IPSWICH WANDERERS CLUB HISTORY

- 1980** ▶ The Club started as an under 14's boys team in 1980. Two yrs later they entered the lowest division of the Ipswich Sunday League.
- 1987** ▶ Joined the newly formed Eastern Counties Division One sponsored by Jewsons in 1987 as founder members.
- 1994** ▶ Home games were played at our present ground at Humber Doucy Lane, under the name of Loadwell Ipswich. Jimmy Barker became a very influential chairman and he negotiated a name change to Lancaster Ipswich FC before we eventually became Ipswich Wanderers. Jimmy died in November 1994 and his presence is sadly missed. Thankfully after all his work he saw the floodlights switched on in September 1994 in a match against Ipswich Town.
- ▶ Great ground improvements were made in the early years under the direction of Development Officer Roger Woshalo and ground Manager Tim Davey.
- 1996-97** ▶ A losing Suffolk Senior Cup appearance in 1996/97 lead to the following season becoming Champions of Division One, under the Chairmanship of Alan Haste, nine points clear of Maldon Town and losing only three league matches all season. Reaping the rewards of a successful youth policy which saw numerous trophies filling the clubhouse cabinet, a well organised side with a good balance between youth and experience saw us establish ourselves as a Premier Division side for a number of seasons until we suffered relegation on the last day of the 2002/3 season at Wisbech.
- 2005-06** ▶ The following season saw Jason Dozzell join the Club as Manager and after a midtable finish in his first campaign, the second season saw the Club sweep to the 1st Division title and with the assistance of Kevin Cunningham and Glynn Hague, the team finished 7th in the Premier Division in 2005/6, with the League's second best defence with home crowds on average exceeding 100.
- 2006-07** ▶ At the end of the 2005/6 Jason Dozzell and Chairman David Bugg left. Local businessman Ed Nicholls became Chairman and John Clarkson was appointed Manager having arrived with a reputation from the West Country. During the season he guided the club to the final of the Riddletons League Cup, the 5th round of the FA Vase and a Suffolk Premier Cup Semi Final against Ipswich Town.
- 2007-08** ▶ At the end of the campaign John left the Club and with an exodus of players, the Club appointed ex player Louis Newman to the role. Louis built a young, inexperienced squad and after a poor start to the campaign which included some record defeats, was replaced by another former player Steve Buckle who was brought in to rebuild the squad and hopefully retain the Clubs' premier status. Unfortunately Steve was unable to prevent relegation and the only positive from the season was the Reserves capture of the Chell Trophy defeating Wroxham.
- 2011-12** ▶ Despite Steve's best efforts over the following few seasons the Club failed to build a promotion push throughout the campaigns and after a poor start to the 2011/12 season, Steve and Assistant Paul Grainger parted company with the Club. New chairman Terry Fenwick appointed Glenn Read and he brought in his own players and former Stowmarket Town boss Steve Jay as his assistant. He quickly revamped the squad and had the Club climbing the table before the end of the season.
- 2012-13** ▶ The 2012/3 season saw the Club just fail to clinch promotion to the Premier Division and lose on penalties in the semi final in the First Division Cup. The season did finish on a high as the Club clinched its first ever Suffolk Senior Cup trophy defeating local rivals Whitton United in the final. It was a remarkable victory coming from a goal down in normal time and then from 3-0 down in the penalty shoot out.
- 2013-14** ▶ 2013/14 saw promotion achieved with two long unbeaten runs ensuring a return to the Premier Division, we also lost a tight Senior Cup final against Whitton United and set a new club record with a 12-1 win over Downham Town.
- 2014-15** ▶ The 2014/15 was mixed as we adapted to Premier Division and finished 9th and enjoyed a good run in the FA Vase but off field the club lost one of its driving forces Roger Woshalo mid-season.
- 2015-16** ▶ In 2015-16 we defeated Canvey Island in the FA Cup and enjoy our best ever FA Vase run but with a heavy fixture backlog, relegation fears were only ended just before the season end. Glenn stepped down at the end of the season and for 2016-17 the Club appointed Shane Wardley as Player/Manager.
- 2017-18** ▶ Shane's first season saw us almost emulate our highest ever position, however, after a poor start to the 2017-18 season Shane resigned and following a disastrous spell under Mark Benterman, club legend Mark Goldfinch took over the side ably assisted by James Buckle and Daniel Thrower. Unfortunately, relegation could not be avoided and in 2018-19 we consolidated and lost in the Senior Cup Semi Final to Cornard.
- 2019-20** ▶ In 2019-20 with Stephen Boyle taking over as Chairman, we rebuilt and after a sticky spell in October we were closing in on the promotion pack and reached a Semi Final of the Suffolk Senior Cup before the season came to an abrupt end. With further additions on field and some good improvements off field under Stephen's leadership, we then looked to gain the vital promotion required for us to take the next steps forward with a good squad. The start to the next season was positive and a second Senior Cup trophy was clinched in the delayed final with a single strike from Connor Field clinching the trophy.
- 2021-22** ▶ After a couple of Covid-19 disrupted and curtailed seasons, for the 2021/22 season Wanderers went into action in the Thurlow Nunn First Division South. With what became a tight run affair and particular rivalry with Buckhurst Hill also aiming for the title, it went almost to the wire, Wanderers finally having the upper hand, and lifting the trophy with a goal 10 seconds from time in the final home game. With the final of the Suffolk Senior Cup to follow, we finished the season with 26 straight wins, and a well deserved double of league and cup was won!
- 2022-23** ▶ The following season started with four cup fixtures in the opening 7 games, and a haul of just 3 points from the first 5 league games meant Wanderers were already playing catch up when our league campaign really got going. A run of 6 wins in an 8 game unbeaten run helped to move us up the table before another rare defeat. More wins followed until in January, we visited top of the table Thetford, which ended in a 1-2 defeat. After this, Wanderers embarked on another 17-game winning run to the end of the season, including coming from behind to avenge the result against Thetford, going above them and ultimately become Thurlow Nunn Premier winners - back to back champions - and into Step 4 football for the first time in the club's history.
- 2023-24** ▶ The 2023/24 season, the first for the club in the Isthmian League North came with added pressure - both on and off the pitch. A poor start to the season on the pitch brought a change in September, with the departure of Mark Goldfinch & James Buckle. Glen Driver came in as manager, with the task of keeping the club clear of relegation. Off the pitch was a mammoth job with a huge amount of work needed to pass the ground grading requirements to stay at this level. The inspection in April brought a great deal of relief, and along with the efforts of Glen and his team on the pitch, meant the aims for the season were achieved.
- 2024-26** ▶ The following season saw us suffer relegation a poor run of results saw Glen Driver resign and Michael Brothers come in but whilst results improved we couldn't stay up. Last season saw a bright start under Michael Brothers but results stagnated and following his departure Jack Wignall steadied the ship before the club were delighted to welcome back Mark Goldfinch and James Buckle who masterminded a long unbeaten run which narrowly failed to reach the playoffs. Optimism is high as we enter 26-27 looking for a positive campaign off the back of those results.

