Relax and let transit do the work: you can travel to, from and within Sedona without compromising your access to unforgettable experiences. Many Sedona hotels are within walking distance of dining and shopping options, and the Sedona Trails and Pathways System (ST&PS) makes biking and walking around town a breeze. A network of public transportation options is also available.

To / from your hotel

Sedona Shuttle Connect is on-demand public transportation that comes to you, providing curb-to-curb pickup within the service area for \$2/ride. Service-area map is located on back cover. Sedona Shuttle Connect operates Thursday through Sunday, 6:30 a.m. to 8:30 p.m. Extended service hours are offered during peak times of year and major holidays.

TIP: Popular shopping areas like Tlaquepaque Arts & Shopping Village, Hillside and Uptown Sedona have their own designated pickup/drop-off locations. Make sure to find the Sedona Shuttle Connect sign at each location when requesting pickup.

To / from popular trailheads

The free Sedona Shuttle Trailhead Routes provide transportation from three Park & Ride lots to popular trailheads at Cathedral Rock, Little Horse, Soldiers Pass, Dry Creek Vista and Mescal. Trailhead Routes operate Thursday through Sunday, 7:00 a.m. to 5:30 p.m. Extended service hours are offered during peak times of year and major holidays.

To / from Cottonwood and around Sedona

The Verde Shuttle provides regular service between Sedona and Cottonwood for \$2/ride, and to 19 stops along State Route 89A and State Route 179 in Sedona for \$1/ride. Schedule available at VerdeShuttle.com.

To / from Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport

Getting to and from Sedona and Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport is easy and takes less than two hours. Whether you are looking for private transportation or a rideshare shuttle, many options exist.

Sedona's spectacular trails



Nestled within the Coconino National Forest, Sedona is home to 200 trails that span more than 400 miles. Access to these unique public lands is a key feature of the Sedona experience. Everyone who enjoys them has a responsibility to preserve and protect them for generations to come.

Trail etiquette for hikers and bikers

To help manage and protect these precious public lands, we kindly ask visitors to avoid off-trail experiences or trails that are not recognized by the U.S. Forest Service. Using so-called “social trails,” while tempting, can lead to significant environmental harm and are not maintained or managed for your safety.

TIP: If you plan to park at a trailhead, purchase a daily, weekly or annual Red Rock Pass at the Uptown or Red Rock Ranger District Visitor Centers. Daily passes available at trailhead kiosks with credit card.

Signature hikes

Signature hikes include some of our most stunning landscapes but can be busy during peak visitation times. Access these signature hikes without driving and parking your car by using the **Sedona Shuttle Trailhead Routes**:

- Cathedral Rock Trail
- Bell Rock Trail
- Devil's Bridge Trail
- Soldiers Pass Trail



TIP: Spring and fall are Sedona's peak seasons for visitation. Trailheads and trails will be busy. Remember to be respectful and always follow trail etiquette.

Solitude hikes

Solitude hikes get you close to the red rocks on less-traveled trails, with trailheads that aren't in as high demand as others:

- Courthouse Butte loop
- Chimney Rock loop
- Mescal Trail
- Bear Mountain Trail

TIP: If you're visiting during summer, hit the trails early to avoid the rising daytime temperatures.



World-class mountain biking experiences

Sedona is home to hundreds of miles of world-class singletrack. Trail experiences range from fun and flowy to technical climbing and descent, dry washes, and sandstone features. Most trails connect so you can pop out almost wherever and whenever you want, and regardless of where you stay in Sedona, you'll have trail access practically right outside your door.



TIP: Test your mountain bike abilities at the City of Sedona Bike Skills Park located at 525 Posse Ground Rd in West Sedona before you hit the trails.

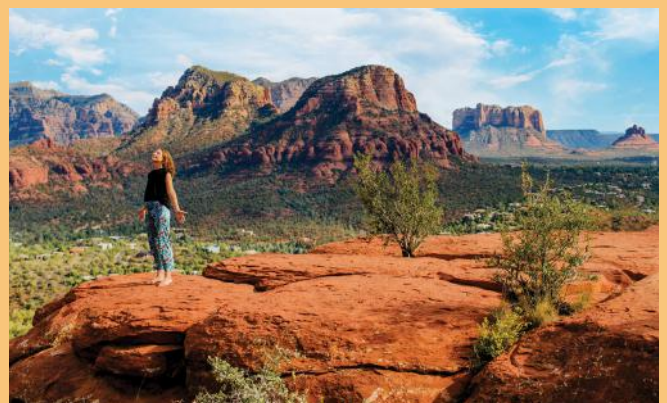

WHAT IS A SEDONA VORTEX?

