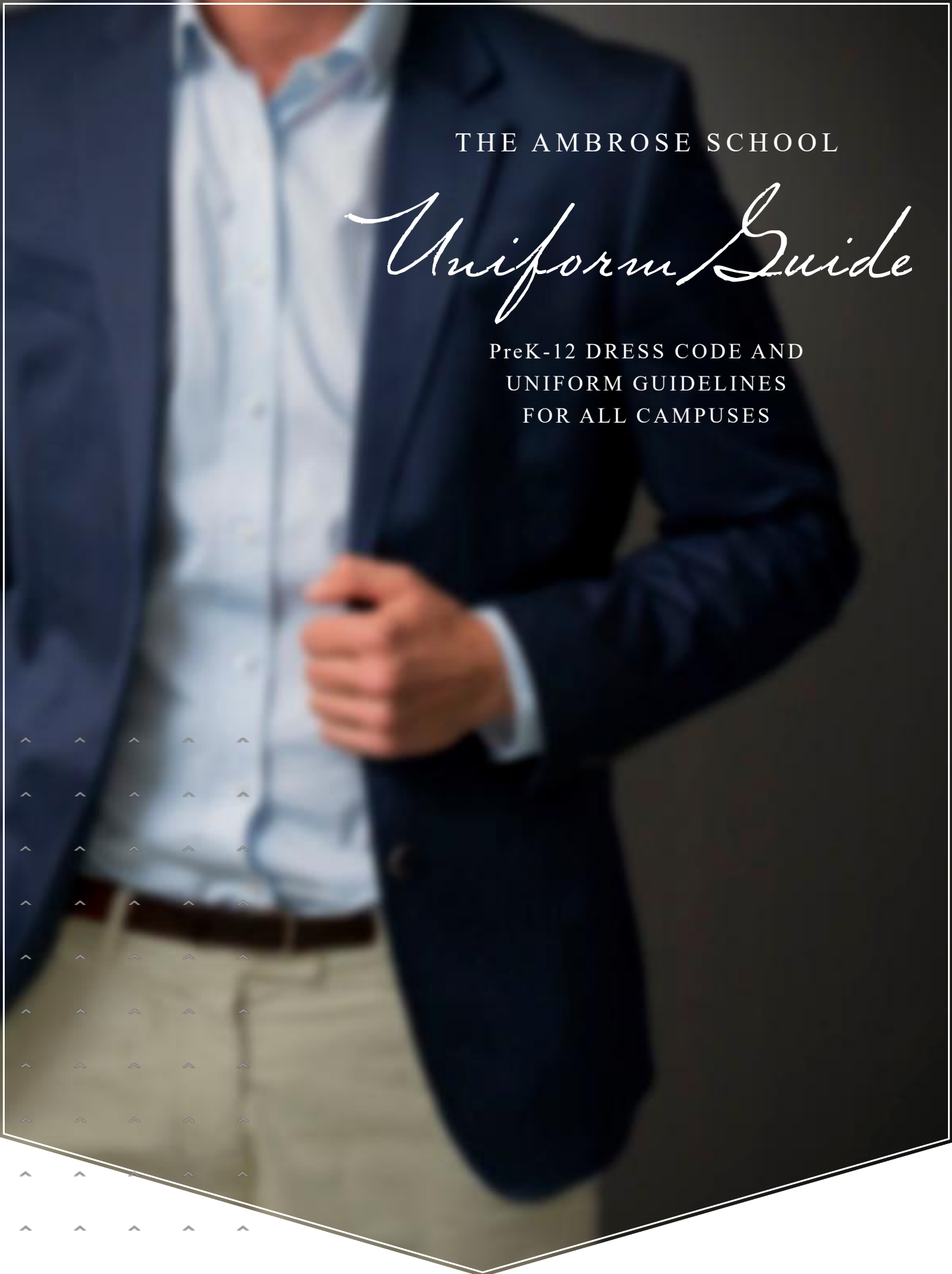

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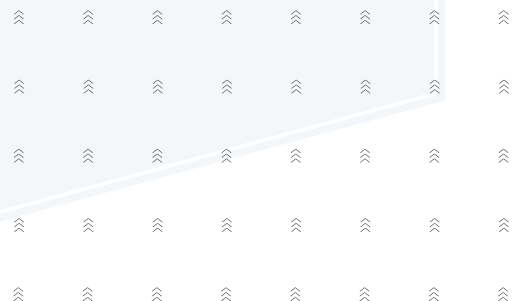
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WHY WE WEAR UNIFORMS

