from Funkstille, a 16th-generation producer in Niederösterreich known for its vibrant wines and contemporary style alongside Eschenhof Holzer, a small organic estate in the heart of Wagram.

Garnacha shines in Campo de Borja with juicy, vibrant wines like Delincuente, while Bobal from Manchuela (think Altolandon Mil Historias) delivers a bold and floral high-altitude example. Up in the cool north, Galicia brings freshness and lift with brilliant Albariños that are right on trend.

It's this mix of old vines, modern winemaking and incredible regional diversity that makes Spain one of the most exciting and best-value wine countries on the planet.

Uruguay

Southern Uruguay's vineyards were first planted by Basque and Italian immigrants, who developed a particular passion for the Tannat grape. Today, Tannat makes up over a quarter of the country's production, thriving in the cooling influence of its maritime climate.

While early vineyards were centred around the capital, Montevideo, a new chapter began in Maldonado, about 180km away, where Bodega Garzón helped pioneer modern viticulture in the region. In just over a decade, it has become one of Uruguay's leading producers and was named "New World Winery of the Year" by Wine Enthusiast in 2018.

Low Intervention Wine

Low intervention or 'natural' wine is becoming increasingly popular and on trend within our industry. It refers to wine produced through minimal intervention from the winemaker. They are often organic or biodynamic, usually containing little to no additives such as commercial yeasts, sulphites and sugar and are generally unfiltered and unfiltered (so sometimes cloudy and with sediment). Winemakers choose to produce wines in this way to offer an authentic product that honestly reflects the character of the grapes, terroir, region and vintage.

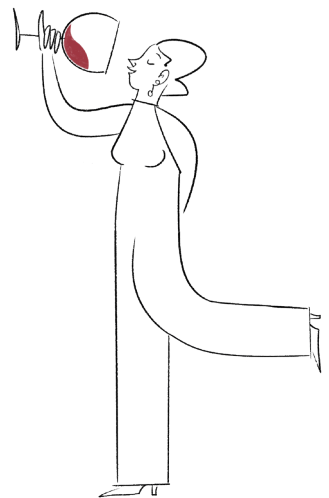
