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YOUR GUIDE TO BUYING A CARAVAN

Expert advice and essential tips for choosing your first (or next!) leisure vehicle — and why a show is the best place to buy.

THINKING OF BUYING a caravan? The Malvern Caravan & Motorhome Show is the perfect place to start your journey.

Here's everything you need to know to choose the right tourer for your lifestyle — and a handy checklist to take with you on the day.

TYPES & LAYOUTS TO LOOK OUT FOR

When walking around the show, take time to explore different caravan layouts so you can find the one that suits you best. Seeing them side-by-side is invaluable.

✓ **Two-berth** – Compact, lighter, easier to tow; often convertible or parallel seating — ideal for couples or solo travellers.

✓ **Four-berth** – Flexible layouts, with fixed beds or convertible lounges — perfect for small families or longer trips.

✓ **Six-berth / Bunk beds** – Extra sleeping capacity with more weight — great for larger families or groups.

✓ **Island / French / Transverse beds** – Different fixed bed options with varying access and washroom layouts — choose for comfort preferences.

✓ **Twin beds** – Often with a rear washroom, popular with couples or teens wanting separate beds.

✓ **Side-diner bunks** – Dinette converts into bunks with a curtain partition — brilliant for families with young children.

✓ **Two lounges** – Front and rear seating areas convert into beds — ideal for families wanting flexible day/night use.

TOP TIP: If you're tall, take a tape measure. Brochure bed lengths don't always match the usable mattress size, so check in person that beds are long enough.

KEY THINGS TO CHECK WHILE YOU'RE HERE

Bring a notebook or take photos as you explore to help you compare later. Consider:

✓ **Berths & sleeping spaces** – Enough beds for everyone and easy to make up?

✓ **Layout & storage** – Space for clothes, bikes or pets? Easy to move around inside?

✓ **Kitchen & washroom** – Practical for the way you like to tour?

✓ **Heating & insulation** – Will it keep you comfortable in all seasons?

✓ **Weight & towing** – Is it within your car's towing limit and your licence category?

✓ **Rooflights & windows** – Do they open and close smoothly and stay watertight?

✓ **Chassis & A-frame** – Free of rust or corrosion?

✓ **Water & heating systems** – Ask for a demonstration to check pressure and warmth.

✓ **New or pre-owned?**

At the show you'll find both, giving you the widest possible choice.

EXPLORE, TEST AND TAKE NOTES

A caravan is a significant investment — possibly second only to your home — so give yourself time to really get to know each model on your shortlist.

- ✓ Take photos and notes to remember layouts and features
- ✓ Sit inside to gauge how the lounge and dining areas feel
- ✓ Lie on the beds to check comfort and ease of making them up
- ✓ Step into the washroom to test shower and toilet practicality
- ✓ Open cupboards and lockers to assess storage and hinge quality
- ✓ Check the floor by gently pressing to ensure it feels solid
- ✓ Evaluate light and ventilation — open rooflights and windows
- ✓ Ask about towing weights, heating, warranties and servicing

Can my car tow a caravan?

Matching your car and caravan is essential for safe, legal and stress-free touring.

Before you fall in love with a layout, make sure your car is up to the job.

- ✓ **Use our free Towmatch tool** to check compatibility. Simply enter your car and caravan details to see whether the combination works, including key figures like Maximum Technically Permissible Laden Mass (MTPLM) and noseweight.

BUYING CHECKLIST

Use this quick list to help guide your decision:

- ☐ 1. Is the layout right for how you travel?
- ☐ 2. Are the beds comfortable and easy to make up?
- ☐ 3. Is there enough storage for everything you'll bring?
- ☐ 4. Does it fit within your towing and licence limits?
- ☐ 5. Is the kitchen and washroom set-up practical?
- ☐ 6. What warranty and servicing support are included?
- ☐ 7. Are there exclusive show offers or upgrades available?
- ☐ 8. Have you compared similar models side-by-side?
- ☐ 9. Have you checked for signs of damp or leaks around windows, doors and floor edges?
- ☐ 10. Are the tyres in good condition and the chassis and A-frame free from corrosion?
- ☐ 11. Do all appliances, lighting, heating and water systems work as expected?
- ☐ 12. Is the CRiS registration and all documentation complete and correct?
- ☐ 13. Does the payload give enough safe carrying capacity for water, gas and accessories?
- ☐ 14. Is the insulation and heating adequate for the seasons you plan to tour in?
- ☐ 15. Have you confirmed delivery times, after-sales support and what's included in the handover?
- ☐ 16. Are the windows, doors and rooflights easy to open, close and lock securely?
- ☐ 17. Is the awning rail intact and free of damage so accessories will fit properly?
- ☐ 18. Are corner steadies and the jockey wheel smooth to operate and free of corrosion?
- ☐ 19. Is the hitch, handbrake and coupling mechanism working correctly and well maintained?
- ☐ 20. Does the overall style, finish and comfort match the way you want to use the caravan for years to come?

