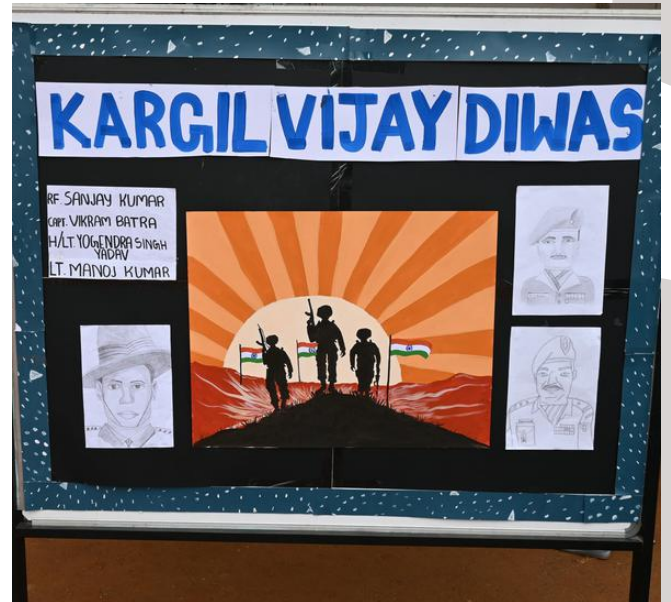


Kargil Vijay Diwas

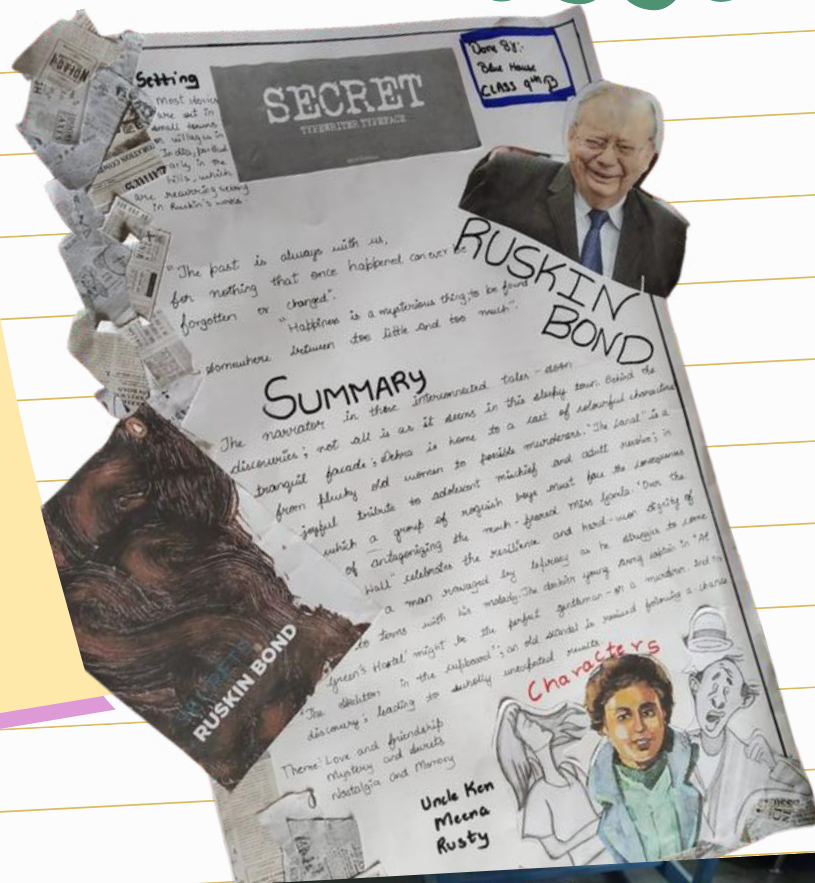

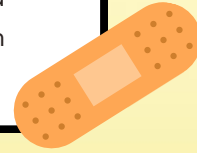

SHOE POLISH



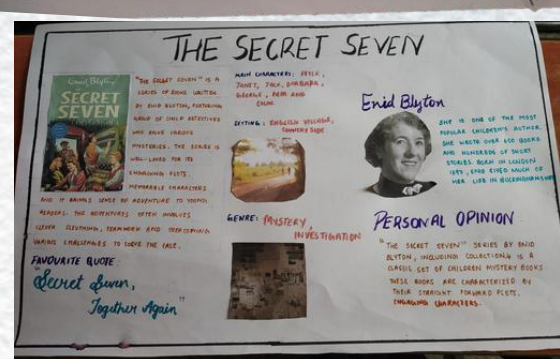
