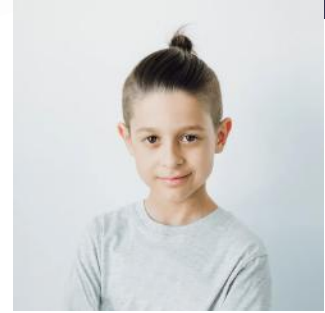


Expectations