Since its inception, The Ambrose School has required uniforms for several key reasons:

- Clarity and Modesty** – Uniforms eliminate subjective dress standards and ensure consistency.
- Academic Focus** – The uniform reinforces a structured environment oriented toward learning.
- Unity** – Students are encouraged to value community over individual expression, reducing distractions and fostering cohesion.
- Cost Efficiency** – Most families find two to three sets sufficient. Used items are available through the Uniform & Logowear Store at the Locust Grove Campus.

UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

- Uniforms must be worn as intended and kept neat, clean, and modest.
- All students must wear formal uniforms **every Wednesday** and for other designated events.
- Informal uniform items may be worn on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday unless otherwise directed by a teacher or administrator.
- All visible K-12 uniform items must be purchased from **approved suppliers** listed in the Uniform Guide. *Please see the Pre-K page for Pre-K purchasing information, which is unique.*
- All students must remain in uniform while at the school (see the *Parent Student Handbook* for a limited number of exceptions).

UNIFORM GUIDELINES & SUPPLIERS

All visible uniform items must be purchased from one of the approved uniform suppliers below or from the Uniform Closet. **Please note that Old Navy is not one of our approved uniform suppliers.** If you have any questions, please contact our Uniform Coordinator at uniformcoordinator@theambroseschool.org.

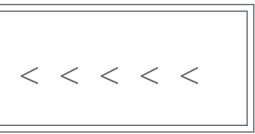

WHAT TO WEAR AND WHEN TO WEAR IT



Please note that all students on all campuses must wear their formal uniform every Wednesday. Informal options cannot be worn on Wednesdays.

REQUIRED FORMAL UNIFORMS

- Must be worn **every Wednesday** (may also be worn every day of the week).
- Special school events, field trips, or community events will require a formal uniform unless otherwise specified by the teacher.

OPTIONAL INFORMAL UNIFORMS

- May be worn on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday unless otherwise directed by a teacher or administrator.
- Boys shorts may be worn on non-formal days *before* fall break and *after* spring break.

ARCHER LOGOWEAR

- Grammar School students may only wear Archer logo wear in the classroom for dedicated events and spirit days.
- Upper School students may wear Archer sweatshirts and hoodies in the classroom every Friday after Christmas break and before spring break.

HOUSE LOGOWEAR (UPPER SCHOOL ONLY)

- Upper School students are required to wear House t-shirts during House activities that take place during the school day.
- House hoodies may be worn in the classroom every Friday after Christmas break and before spring break.

UNIFORM DRESS CODE AND APPEARANCE



Uniforms, including shoes, shall be worn as intended and kept neat, clean, and in good condition. The following should be noted in particular:

MISSING BUTTONS

- Button replacements are available at the Uniform & Logowear Store.

GIRLS JUMPERS, SKIRTS, AND KILTS

- The hemline must reach **to the knee**. Ordering a larger size will not make the skirt longer—if a skirt is too short, you must order the tall (XL), which is 2" longer.

BOYS PANTS

- No holes or stains.
- Pants must be purchased from the approved uniform suppliers. They may not be made of denim or denim-like fabric and may not have cargo-type pockets.
- Pants should reach at least the **top of the shoe**, with no excessively short pants or cuffed pants. We realize that boys grow quickly, and by spring, they sometimes have "high waters." If this is the case, please purchase new (or used) pants if the hemline is more than 1" above the top of the shoe.
- Pants should not be excessively tight or baggy. No undergarment or pocket lines should show because the fabric is too tight. Stand straight and pinch 1/2" to 1 inch of fabric on either side of the thigh—if it is less than that, the pants are too tight.