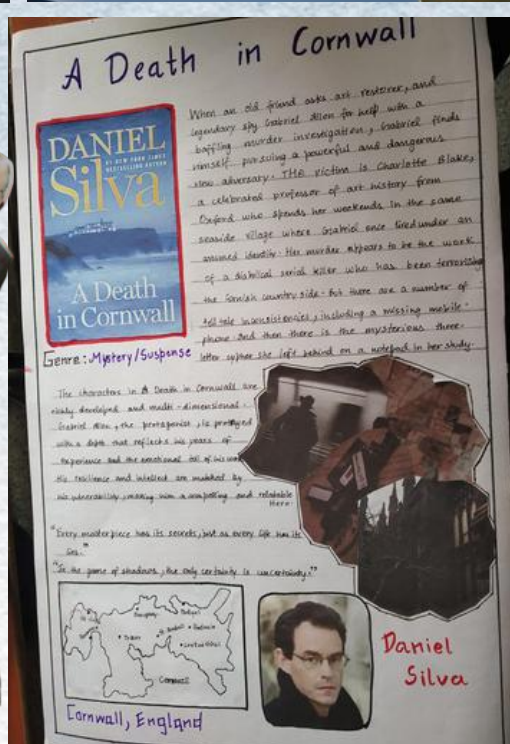
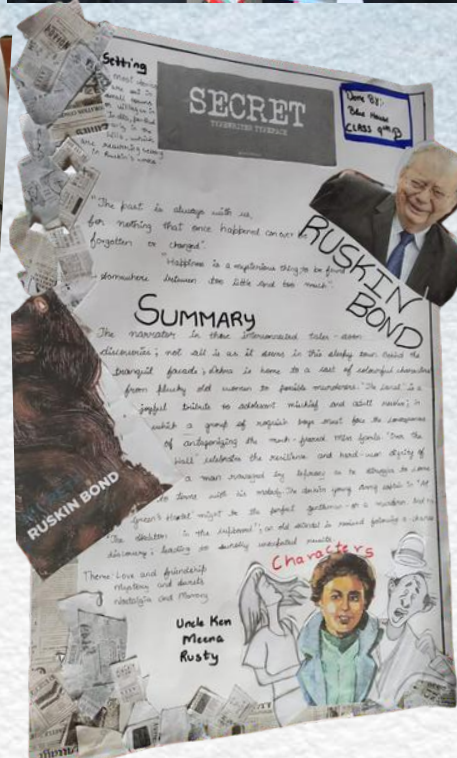
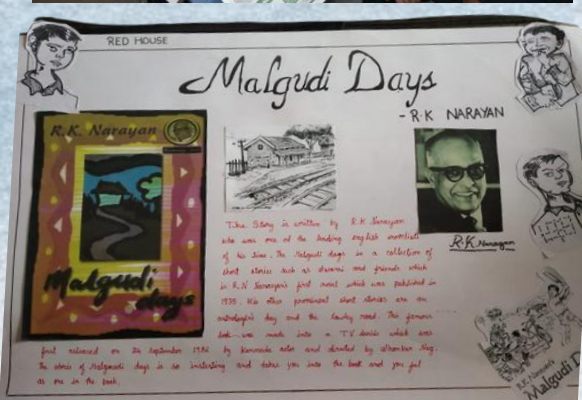

FRIENDSHIP BAND MAKING

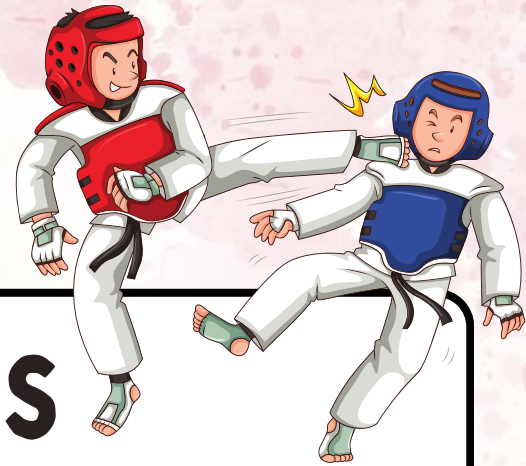

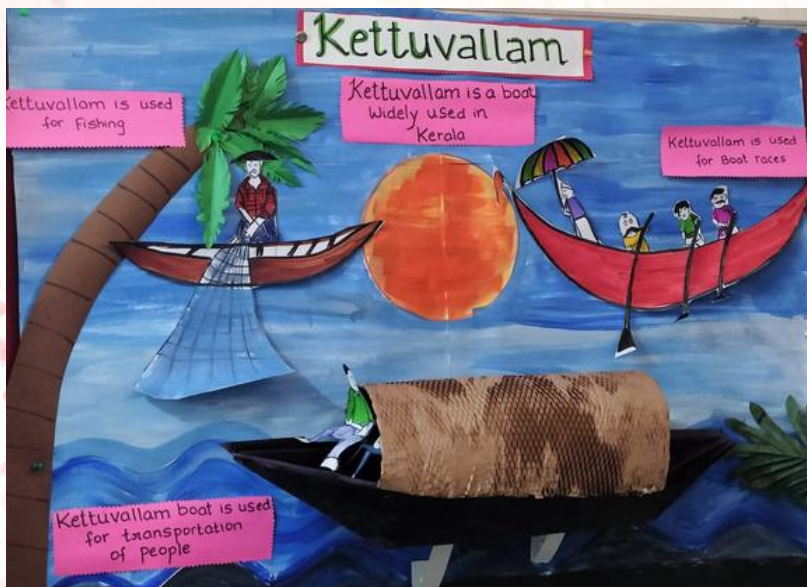
