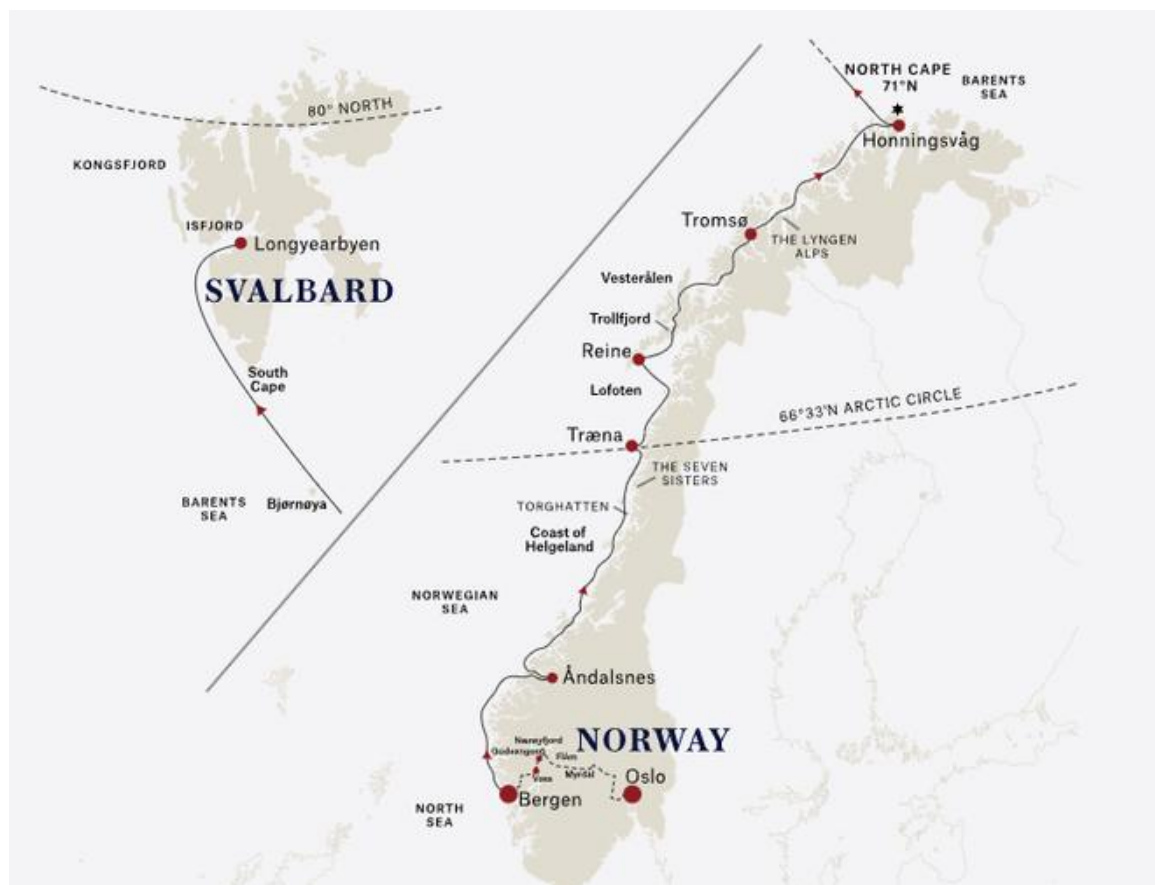

DAY 1

Oslo

Arrive in Oslo



On your first day in Oslo, immerse yourself in Norway's vibrant capital, where culture, history, and modern life blend seamlessly. Explore the Bygdøy Peninsula with its fascinating museums like the Norsk Folkemuseum, wander through Vigeland Sculpture Park with its striking sculptures, or admire panoramic city views and art at Ekeberg Park. Art lovers can't miss the Munch Museum, home to Edvard Munch's world-famous painting *The Scream*. Between sightseeing, enjoy the city's lively neighbourhoods—bohemian Grünerløkka or the sleek Barcode district—filled with cafés, bars, and restaurants. For a unique experience, unwind in a floating sauna on the Oslofjord, setting the perfect tone for your Arctic Norway and Svalbard adventure.

DAY 2

Oslo

Oslo to Flåm via Myrdal

Start your day with a hearty breakfast before boarding the Norway in a Nutshell journey. Travel by train from Oslo to Myrdal, passing farmland, forests, and mountains, before connecting to the world-famous Flåm Railway. This spectacular ride descends roughly half a mile through valleys and past waterfalls, offering some of Norway's most breathtaking scenery before arriving in the fjord village of Flåm.

