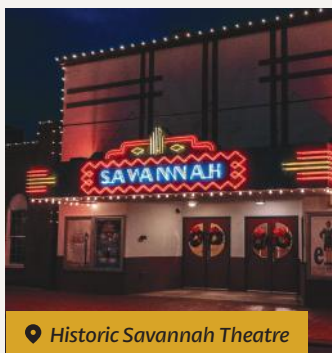

Attractions **PLACES**

Pickwick

Named after The Pickwick Papers by Charles Dickens, the unincorporated city of Pickwick has always had a story to tell. During the Great Depression the community was chosen as the site for a new dam as part of Franklin D Roosevelt's New Deal. After construction Pickwick became one of the first all-electric cities in the nation. Today, what began as a quiet riverside community has grown into a haven for outdoor recreation. Life moves with the current and the landscape invites you to explore.



Crump

On the west side of the Harrison-McGarity-Carpenter Bridge is the incorporated city of Crump. Visit Crump on the weekend and shop your way through the Crump Flea Market open every Saturday and Sunday. Vendors from across the region set up booths and tables both indoor and out.

Saltillo

A mix of charm and history, the incorporated riverside town of Saltillo offers a peaceful river lifestyle. Head out on the river from Saltillo Landing or Wilkinson Ferry Landing on the opposite bank and enjoy a day of fun and sun on the water.



Savannah

Resting along the banks of the Tennessee River is the ever-growing Hardin County seat of Savannah, shaped by its Civil War past, softened by its hospitality, and held together by stories passed from one porch to the next. Brick-lined streets lead to family-owned shops, century-old architecture, and riverfront views that still feel untouched.

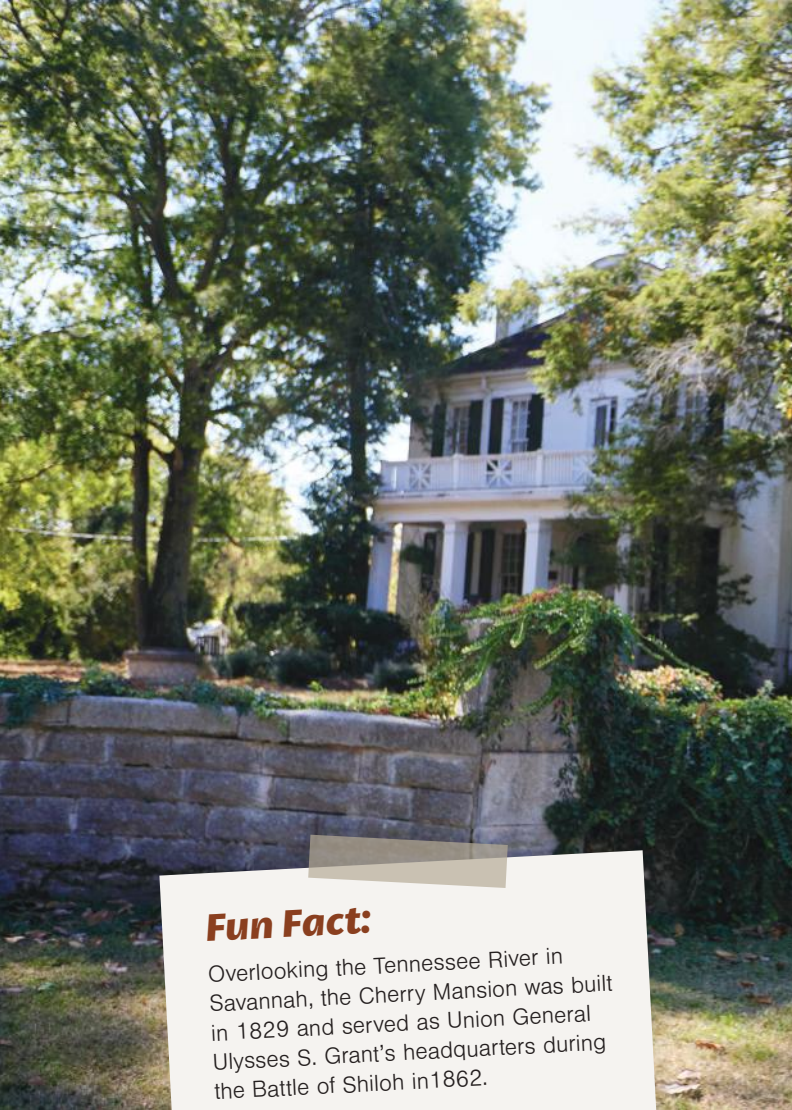

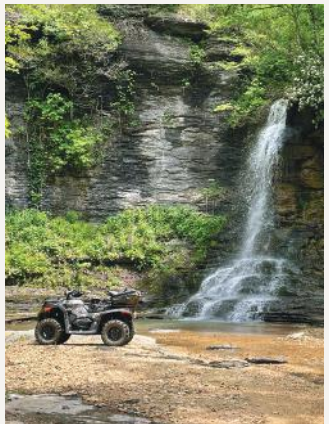




Savannah Historic District

The Savannah Historic District tells stories that stretch back more than a century. Included is a two-mile self-guided walking tour with more than 50 private homes and public landmarks. Styles range from elaborate Queen Anne to Classical and Colonial Revival. A printed guidebook, available at the Tennessee River Museum, provides historical context for each stop and a map of the loop.

