CELEBRATING AMERICA'S 250th



Cold Spring Village preserves and interprets authentic 18th-century buildings that pre-date or span 1776

IN 2026 OUR NATION MARKS 250 YEARS since declaring our independence. Here in Cape May County, that anniversary lands a little differently as this corner of New Jersey was already a thriving destination when the nation was just starting out. Long before there was a country to celebrate, Cape May was a place people visited. In 1609, English explorer Sir Henry Hudson sailed past the southern tip of New Jersey while searching for a passage to Asia. Twelve years later, Dutch captain Cornelius Jacobsen Mey explored the area more closely, lending his name, eventually to Cape May itself. By the time the American Revolution began in 1776, Cape May was no frontier outpost. It was already a working coastal community shaped by the sea, trade, and travel. During the Revolutionary era, the county's quiet inlets and bays played supporting roles in a very loud conflict. Privateers slipped out of local waters, while British ships patrolled nearby. Communities adapted, endured, and carried on. There were no grand battlefields, but real working places where loyalty, survival, and independence were lived out day by day.

After the war, Cape May took on a new identity, and one that would help define American leisure culture. In the early 19th century, visitors began arriving by stagecoach and

steamship, drawn by the sea air, saltwater bathing, and the idea that time by the ocean could restore both body and spirit. Cape May became the nation's first seaside resort, setting a pattern that coastal towns up and down the Eastern Seaboard would later follow.

By the late 1800s, the town of Cape May was flourishing. Grand hotels lined the streets. Painted Victorians rose in neat rows, many of which still stand today. After a devastating fire in 1878, the town rebuilt with confidence, resulting in one of

the largest collections of Victorian architecture in the country. Walking these streets still feels like stepping back in time into a place where history is still visibly tangible.

The county's role on the national stage continued into the 20th century. Several U.S. presidents, including Ulysses S. Grant and Benjamin Harrison, spent summers in Cape May, earning it a reputation as an unofficial Summer White House. Decisions weren't made here, but important ideas were exchanged, alliances formed, and the rhythms of American political life moved at a more relaxed pace.

While Cape May proper drew national attention, the rest of the county developed its own distinct character. Fishing and whaling villages, farming communities, barrier island towns, and inland hamlets grew alongside one another. Shipbuilding, salt hay harvesting, oystering, and later tourism shaped daily life. Each generation added its own layer of history – sometimes literally, as roads, rail lines, and boardwalks expanded across marsh and sand. Cape May County is still shaped by its visitors, who come for beaches, birding, food, festivals, and quiet back roads.

America's 250th anniversary offers a moment to reflect and celebrate, but in Cape May County, it also invites a longer view into our 400 years of history as a place that has welcomed newcomers for more than four centuries. Celebrate our nation's birthday here by walking streets older than the country, swimming in waters crossed by explorers and presidents alike, and enjoying meals shaped by the same land and waters that sustained earlier generations. ■

MORE PLACES TO EXPLORE



Seaville Friends Meetinghouse, 1702

COLD SPRING VILLAGE (Lower Township):

With multiple original structures dating to the 1700s, Cold Spring Village preserves and interprets authentic 18th-century buildings that pre-date or span 1776. These buildings were relocated from across the county and restored.

TOWN BANK: (Lower Township)

One of the earliest European settlements in Cape May County (mid-1600s). By 1776, Town Bank was a known Delaware Bay community tied to shipping and trade.

THE DELAWARE BAY:

A major Revolutionary corridor for commerce, troop movement, and naval activity. Over time, Cape May County has remained on the nation's front lines.

HEREFORD INLET: (North Wildwood)

A strategic maritime gateway during the colonial era. Inlets like Hereford were used by fishermen, traders, and privateers during the Revolutionary period.

COLONIAL HOUSE MUSEUM: (Cape May)

Built in the 1700s by Revolutionary War patriot Memucan Hughes, the Colonial House operated as a tavern during the Revolutionary era.. The Colonial House is open to the public at no charge from June 15 through September 15. Winter tours are available by appointment.

JONATHAN HAND HOUSE: (Cape May)

Built around 1740 and expanded in the 19th century, the Jonathan Hand House was already standing when the American Revolution began. It is one of the oldest and few remaining early-Republic-era dwellings left in the city.