✓ **Gross Train Weight (GTW):** Found on your car's weight plate. Subtract your car's Maximum Authorised Mass (MAM) from GTW to find its maximum towing capacity.

✓ **Noseweight:** The downward force on the towbar should be around 5–7 % of your caravan's MTPLM. Use a gauge or scales to check and adjust loading to stay within safe limits.

✓ **Top tip for first-time caravanners:** aim to keep the caravan's MTPLM under 85 % of your car's kerbweight for the most stable towing experience.

Dealers at the Malvern Caravan & Motorhome Show can help with these figures, so you can cross-check straight

away and make sure your dream tourer is a safe, sensible match for your current vehicle.

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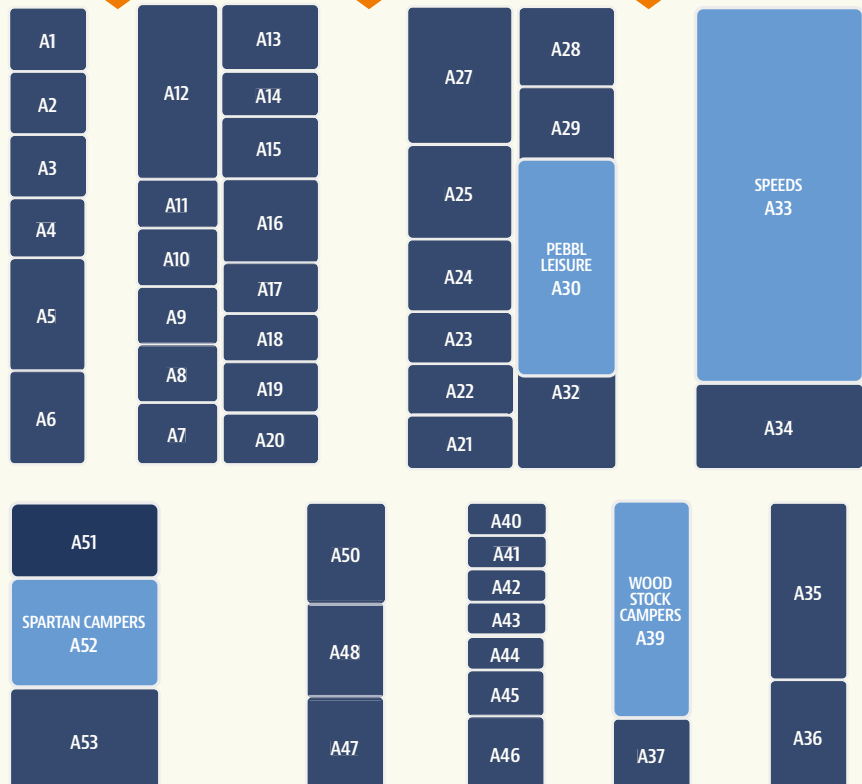
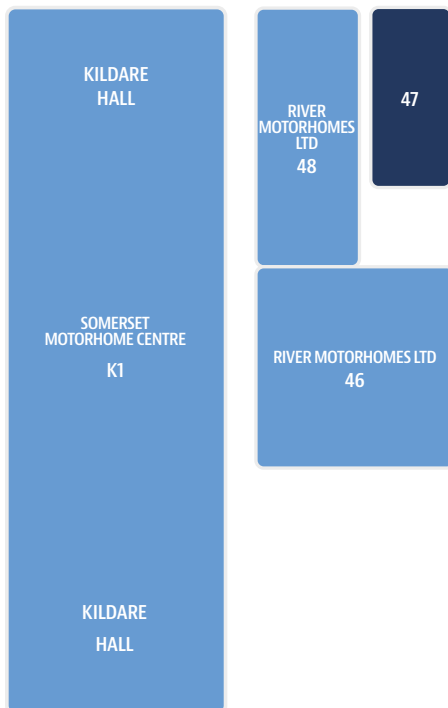