Students are asked to dress appropriately for the event's decorum and to keep both the spirit of the event and practical considerations in mind when choosing apparel.

- Leggings can only be worn under a skirt or dress.

- No tight or see-through shirts.
- No sleeveless shirts.
- The front and back necklines of tops must be modestly cut.
- No midriffs showing.

- Students must wear loose-fitting pants or shorts, with shorts longer than the tips of their fingers when

- Shoes must be closed-toe with heels no taller than 1/2".

This standard helps minimize distractions and discourages social divisions tied to trends or preferences. Teachers may also limit toys or items that disrupt the school environment.

NON-UNIFORM GUIDELINES

DRESS CODE CLASSIFICATIONS

General guidelines for each dress category are given below. Please refer to teacher communications for additional guidelines particular to specific events (class trips, classroom events, dances, graduation, etc.).

CASUAL

A casual dress code refers to clothing that is informal and comfortable yet clean with no holes, rips, or tears. (Jeans, t-shirt, etc.) Sweatpants, joggers, or pajama pants are not allowed unless otherwise specified.

Most of our events are casual. Please see the general guidelines on the left when dressing for Ambrose events.

BUSINESS CASUAL

Business casual typically means collared shirts with pants or skirts. It is the equivalent to our informal uniforms.

GIRLS ATTIRE

- Skirt or dress pants
- Collared shirt, knit shirt or sweater (*no sleeveless*)
- Dress (*middle of the knee or longer*)
- Jumpsuit or pant suit
- Dress shoes (*flats or heels*)

BOYS ATTIRE

- Slacks or khakis
- Dress shirt, casual button-down shirt, or polo shirt
- Tie (*optional*)
- Optional sportcoat or blazer
- Dress shoes (*not sneakers*)

BUSINESS FORMAL

Business formal is characterized by a suit jacket with matching pants or a skirt. The darker the suit, the more formal. It is the equivalent to our formal uniforms.

GIRLS ATTIRE

- Pant suit or skirt suit (*must reach the middle of the kneecap or longer*)
- Dress with jacket (*must reach the middle of the kneecap or longer*)
- Jumpsuit with jacket
- Dress shoes (*flats or heels*)

BOYS ATTIRE

- Business suit
- Matching vest (*optional*)
- Dress shirt
- Tie
- Dress shoes (*not sneakers*)

SEMI-FORMAL

Semi-formal attire is more elevated than office wear but more flexible than formal wear. The Winter Dance is typically semi-formal.

FORMAL

Formal attire is the most elegant and elevated and is typically reserved for evening events such as Protocol.

ACCESSORIES, JEWELRY & HAIR

The Ambrose School expects students to express themselves with their mind and character, not their grooming, accessories, or dress. Both boys and girls are expected to keep their hair well-groomed, clean, and out of their faces.

Accessories and jewelry, if worn, should tastefully complement the uniform and not draw attention.

ACCEPTABLE

JEWELRY

Girls may wear jewelry that is small, simple, and not distracting. Boys may not wear visible jewelry except for simple bracelets.



HAIR ACCESSORIES

Any hair accessory that coordinates with school uniforms is acceptable. If a hair accessory is distracting, a teacher may ask the student to remove it. These are a few examples of acceptable hair accessories.

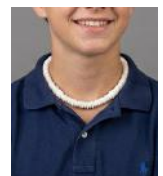

PRE-K GIRLS & BOYS

Pre-K students have looser uniform guidelines than our K-12 students. We ask that all Pre-K students wear **plain navy polo shirts and khaki pants, skirts, or shorts**. Recommended suppliers include the Old Navy Uniform Shop, Lands' End, Skobel's, and Flynn O'Hara, but any item similar to the ones below is acceptable.