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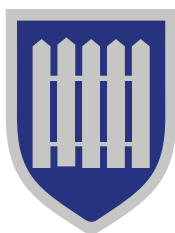

CLUB HISTORY

The Club was founded in 1887, and were founder members of the Ipswich & District League, winning Division Two of the league in 1898. The club adopted the name Brantham Crown for some time and returned to Division One of the Ipswich & District League in 1905. In 1906 they reverted to their original name, and the following year left the Ipswich & District League again to join Division Two of the South East Anglian League. They returned to Division One of the Ipswich & District League for the 1908-09 season, but left again in 1910 to join the Harwich & District League. After playing in it for a single season they joined the Essex & Suffolk Border League, before switching back to Division Two of the Ipswich & District League in 1912, also playing in Division Two of the (now renamed) East Anglian League, winning both in 1913-14.

After World War I the club played in the Ipswich & District League from 1919 until 1925, the year in which they reached the final of the Suffolk Senior Cup, losing 1-0 to Kirkley. That year they also switched back to the Essex & Suffolk Border League. The club won the Senior Cup in 1927 with a 3-0 win over Lowestoft Town. After finishing bottom of the Essex & Suffolk Border League in 1931-32 they returned to the Ipswich & District League. After World War II they re-joined the Essex & Suffolk Border League. They won the Essex & Suffolk Border League Cup in 1948-49, beating Colchester United 4-0 in the final.[3] The club won the Senior Cup for a second time in 1959-60, defeating Christchurch Athletic 3-2.[4] In 1972-73 they won the Essex & Suffolk Border League and retained the title the following season. In 1975-76 they won the league again, also winning the League Cup (with a 1-0 win against Wivenhoe Town after extra time) and the Senior Cup. A league and League Cup double was repeated the following season, with Brantham beating Wivenhoe's 2-0 in the cup final.

