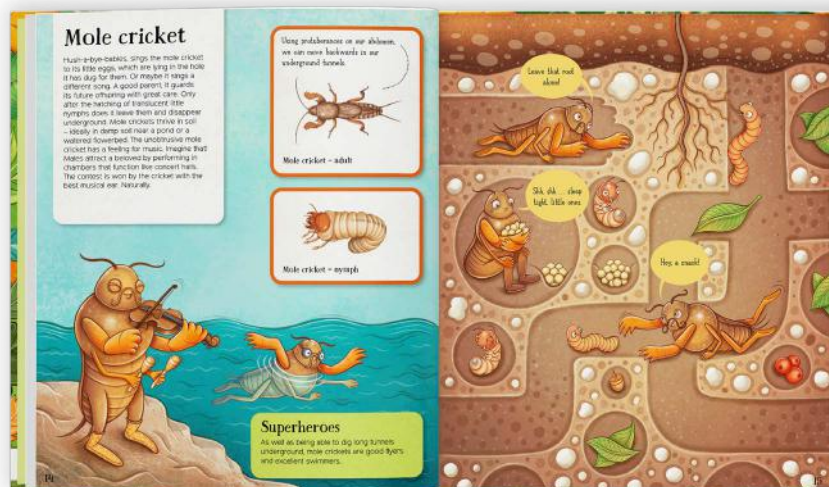
The World of Beetles

Elephant Beetle

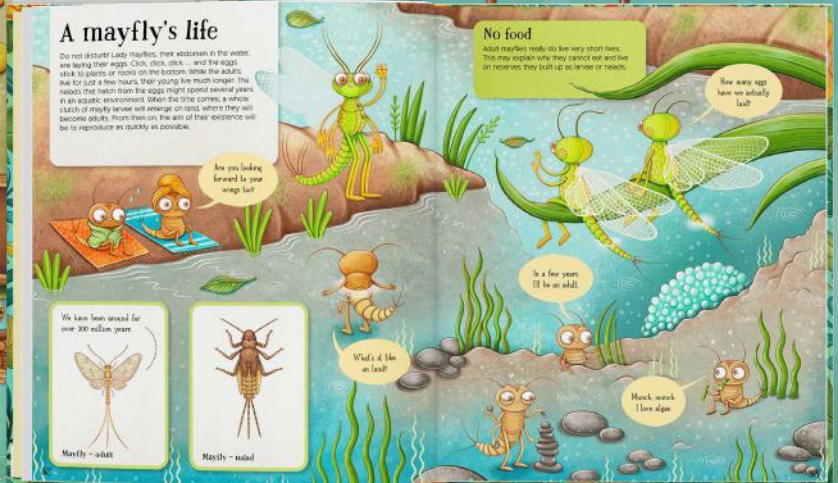
Through the rainforest grass hides an elephant beetle, steady and grand, and three proud beetles rise from its head. A creature to fear – or so it seems. But wait, this "elephant" is a beetle! It may be as long as a third of a human palm, a true giant in the beetle kingdom yet in our world it is still only a tiny creature. Those huge horns might look scary, but don't worry, the gentle giant is a vegetarian! When it comes to food, these beetles have a lot of a sweet tooth. Delicious only is their favorite, and that thick coat of black hair? It's there for a reason to keep them warm when the temperature drops. Even though they live in the tropics, they can handle a little cold with no trouble at all.

A mayfly's life

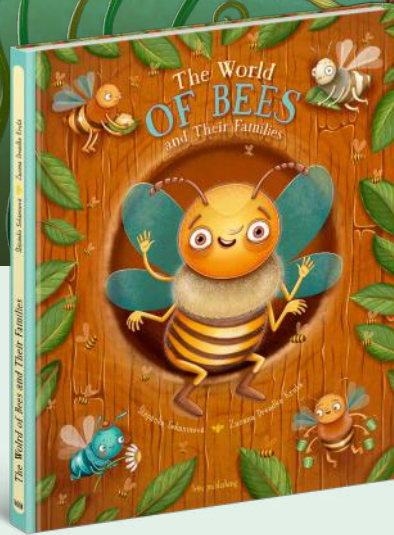
Do not disturb! Lady Mayflies, their abdomen in the water, are laying their eggs. Click, click, click... and the eggs sink to pebbles or rocks on the bottom. While the adults live for just a few hours, their young live much longer. The adults that hatch from the eggs might spend several years in an aquatic environment. When the time comes, a whole clutch of mayfly larvae will emerge on lands where they will become adults. From then on, the aim of their existence will be to reproduce as quickly as possible.

No food

Adult mayflies really do live very short lives. This may include when they cannot eat and live on reserves they built up as larvae or nymphs.

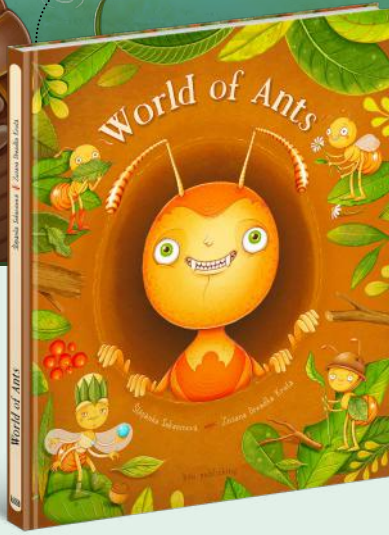