In Flåm, explore the village at your own pace—visit the Flåm Railway Museum to uncover the story behind this engineering feat, or relax at the local brewery with a craft beer while admiring fjord views. The blend of dramatic landscapes, history, and local flavours makes Flåm a true highlight of your journey.



DAY 3

Flåm

Flåm to Bergen via Gudvangen and Voss

After breakfast, board a scenic ferry from Flåm to Gudvangen and glide through the UNESCO-listed Nærøyfjord, famed for its towering peaks, deep valleys, and cascading waterfalls. From Gudvangen, continue to Voss and then by train to Bergen, Norway's charming gateway to the fjords. Founded in 1070 AD, Bergen is rich in history and atmosphere—wander the UNESCO-listed Bryggen with its colourful wooden wharfs, explore cobblestone alleyways, ride the Fløibanen funicular for sweeping city views, or sample fresh seafood at the lively fish market.



DAY 4

Bergen

Explore Bergen and Embark on MS Trollfjord

Spend the morning enjoying a bit more of Bergen before transferring to the Hurtigruten terminal, where you can relax in the guest lounge and chat with staff about optional excursions. Once aboard, meet the friendly Expedition Team who will guide you on your journey north and settle into your comfortable home-at-sea. As the ship departs, share a meal with fellow travellers and head out on deck with a drink in hand to watch Bergen's colourful skyline slowly disappear on the horizon.



DAY 5

Åndalsnes

Alpine Village by the Fjord

Nestled along the Isfjord, the small town of Åndalsnes offers big scenery with its dramatic mountains and fjords. Embrace Norway's love of the outdoors with a hike to the Rampestreken viewpoint, or take in sweeping vistas more comfortably on the Romsdal Gondola or a bus ride along the winding Trollstigen Pass. However you explore, the day promises breathtaking views of the Isfjord, Romsdalsfjord, and the surrounding peaks.





DAY 6

Træna

Norway's Oldest Fishing Community

Perched on the edge of the Arctic Circle, Træna is a remote archipelago of some 500 islands, with only a handful inhabited year-round. Here, the village opens its doors exclusively for us, inviting you to explore landmarks like the church, Petter Dass chapel, and the local museum, or join optional experiences such as hiking, cultural walks, or even a sauna and invigorating Arctic dip.

Later, as we sail onward, we'll officially cross the Arctic Circle. This milestone will be marked on board with a lighthearted ceremony, celebrating the start of our journey deeper into the Arctic.

DAY 7

Reine



The Tip of Lofoten

Sail into the breathtaking Lofoten Islands, where jagged peaks rise dramatically from the sea and fishing villages dot the coastline. We dock in Reine, famed for its red rorbuer cabins and striking scenery that has made it one of Norway's most photographed destinations.

From here, you may join an optional excursion to Å, a beautifully preserved fishing village at the western tip of Lofoten. Explore the Norwegian Fishing Village Museum to learn how fishing has shaped life here for more than 250 years, offering an authentic glimpse into the archipelago's rich maritime heritage.



