JOINT SEALING

Where you have new or existing construction joints in road surfaces made from asphalt or concrete it is necessary to fill and seal them appropriately.

Joint Sealing not only allows the surface to tolerate expansion and contraction but also protects the joint from water damage, prevents the joint from failing due to other surface applications such as de-icer or from surface spillages.

Jointline provide joint sealing in a variety of ways:

- > **Hot Applied N1 and N2 Sealants:**
Hot applied N1 and N2 sealants are used to maintain and repair joints in concrete or asphalt surfaces and are particularly used on highways, airfields and car parks. These hot applied sealants are fully BS EN14188-1 compliant. They have excellent expansion and contraction qualities and are effective at preventing damage resulting from water and dirt. These joint sealants can be quickly and simply applied at any time of year and cure quickly, helping to minimise disruption to traffic or users of the area to be treated.
- > **Cold Applied Fuel Resistant Joint Sealants:**
If the area to be treated has a high likelihood of fuel spillages i.e. Oil terminals, garage forecourts, parking and cargo areas then we would apply a fuel resistant sealant using a cold application method. As with the N1 and N2 sealants the contraction and expansion properties provide joint protection from water, dirt and more importantly kerosene, petrol and aircraft fuel.

As well as simply sealing joints Jointline have specialist saw cutting equipment to:

- > Create joints in new/green concrete to enable the surface to deal with expansion and contraction
- > Chase out or existing concrete cracks before sealing them or overbanding them
- > Reform existing joints to effectively reapply sealant.





OVERBANDING

Jointline can protect your surfaces with our HAPAS approved materials.

Overbanding is a process used to seal cracks in a road or surface which may be:

- > Spontaneous from wear and tear and require repair; or
- > Where works have been carried out and the joint between the old surface and new surface need sealing

Overbanding these cracks is vital and serves to prevent damage and surface fretting from water, dirt or spillage penetration. Overbanding effectively seals the joint and overlaps the two sides of the joint up to 200mm. This ensures that nothing can get into the crack and further degrade the surface.

Overbanding these cracks is vital and serves to prevent:

1. Using hot applied Bituminous material to seal and overband the crack
2. Using cold applied resins

The method chosen will depend on the project characteristics; the type of materials either side of the crack to be overbanded and how the surface is used i.e. car park versus airport fuelling area.

Jointline take health & safety very seriously and both of their overbanding methods are HAPAS approved, with high skid resistance values necessary to conform to requirements. This helps prevent any road users from slipping or skidding on the overbanded area particularly in wet conditions.