While there is no definitive explanation of a vortex, it is generally agreed that specific sites around Sedona make you feel something extra. When visiting a vortex site, you may feel a heightened sense of awareness, profound emotions, a surge of physical energy or a deep sense of peace. The experience is unique to everyone. Sedona invites you to explore it for yourself. The most well-known vortex locations are:

- Airport Mesa
- Cathedral Rock
- Bell Rock
- Seven Canyons

Sedona stargazing

Stargazing is exploring the ultimate art gallery. Humans have been charting the stars since at least ancient Egyptian times, and it's probably safe to say we've been stargazing much longer. On a clear and crisp night, who can ignore a sky full of twinkling stars and shining planets, or wonder at the brightness of a full moon as it rises above the horizon? As Ralph Waldo Emerson famously said, "The sky is the ultimate art gallery just above us." This is especially true in Sedona.

No light pollution—it's really dark here

Since 2014, Sedona has been designated an International Dark Sky Community. Driving through town at night, you might notice that businesses are not brightly lit on the outside and the streetlights point straight down. Measures like these protect Sedona from light pollution and create excellent conditions for stargazing.

Altitude, wide-open spaces and red rocks

At 4,350 ft elevation, the stars above Sedona shine with extraordinary clarity and the Milky Way often dominates the sky. Add to that Sedona's wide-open desert spaces framed by its famous red rocks and conditions for stargazing become nearly ideal.

Comfortable night temperatures

Nighttime temperatures in Sedona, even in summer, drop considerably lower than daytime temperatures, allowing for comfortable stargazing well into the night.

Guided stargazing experiences

A handful of local businesses offer guided stargazing tours. See listings on [ScenicSedona.com/play](https://www.scenicsezona.com/play). Select Sedona hotels also provide opportunities and telescopes on their properties.

Self-guided stargazing opportunities

If you prefer to explore the stars solo, Sedona has many convenient places to look skyward. Consider these trailheads for stargazing: Little Horse trailhead, Bell Rock trailhead, or Fay Canyon trailhead.

TIPS:

- *Plan around the moon phase—new moon dates yield the darkest skies*
- *Respect private property—always stay on trail or designated public lands*
- *Sound travels far in the dry desert climate—speak quietly and listen to music in headphones*
- *Stay alert for wildlife that may be nearby and maintain a safe distance*

What time of night is best?

Make plans for stargazing with the hour of sunset in mind. Full darkness occurs about one and a half hours later.



Whether you join a guided tour with professional telescopes, hike to a secluded location, or just gaze up at the majestic Milky Way from your hotel balcony, Sedona offers stargazing that's educational, enchanting, and unforgettable.

Verde Valley Wine Trail



Move over, Napa. Step aside, Sonoma. Welcome to Arizona's Verde Valley, a desert-meets-river oasis where volcanic soil, high-elevation sun, and a touch of red rock magic conspire to produce some of the Southwest's most surprising wines.

When did winemaking start in Sedona and the Verde Valley?

When the Spanish first arrived in the late 1500s, they named the area Via de Uva, or Valley of the Grape, because a native grape variety grew here in abundance. Sadly, the native grape is inedible. Fast-forward 300 years to when Henry Schuerman, a German immigrant, planted the first vineyard in the Sedona area in the late 1880s and supplied wine to the miners in Jerome, AZ.

Although the Verde Valley was designated as Arizona's third American Viticultural Area (AVA) in 2021, the modern wine industry in the Verde Valley began in 1997 when Jon Marcus started Echo Canyon Vineyard and Winery. More wineries soon followed—Page Springs Cellars, Javelina Leap, Oak Creek, and Arizona Stronghold Vineyards—and winemaking in the Verde Valley has been steadily growing ever since.

What makes the Verde Valley good for winemaking?

Many factors make the Verde Valley favorable for growing grapes. Volcanic soil (like Italy, Spain, and parts of California), large limestone deposits (like Bordeaux and Rhone), ideal elevation around 3,500 ft, and the bright Arizona sun all contribute to growth.

Possibly the most significant factor supporting vineyards in the Verde Valley is the region's diurnal shift. Diurnal shift is the term used to describe the difference between the high temperature during the day and cold temperature at night.

In the Verde Valley, the difference in temperatures can be 30°F or more, which is similar to the temperature shifts found in Mendoza, Argentina. High temps during the day encourage sugar production in grapes and low temps at night preserve acidity, producing well-balanced wines.

What Verde Valley wines should I try?

Arizona wineries offer a unique mix of white, red, rosé, dessert, and sparkling wines that are similar to old world-style wines. White wine grapes include, but are not limited to Chardonnay, Viognier, and Picpoul Blanc. Red wine grapes include Syrah, Sangiovese, Tempranillo and more.



TIP: Leave the car behind and let local experts guide your Verde Valley wine adventure. Wine tour options are numerous, including traditional driver-provided tours as well as *Water to Wine* (which includes kayaking the Verde River) and *Trails to Vines* (which includes horseback riding).