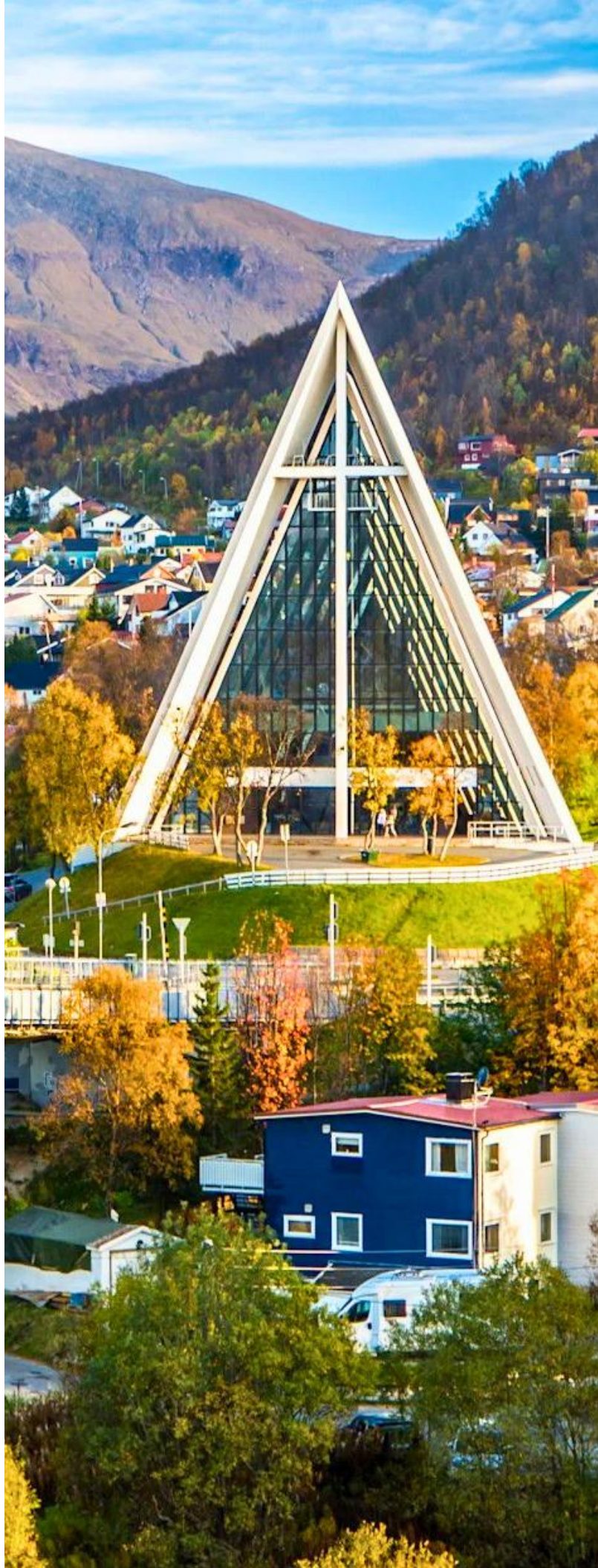
DAY 8

Tromsø

Gateway to the Arctic

Arriving in Tromsø, northern Norway's vibrant Arctic capital, you'll have a full day to explore a city rich in culture, history, and striking scenery. Once a starting point for daring Arctic expeditions, Tromsø today blends historic charm with modern architecture, lively restaurants, and the world's northernmost university.

Choose from a variety of excursions—stroll through the city to uncover its polar heritage, admire the stunning stained-glass of the Arctic Cathedral, or ride the Fjellheisen Cable Car up Storsteinen Mountain for sweeping views of the surrounding fjords and peaks.



DAY 9

Honningsvåg



At the Top of Europe



This morning we arrive in Honningsvåg, the northernmost city on mainland Norway and the gateway to the famous North Cape. Choose from a variety of excursions—ride a bus or quad to the North Cape plateau, join a guided hike with the Expedition Team, or learn about life at 71°N. Standing 307 metres above the sea, the North Cape offers breathtaking views across the Arctic Ocean, just 990 miles from the North Pole.

As we sail onward, enjoy dramatic views of the cliffs from the sea before we leave the Norwegian mainland behind and head into the vast Barents Sea, marking the next stage of our Arctic journey.