SIGNATURE LAKES

Pickwick Lake is one of 10 large reservoirs endorsed by Bill Dance Outdoors in collaboration with TN Wildlife Resources Agency, TN Department of Environment and Conservation, and TN Department of Tourist Development. It is 43,100 acres of serious fishing.

NATIONAL MILITARY PARK

Established in 1894 to preserve the scene of the first major battle in the Western theater of the Civil War, Shiloh is considered one of the best-preserved battlefields in the nation. Featuring historic monuments, preserved earthworks, interpretive trails and a visitor center offering exhibits, films, and ranger-led programs.

Trails

Fit as a Fiddle Hiking Challenge

Explore Hardin County's scenic trails with this self-guided hiking challenge inspired by our musical roots. Hike five or more of the thirteen trails and earn an award.

Island Loop Trail

This 2.5-mile natural surface loop in Pickwick Landing State Park offers an easy, scenic walk-through wooded terrain. Interpretive signs along the way highlight the area's local history, making it a peaceful and informative 51-minute stroll.

Shiloh Indian Mounds

Located within Shiloh National Military Park, this easy 1.1-mile loop guides visitors through the remnants of a prehistoric village. Burial mounds, a former palisade wall, and year-round wildlife sightings make this a thoughtful 45-minute hike through centuries of history and nature.

Civil War Trails

These interpretive trail sites highlight the Union and Confederate headquarters in the days leading up to the Battle of Shiloh. Johnston's Bivouac in Shiloh and Cherry Mansion in Savannah are both open for self-guided visits.

Bike TN

This 10.1-mile paved loop is ideal for biking, walking, or a scenic drive. Enjoy quiet roads, historic landmarks, and accessible stops year-round.

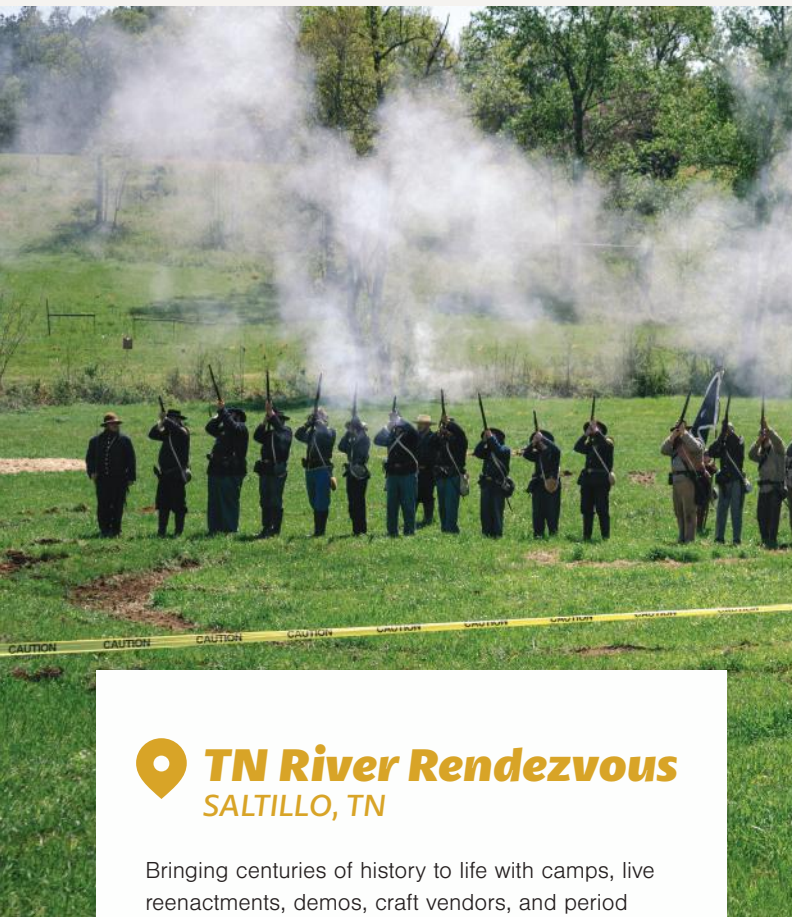

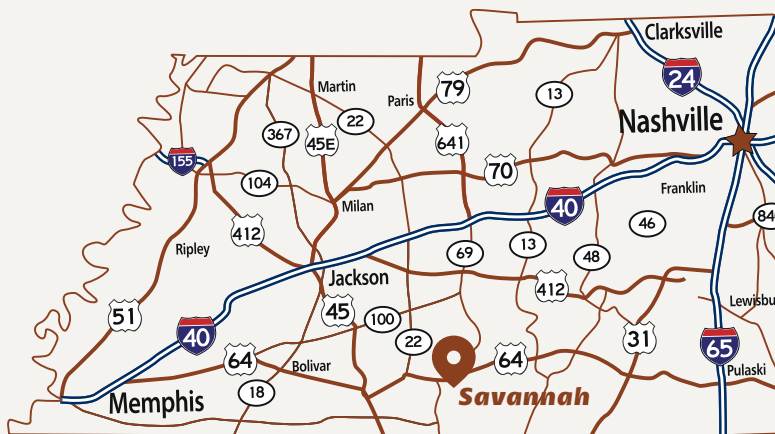