Arts in Sedona



There are places where art is displayed, and there are places where art seems to rise directly from the landscape itself. Sedona belongs firmly in the second category. Long before the city became famous for wellness retreats and red rock hikes, artists were arriving here in search of something harder to define: light, stillness, color, scale, and the strange emotional pull of the desert. Today, that creative energy continues to shape Sedona.

Sedona as an arts town

By the mid-20th century, creative artists had already begun gravitating toward Sedona's dramatic high-desert terrain, drawn by the quality of light and emotional atmosphere. Artists, Max Ernst and Dorothea Tanning spent time creating work here from 1946–1953, helping establish Sedona as a serious creative destination.

In 1958, local artists and community leaders founded what would become the Sedona Arts Center, a gathering place for exhibitions, education, and artistic exchange. But Sedona's creative story reaches far deeper than its modern arts institutions. The region lies within the ancestral homelands of Indigenous peoples whose cultural presence, artistic traditions, and enduring relationships with the land continue to shape Sedona's identity today.



Sedona's creative districts

- **GALLERY ROW** is home to Tlaquepaque Arts & Shopping Village, built in the 1970s to resemble a traditional Mexican village. Vine-covered courtyards, tiled fountains, and stucco passageways frame galleries showcasing everything from fine art to handcrafted jewelry and modern kinetic sculpture. Tlaquepaque Arts & Shopping Village also serves as a natural gathering point during 1st Friday in the Galleries.
- **UPTOWN SEDONA** is home to the Sedona Arts Center, which remains both a historic anchor and an active community hub through exhibitions and workshops that draw artists and visitors from across the country. Throughout the Uptown area, many other galleries showcasing original works of art, custom jewelry, and other one-of-a-kind items are all within half-mile walking distance.
- **WEST SEDONA** continues to evolve as a growing creative district, with working studios helping shape a more hands-on atmosphere. Open studios create opportunities to engage directly with local artists rather than simply browse finished pieces. Notable West Sedona studios where visitors can create their own works of art include Rovang Ceramics and The Melting Point glass studio.

Sedona's festivals and events



Sedona is home to many popular annual festivals and events celebrating food, film, art, music, nature, and wellness, highlighted by the Sedona International Film Festival, Sedona Arts Festival, Plein Air Festival, Sedona Yoga Festival and more.

Sedona International Film Festival

What began as a regional film gathering has grown into one of the Southwest's most respected cinematic events, drawing filmmakers, actors, critics, and audiences from around the world. Screenings take place at the Mary D. Fisher Theatre and other venues throughout the city.

Sedona Arts Festival

This festival brings a fine-art experience to West Sedona each fall, featuring more than 100 juried artists, live music, food, and libations against the backdrop of Sedona's red rocks.

Plein Air Festival

Presented by the Sedona Arts Center, this is one of the nation's oldest plein air festivals. Artists spread across trails, overlooks, vineyards, and canyon edges to paint Sedona's scenery in real time.

Sedona Yoga Festival

The Sedona Yoga Festival is a four-day immersive consciousness evolution conference and wellness gathering. It features yoga classes, Ayurveda workshops, live music, and outdoor excursions.

- **SPIRITUALITY:** Whether you're aligning chakras or meditating to the sounds of nature, Sedona's energies will inspire you to new heights.
- **CULTURE:** Many ancient heritage sites and monuments built by the Sinagua and other Native American tribes are spread throughout the red rock landscape.
- **SHOPPING:** Whether you're looking for fun keepsakes to give to friends or one-of-a-kind works of art, Sedona has over 100 retail shops and galleries.

- **DARK SKIES AND STARGAZING:** Sedona became an International Dark Sky Community in 2014. It was the 8th location in the world to achieve this designation.

- **VERDE VALLEY WINE TRAIL:** The Verde Valley became an American Viticultural Area (AVA) in 2021 and has more than 20 vineyards and tasting rooms.