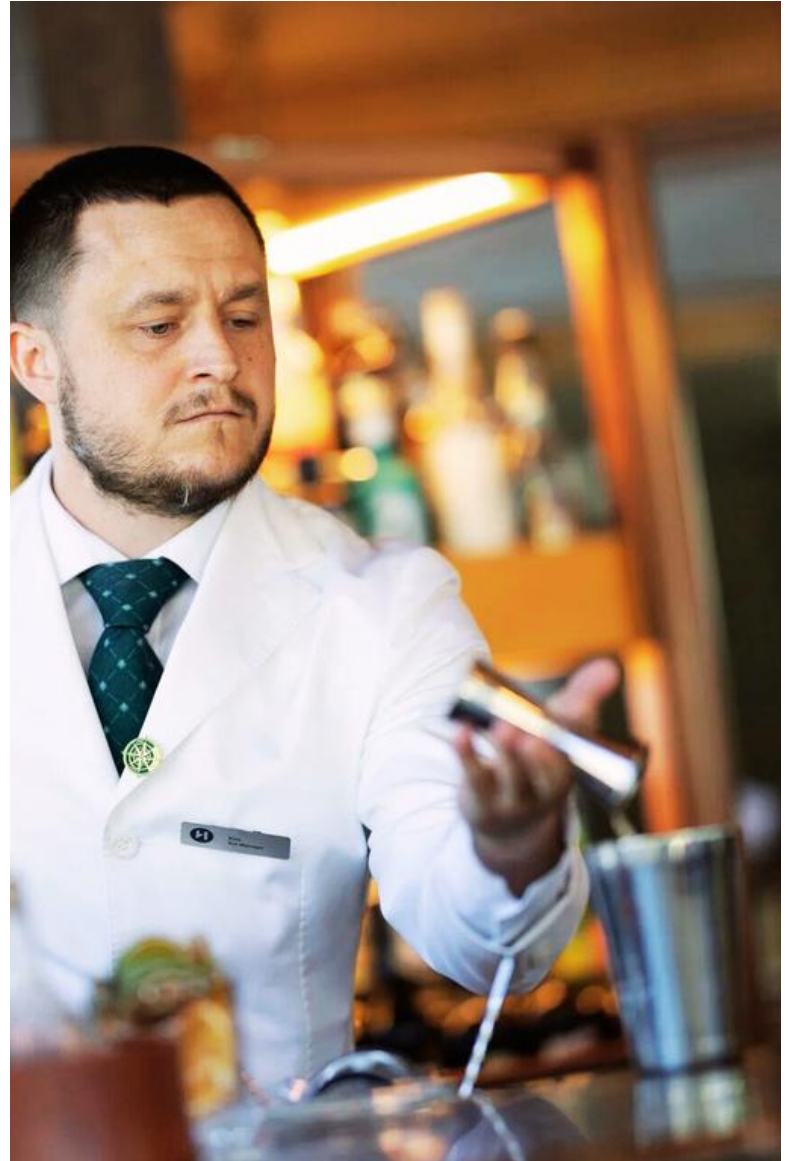
DAY 10

North Sea crossing

Towards the Arctic Frontier

Today we cross the Barents Sea on our way to the remote wilderness of Svalbard, leaving the mainland far behind. This is a day to relax and enjoy life on board, with time to use the ship's facilities, unwind in the sauna, or simply take in the endless Arctic horizon. The Expedition Team will give lectures about Svalbard's unique Arctic desert environment, while our chefs host another special tasting out on deck.

As we sail, look out for Bear Island (Bjørnøya), a stark and rugged outpost with a fascinating history. Later, you'll attend a briefing on the regulations that help protect Svalbard's fragile ecosystem before we arrive in the archipelago. Whether reading in the library, working out in the fitness room, or sharing your photos with fellow guests, today offers the perfect mix of rest, learning, and anticipation for the adventures that await.



DAY 11

Longyearbyen

Arrival in Longyearbyen

On your final day at sea, we sail into the Svalbard archipelago, arriving at Spitsbergen where rugged brown and green mountains rise above the tundra, cut through by sparkling meltwater streams. At over 78°N latitude and less than 1,500 kilometres from the North Pole, this remote Arctic desert offers crisp, clean air and surprisingly mild summer temperatures, warmed by the northern Gulf Stream.

By afternoon we reach Longyearbyen, a former mining town turned lively Arctic settlement on the edge of Isfjord. After disembarking, transfer to the welcoming Funken Lodge, where a lavish dinner awaits—an elegant finale to your Arctic Norway sea voyage.





DAY 12

Longyearbyen

Wildlife and Glacier Tour in Longyearbyen

After breakfast, set out on a Wildlife and Glacier tour aboard the hybrid-electric MS Bard, designed to bring you close to Svalbard's stunning scenery with minimal disturbance. Glide silently through Billefjorden to marvel at the mighty Nordenskiöldbreen glacier and pass the intriguing ghost town of Pyramiden, with panoramic windows and open decks offering unforgettable views of ice, mountains, and wildlife.

Later, return to Longyearbyen for a remarkable culinary finale: a 14-course tasting menu at Huset, the town's iconic restaurant. Featuring Arctic ingredients and paired with wines from one of Scandinavia's largest cellars, this dining experience is the perfect way to celebrate the end of your extraordinary Arctic voyage.

After an incredible journey from Oslo through fjords, mountains, and the Arctic wilderness, it's time to bid farewell. A transfer will take you to the airport for your onward journey, carrying with you unforgettable memories of Norway and Svalbard—and the hope that we'll welcome you back on another adventure soon.
