Services are also livestreamed to our YouTube Page.

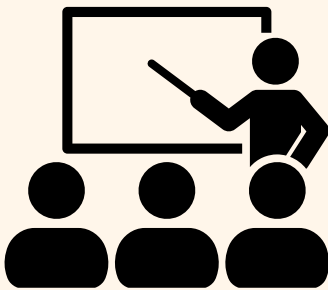


NEW MEMBER CLASS!

All children and youth in 3rd grade and up are invited to be an acolyte. Our Acolytes at CPC serve by lighting and extinguishing the candles in the sanctuary as part of the worship service. The light represents the Light of Christ, reminding all of us that God is with us in worship. Look for the acolyte sign up in our weekly email.

WORSHIPING WITH CHILDREN

Kids are always welcome at CPC! We love the energy, questions, wiggles, and joy they bring to worship. There's no expectation that children sit perfectly still or quietly the whole time—we're glad they're here!

Children are welcome to stay with their families throughout worship. Busy Bags are available at the front and back of the sanctuary with activities for little hands, and worship bulletins help older kids follow along with the theme of the service.

Each Sunday, children are invited to join us for a Children's Conversation during worship. Afterward, children age 6 and under can head to the nursery or return to their seats with their families. Older kids are encouraged to stay and worship alongside their grown-ups.

Nursery care is available for infants throughout the entire service if that works best for your family.

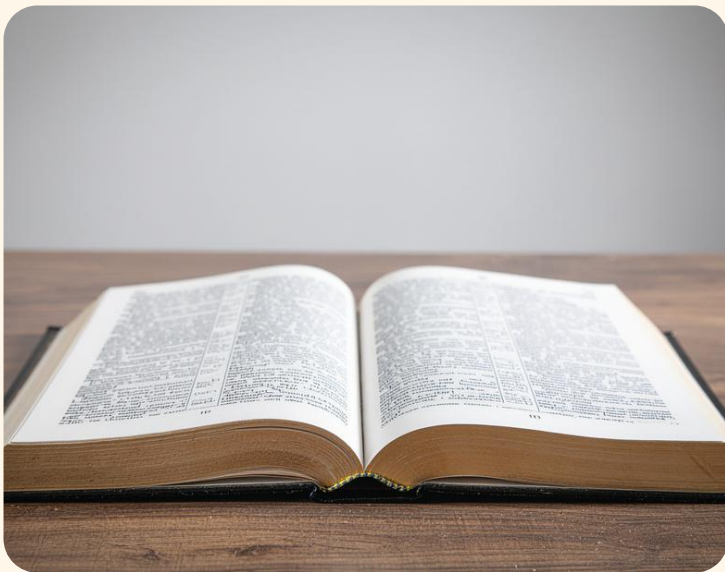
KICK OFF SUNDAY SEPTEMBER 13TH

MUSIC MINISTRY

Praise Team

The Praise Team leads us in contemporary worship music. They rehearse on Saturday mornings, usually around 10am. Rehearsals begin on September 6th and continue throughout the year. Singers and musicians are always invited to join this team and use their gifts to praise God.

Chancel Choir

The chancel choir sings approximately twice a month during our worship services. Rehearsals are held on Wednesday evenings from 7-8pm, starting on September 3rd. The choir performs a variety of musical styles including classical, gospel, and modern. The ability to read music is helpful, though not required. You do not have to be a member of CPC to join the chancel choir and no audition is necessary. Please join us as we seek to glorify God through music!

Children's Chorus

At CPC, our Children's Chorus offers songs throughout the year. All kids from Preschool through 5th grade are welcome to join. Rehearsals are scheduled on an as-needed basis and are usually held on Sundays immediately after church service. We're gathering the whole youth group family for a Friendsgiving celebration full of good food, games, and gratitude for the people we get to do life with.

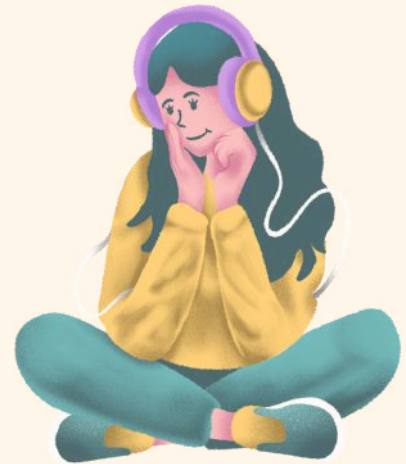

We're proud to partner with the Flemington Area Food Pantry!

The need in our community continues to grow. In 2025, the Pantry welcomed more than 21,000 visits from neighbors across Hunterdon County—a 92% increase since 2019. Behind those numbers are families stretching a paycheck, seniors living on fixed incomes, and neighbors facing unexpected challenges.

CPC members serve at the Pantry throughout the year, and our Joy Scouts regularly pitch in to sort donations and lend a helping hand. We also support the Pantry through our mission giving.

There are lots of ways for you to help, too! Volunteer at the Pantry, help sort donations, make deliveries, organize a food drive, or lend a hand at special events.

And don't miss the 29th Annual Empty Bowl on Friday, October 23! Enjoy a delicious bowl of soup in a handcrafted bowl donated by a local potter while supporting the Pantry's work to nourish our neighbors with dignity.