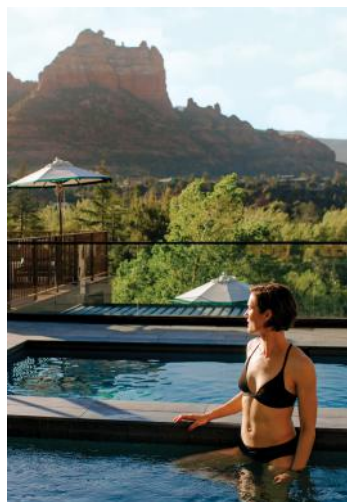

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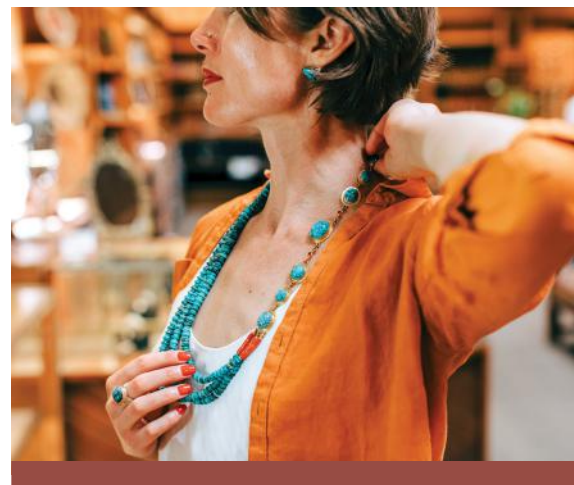
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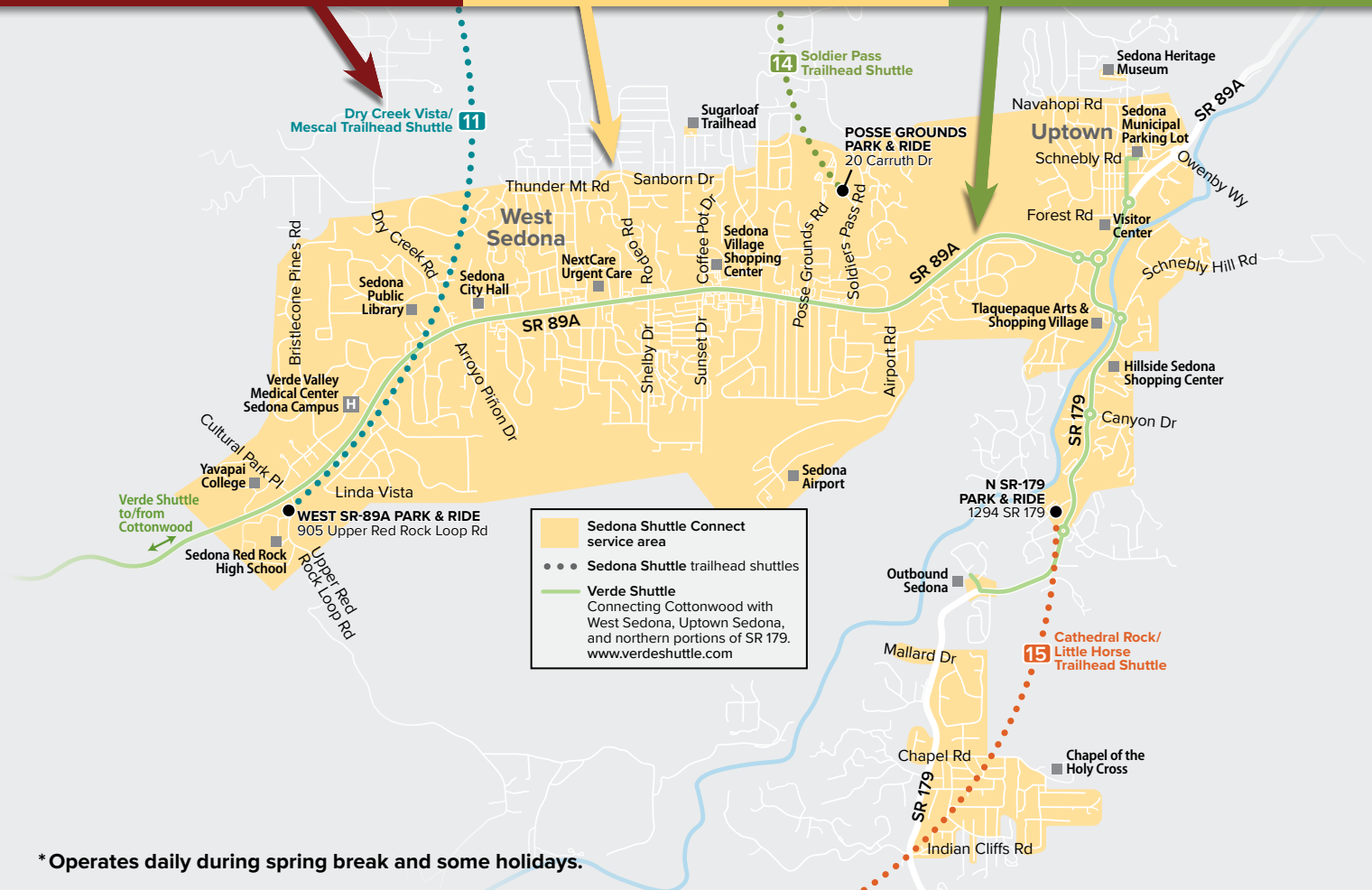
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
