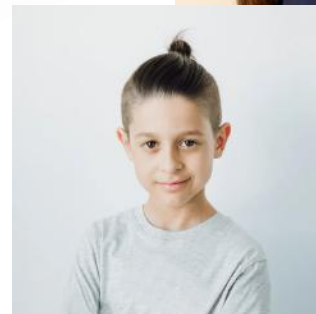


Expectations

Home Learning

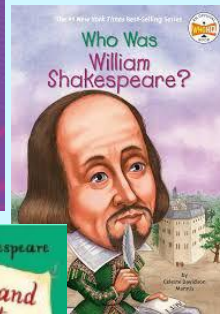
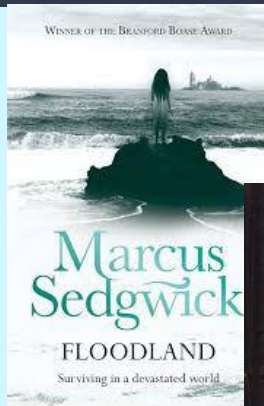
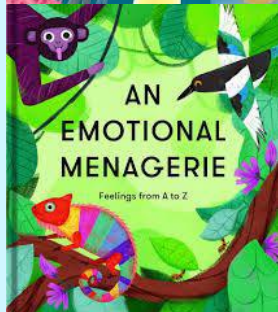
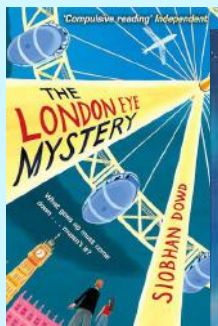
- Every Thursday, there will be 1 piece of English and 1 piece of maths homework to be completed for the following week.
- Every Thursday, spellings will be live on Spelling Shed – children need to practise a minimum of 5 times each week on separate days.
- Children are expected to read for at least 20 minutes per day and record their reading in their reading records. They must bring their reading book and reading record into school every day.
- Occasionally, there will be an IPC Home Project to complete over a couple of weeks.