MOTORHOMES AND WINTER

Whether you're carrying on touring through the colder months or putting your motorhome away until spring, a little preparation now can help protect your 'van and keep you comfortable throughout winter.

WINTER MOTORHOMING HAS plenty going for it – fewer crowds, quieter roads and easier campsite bookings – but colder temperatures bring additional considerations, particularly when it comes to water, heating and power.

PROTECT YOUR WATER SYSTEM

When temperatures drop below freezing, your water system is particularly vulnerable. Frost can damage taps, shower heads, pumps, tanks and boilers, potentially leaving you with an expensive repair bill.

If you're laying up your motorhome, empty the fresh and waste water tanks and make sure the boiler frost

drain valve is open or set to automatic. Pay particular attention to exposed pipework and underslung tanks.

If you're continuing to tour, tank insulation and heaters can offer extra protection. Electrically heated mats can be fitted externally to tanks, while exposed pipes can be combined with insulation and 12V pipe heaters. Just remember that heaters will place additional demands on your power supply when camping off-grid.

WHAT DOES GRADE 3 INSULATION MEAN?

Grade 3 doesn't mean your motorhome is completely winter-proof. Under the UK EN1645-1 standard, it means the

vehicle's heating and insulation should maintain an internal temperature of 20°C when it's -15°C outside. Grade 2 achieves the same internal temperature when it's 0°C outside.

KEEP WARM – SAFELY

Heating can use a lot of energy during extended stays in cold weather, so electric hook-up can be particularly useful, with gas or diesel supplementing your supply where necessary.

Simple additions can make a noticeable difference to comfort. A good-quality external windscreen cover can help reduce condensation, while insulation around rooflights, pop-tops and wheel arches can help tackle cold spots.



Never block essential ventilation and never use your gas hob, oven or a charcoal barbecue to heat your motorhome.

WINTER TOP TIPS

- ✓ Use an external windscreen cover
- ✓ Protect exposed tanks and pipework
- ✓ Keep essential ventilation clear
- ✓ Monitor your leisure battery
- ✓ Check heating and frost-protection settings

POWER AND GAS

Cold weather reduces battery efficiency, making it particularly important to keep your batteries healthy. Plugging into the mains is ideal where possible, while a good battery-to-battery charging system can replenish power while you drive.

Don't rely too heavily on solar either. Shorter days and the lower winter sun mean panels won't perform as efficiently, while snow and ice can reduce output further.

For gas, propane is the better winter choice because butane stops gassing effectively as temperatures approach freezing. In snowy conditions, also check that external air intakes and exhaust vents for your heating and hot-water systems remain clear.

PUTTING YOUR MOTORHOME AWAY?

If your touring season is over, a few simple jobs can help keep your

motorhome in good condition until spring.

Give the interior a thorough clean and remove food that could attract rodents. Switch off the fridge and leave its door slightly open to prevent mould, and encourage airflow by lifting mattresses and cushions and opening lower locker doors where appropriate. A dehumidifier or moisture absorber can also help combat condensation.

It's also worth giving seals and the toilet cassette some attention before storage. Chocking the wheels and leaving the handbrake off can help prevent brakes binding. If possible, take the motorhome for a decent drive periodically rather than simply starting the engine – this can help charge the batteries, air the vehicle and prevent mechanical components from seizing.

DRIVING THIS WINTER

For UK touring, start with the basics: top up with winter screenwash, check your radiator antifreeze and make sure your tyres are ready for colder conditions.

Winter tyres offer improved grip when temperatures fall below 7°C, while four-season tyres can provide a compromise for those who don't want to swap between two sets.

Heading into Europe? Winter tyre, snow chain and snow sock rules vary between countries and even regions, so always check the latest requirements for your route before travelling.
