# JUNIOR KINDERGARTEN – KINDERGARTEN SUMMER & WINTER

## GIRLS' SUMMER UNIFORM TERM 1 & TERM 4

- Blue denim pinafore with crest
- Pale blue overblouse with crest and yellow piping
- Pale blue ankle socks (not to be worn with sandals)
- Reversible School/House sun hat
- Open toe navy sandal or brown velcro fastening shoe or lace up

## GIRLS' WINTER UNIFORM TERM 2 & TERM 3

- Blue denim pinafore with crest
- Pale blue overblouse with crest and yellow piping
- Pale blue cardigan with crest
- Navy tights or pale blue ankle socks (not to be worn with sandals)
- Reversible School/House sun hat
- Brown velcro fastening shoe or lace up

## BOYS' SUMMER UNIFORM TERM 1 & TERM 4

- Navy shorts
- Pale blue shirt with crest
- Pale blue socks (not to be worn with sandals)
- Reversible School/House sun hat
- Open toe navy sandal or brown velcro fastening shoe or lace up

## BOYS' WINTER UNIFORM TERM 2 & TERM 3

- Navy trousers or navy shorts
- Pale blue shirt with crest
- Pale blue cardigan with crest
- Blue ankle socks
- Reversible School/House sun hat
- Elastic-sided brown boot or other plain brown boots or shoe

# PRE PRIMARY – YEAR 4

## SUMMER & WINTER

### SUMMER UNIFORM TERM 1 & TERM 4

- Grey skort
- Pale blue overblouse with crest and yellow piping
- Blazer with House badge (optional in summer)
- Grey jumper (optional in summer)
- Boater
- Pale blue ankle socks
- Reversible School/House sun hat
- Brown velcro fastening shoe or lace up



### SUMMER FORMAL UNIFORM

- As above with blazer and tie

### WINTER & WINTER FORMAL UNIFORM TERM 2 & TERM 3

- Grey skort
- Pale blue overblouse with crest and yellow piping
- Blazer, with House badge
- Grey jumper
- Tie
- Grey tights (formal) or pale blue ankle socks
- Reversible School/House sun hat
- Brown velcro fastening shoe or lace up
- Grey scarf (optional)







# YEAR 5 – YEAR 6

## SUMMER & WINTER

### SUMMER UNIFORM TERM 1 & TERM 4

- Grey skort or grey skirt
- Pale blue overblouse with crest and yellow piping
- Blazer with House badge (optional in summer)
- Grey jumper (optional in summer)
- Boater
- Pale blue ankle socks
- Reversible School/House sun hat
- Brown lace up shoe



### SUMMER FORMAL UNIFORM

- As above with blazer and tie

### WINTER & WINTER FORMAL UNIFORM TERM 2 & TERM 3

- Grey skort or grey skirt
- Pale blue overblouse with crest and yellow piping
- Blazer with House badge
- Jumper
- Tie
- Grey tights (formal) or pale blue ankle socks
- Reversible School/House sun hat
- Brown lace up shoe
- Grey scarf (optional)







# JUNIOR SCHOOL SPORTS

## JUNIOR KINDERGARTEN - YEAR 6

- Bumblebee polo shirt
- Navy shorts with yellow and blue stripe
- Pale blue fleece tracksuit pants (Junior Kindergarten and Kindergarten only)
- Pale blue microfibre tracksuit
- Pale blue and yellow hoodie
- Reversible School/House sun hat
- House polo shirt can be worn for House activities and Interhouse carnivals only (Pre Primary - Year 6)
- Sports Shoes: Please limit shoe selection to predominantly white / black / pale colours





# UNIFORM POLICY

- Students must wear correct uniform at all times. The uniform can be purchased from the Uniform Shop. Every item is a regulation item – a specified brand and colour including items such as socks and hair ribbons.
- The regulation length for skorts / skirts is knee length.
- Students (Pre Primary – Year 6) wear boaters to and from school and in public in Terms 1 and 4.
- Students (Pre Primary – Year 6) wear blazers to and from school and in public in Terms 2 and 3. Once at school, blazers must be removed before entering the classroom.
- Students are required to wear their House badge on their blazer.
- Students (Pre Primary to Year 6) can wear the optional grey scarf to and from school in Terms 2 and 3. Once at school, scarves must be removed before entering the classroom.
- Excursions: Regulation summer uniform if excursion occurs in Terms 1 or 4. Regulation winter uniform if excursion occurs in Terms 2 or 3, unless advised otherwise.
- Formal uniform occasions include: St Hilda's Day, end-of-year awards ceremonies, commissionings, or any other occasion determined by the Director of Junior School. Summer formal function attire will be determined according to weather conditions.
- Physical Education (PE) Uniform: Junior Kindergarten – Year 6, on PE days, travel to and from school in PE uniform and stay in PE uniform all day.
- Exceptions: If students have a cocurricular activity before school that requires PE uniform on a non-PE day, they can travel to school but then must change prior to class time. If students have a cocurricular activity after school that requires PE uniform on a non-PE day, they are required to change into their PE uniform after school. Students may travel home in their PE uniform.
- Dance Uniform: Pre Primary to Year 6 students will bring their long black leggings and their Bumblebee polo to school for dance lessons. Students will change into and out of their dance uniform at school.
- House polo shirt can be worn for House activities and Interhouse carnivals only (Pre Primary – Year 6).
- Hair must not be dyed beyond natural colourings. It must be neat and tied back once it reaches the collar. Hair ribbons must be regulation stripe. Headbands and cloth scrunchies must be regulation blue. Hair ties, snap clips and bobby pins must be the same colour as the student's hair colour. I.e. black hair requires black hair tie but must be worn in conjunction with a regulation stripe blue ribbon. All available at the Uniform Shop.
- Reversible School/House sun hat must be worn at all times when outside. Students who do not have an appropriate sun protective hat will be asked to stay in shaded areas only.
- Make-up and nail polish must not be worn.
- Braids (from cultural overseas holidays) or body markings such as henna tattoos are not permitted.
- One pair of small gold or silver studs, no larger than 4mm in diameter, with one worn in the first piercing of each lower ear lobe, is permitted. These studs are available through the Uniform Shop.
- Watches with plain bands are allowed i.e. brown, black, blue, white, gold or silver. Smartwatches are not permitted.
- Religious necklaces e.g. crucifix requires written permission from the Director of Junior School. They are not to be in sight and are to be removed during any physical activity and/or lessons which could potentially be a health and safety hazard.
- Please ensure that each article of clothing is clearly marked with the current owner's name.
