Randolph County is a conglomeration of towns that are as different as the history that shaped them. Surrounded by varied terrain, these towns were built to provide necessities required by those that settled each distinct community. Today, some of the communities have steadily grown while others have remained the charming small towns they always have been. As you traverse Randolph County and visit these historic locations, you will begin to understand that we are *Shaped by Nature.*

ELKINS

Located on the edge of the Monongahela National Forest, this quaint city makes it easy to play in the mountains while staying in luxury.



- Known as the business and cultural hub of Randolph County
- Tree-lined streets and vibrant downtown
- Rich in history, outdoor fun, beautiful art, thriving theatres, and a variety of unique shops, breweries, and eateries
- Home of Davis & Elkins College

BEVERLY

Beverly is a quiet, small town and a hidden treasure of history in the Tygart Valley.



- Beverly dates back to the era of the American Revolutionary War and was significantly shaped by the Civil War
- Much of the town is designated as a National Register Historic District
- Over a dozen pre-Civil War buildings still survive - some open to the public as museums or shops
- Check out folk-life events, arts, crafts and antiques

HELVETIA

Hidden in a high mountain valley, an hour from anywhere, the community of Helvetia was settled by Swiss and German immigrants in 1869.



- Embrace the oasis of serenity in this small village blending Appalachian and Swiss culture
- Known for preserving the Swiss traditions that have been passed down from generation to generation
- From the monthly square dances to yodeling, festivals, food, and folkways, Helvetia is unlike any other place in West Virginia

PICKENS

Nestled deep in a remote hardwood forest, Pickens is one of Randolph County's most isolated communities.



- The wettest place in West Virginia, receiving more than 66 inches of precipitation yearly, much of it in snowfall
- Home of the annual Maple Syrup Festival in March - pancake feed, demonstrations, crafts and more

HARMAN

Situated as the mid-point between Canaan Valley, Seneca Rocks, and Elkins, the town of Harman is surrounded by the Allegheny Mountains of West Virginia.



- Home of the historic Old Mill, one of the few functioning gristmills in the state
- Nearby farm-to-bottle distillery and access to countless trails, streams, and rivers of the nearby forest

COALTON

Near the outskirts of Randolph County lies the town of Coalton, also known as Wolmelsdorf.



- For over 25 years, Coalton has celebrated Coalton Days - parades, a car show, entertainment, crafts, carnivals, competitions, and more
- Weekly bingo games at the local fire department
- Field of Fire Park located within the nearby historic Rich Mountain Battlefield

MONTROSE

Imagine the rolling hills, fields of wild roses, and the sound of a locomotive chugging along the tracks as it makes its way across Randolph County. This would be a common sight during the early 1900s in the community of Montrose.

HUTTONSVILLE

Huttonsville is surrounded by valley farmland and forested mountain slopes. There are many fishing and hunting opportunities found within the various nearby wildlife management areas.