CAPE MAY COURT HOUSE: (Cape May Court House)

The county seat location was established in 1694 and served as the center of local justice and governance during the Revolutionary period. The current Old Court House was built in 1850 and replaced earlier structures dating to 1715.

DENNISVILLE (Dennis Township)

Established in the early 1700s and originally known as Dennis Creek Landing, this was a shipbuilding, lumber, and milling center along Dennis Creek.

SEAVILLE: (Upper Township)

An inland settlement that was well established before independence, Seaville is home to the Quaker Friends Meeting House, which was built in 1702 and is still standing today.

BEASLEY'S POINT: (Upper Township)

A Great Egg Harbor Bay landing active by the early 1700s, Beasley's Point served farmers, ferries, and regional trade during the colonial and Revolutionary eras.

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PARKS & REC AT THE JERSEY CAPE

CORSON'S INLET STATE PARK This 341-acre undeveloped tract of land at the south end of Ocean City is home to a natural habitat rich in diverse wildlife. The park offers outstanding scenic beauty and is a great place for hiking, fishing, crabbing, boating and sunbathing. Facilities and activities include a boat ramp, hiking trails, saltwater fishing and crabbing.

BELLEPLAIN STATE FOREST Located in Woodbine at the Northwest corner of the Jersey Cape, the forest offers over forty miles of trails for hiking, biking and horseback riding. Other activities include hunting, fishing, swimming at Lake Nummy and a variety of camping options. Belleplain is a well-known birding spot, especially during the spring migration.

CAPE MAY POINT STATE PARK With 244 acres of freshwater meadows, forests, dunes and beach, it's one of the best sites for bird watching in North America and a natural route for migratory birds. Known for the Cape May Lighthouse, a World War II gun battery and fire control tower, the park offers beach walking, hiking, fishing and picnicking.

HEREFORD LIGHTHOUSE Built in 1874 in North Wildwood, this historic structure is open to the public and still functions as an active navigational aid. Visitors to the Lighthouse learn

about its rich history and the Lighthouse grounds are a great place for a relaxing stroll in the gardens and a place to enjoy the beauty of the seashore.

CAPE MAY LIGHTHOUSE Built in 1859 and still an aid to navigation, visitors can climb the 199 steps to the top of the lighthouse for a spectacular panoramic view of the Atlantic Ocean and Delaware Bay for a fee. For those who choose not to climb, there's a fully-accessible visitors center, Museum Shop and beautiful grounds to explore. ■

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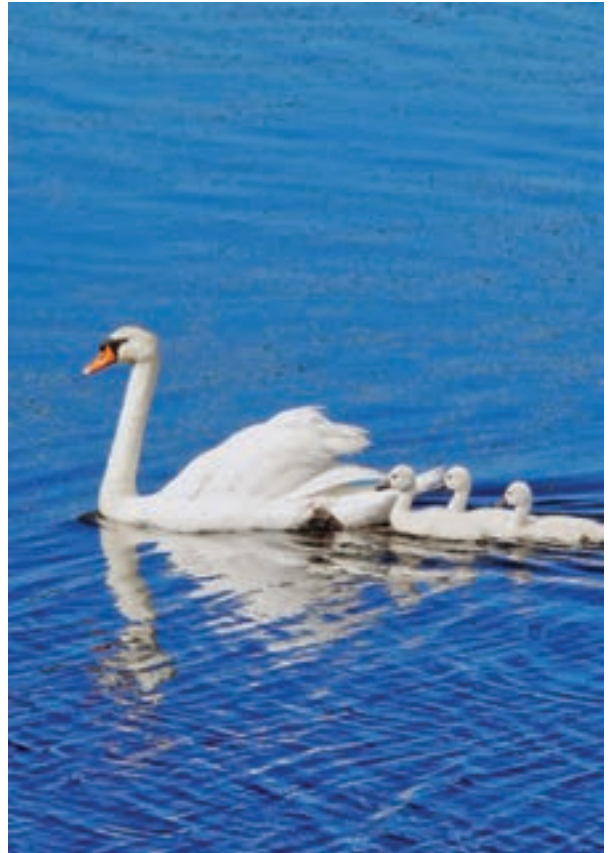


NATURE AT THE CAPE