The club applied to join the Eastern Counties League in 1977, but were rejected as the ECL secretary claimed that they wouldn't "attract people to watch them in other parts of the region". However, the following year they were successful and were

admitted to the league. They achieved their highest-ever finish of fourth in 1982-83, the same season in which they reached the fifth round of the FA Vase, losing 1-0 at home to VS Rugby in front of a then-record crowd of 594. The following season they won the Suffolk Premier Cup, beating Lowestoft Town 2-0. When the league gained a second tier in 1988, the club was placed in the Premier Division. However, they were relegated to Division One in 1992-93 after finishing second from bottom.

Two years later they were relegated to the Suffolk & Ipswich League after finishing eighteenth out of 19 clubs. Suffering from financial problems, the club merged with SIL club Stutton to become Brantham & Stutton United. After winning the League Cup in 1997, the club reverted to its old name in 1998. They were relegated to Division One in 1999-2000, and despite making an immediate return to the Senior Division, they were relegated again the following season. They were promoted to the Senior Division after finishing second in 2004-05. They won the title in 2007-08, and were promoted back to the Eastern Counties League. After finishing third in 2009-10, the club were promoted to the Premier Division.

The Club secured the Eastern Counties Cup 2018 with a 4-2 win over Thetford Town. After two truncated seasons through the global Pandemic, the club managed to find way through with help from all behind the scenes and have come out a stronger club. We went in to the 2023/24 season full of optimism and hope, knowing it's going to be a hard one, but led by the newly appointed Chairman Roger Peck off the field and by 1st Team Manager Pip Boyland on the pitch, unfortunately the season got away from us and at Christmas we parted company with Pip and his team. Roger and Darren appointed interim management of Stef, Duncan and Kirk to hold the fort until new management team of Tom Austin & Jack Sibbons could take the reins.

2024/2025

Optimism was for a steady season, perhaps the play-offs but no one could foresee the season ahead. Jack & Tom gelled together a group of talented and committed players. As the season went on, the

play-offs became the objective for the committee, but Jack & Tom had different ideas – promotion was their sole agenda. So we enter the last game of the season, had having had the chance to win the league a few weeks earlier, but results went against us. Last game, sitting 2nd on goal difference 3 to Fakenham, could we overturn such a difference – well 3 up by half time, with Fakenham 2 up....goal difference now -2 – by full time 6-0 win, Fakenham won, but only 2-1 – therefore, champions with a 5 goal swing.... euphoria erupted around the ground. Tom, Jack and all those players and coaches will be forever legends of the club.

2025/2026

Now with new management team of Kevin Coyle and Alex Rossi and a new set of players, we started our first season at Step 4. We knew it would be a challenge, but the club and management were up for that. Unfortunately, as is the case sometimes with football, new management teams don't work out and that is what happened here, we have no doubt that Kev and Alex along with Liam and JJ worked hard behind the scenes and off the pitch, but results is what it is all about and we had to make a tough decision for the benefit of the team and the club. In October 2025, Michael Brothers and Craig Clarke returned to the club as joint managers to take us forward. Unfortunately they were unable to keep us

up, despite some promising performances, and we were relegated back to step 5 and the Thurlow Nunn League.

2026/2027

Michael and Craig begin this season with their own players, hoping to return to Step 4 once again.

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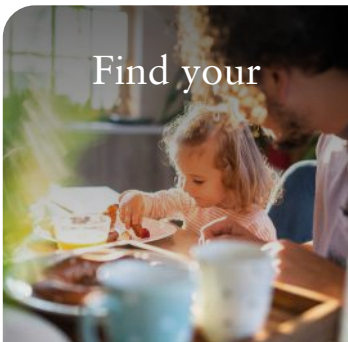

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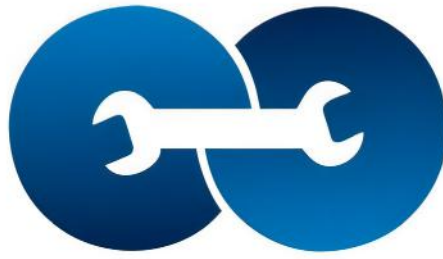
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On this day in IWFC History