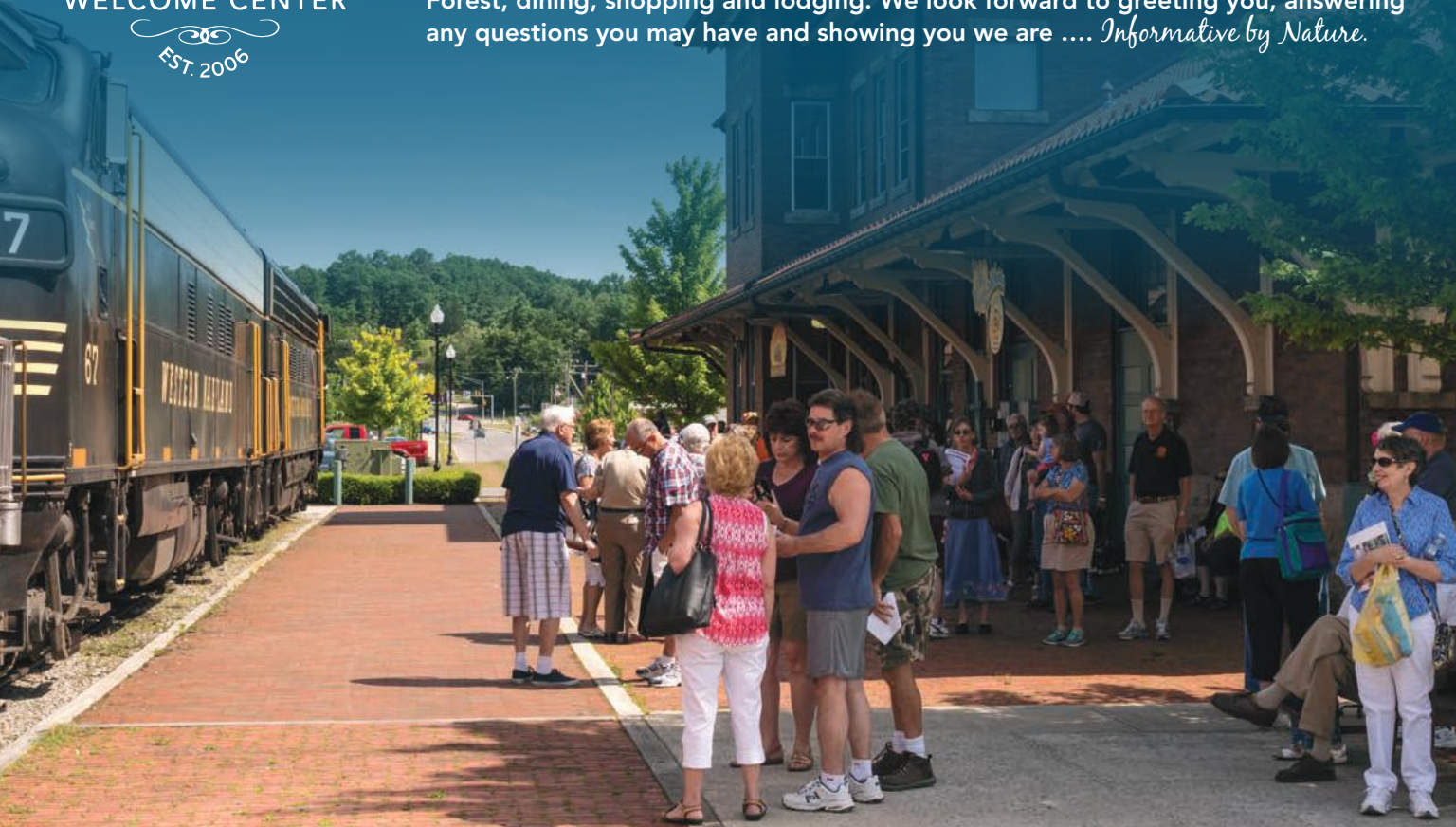

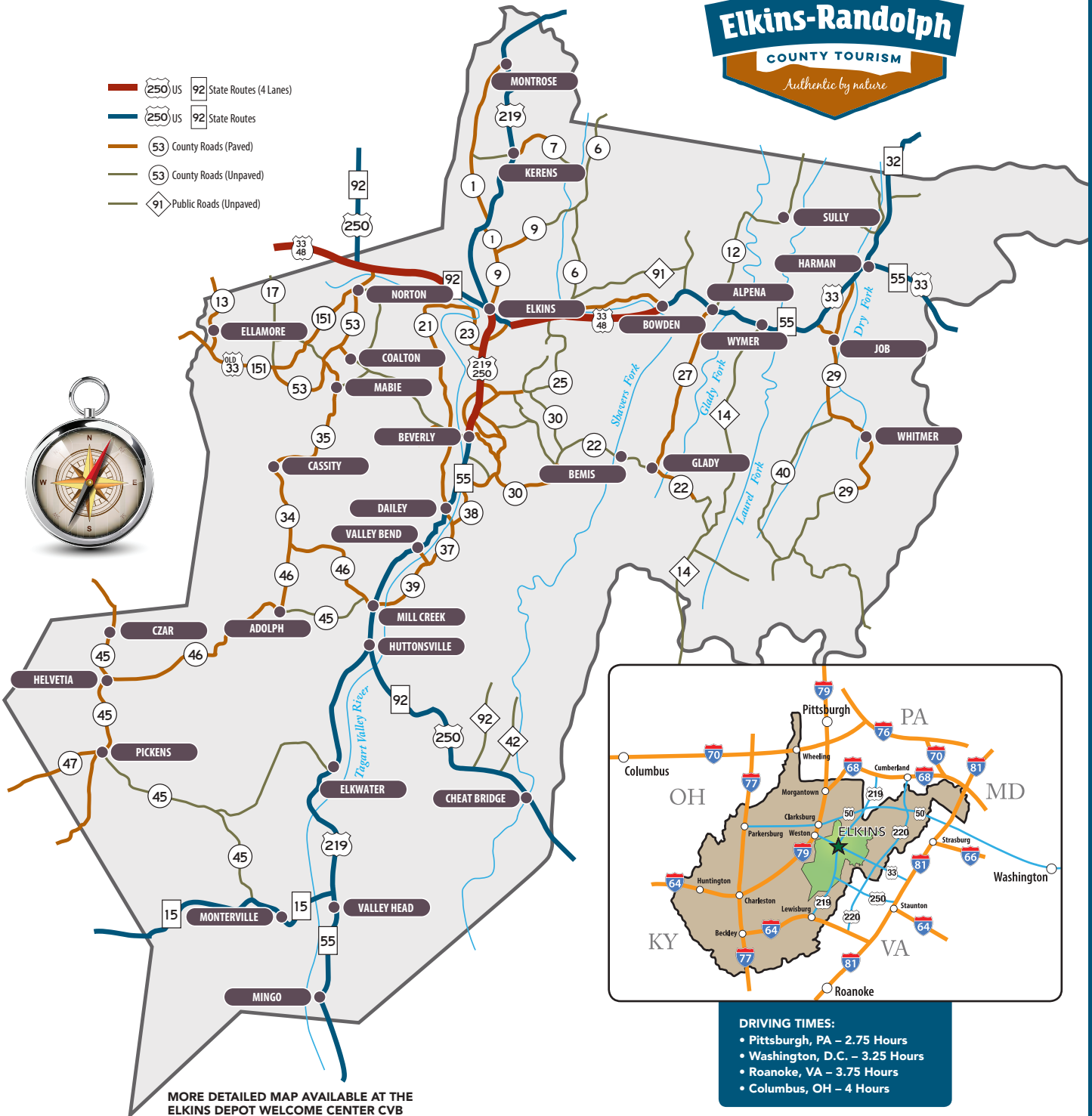
