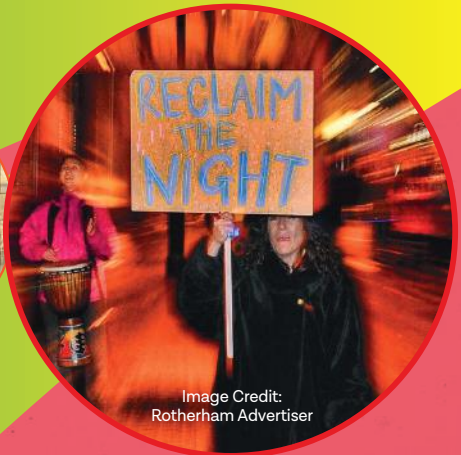

Whether you come alone, with friends, or bring the whole family, you'll be part of a powerful movement for change.

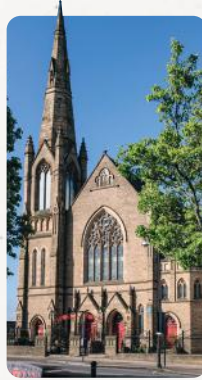
