Founded in 2000 by Artistic Directors Hannah Baumgarten and Diego Salterini, Dance NOW! Miami stands at the forefront of the South Florida dance community. Named "Best Dance Company" by Miami New Times in 2022, the company is in residence at the Little Haiti Cultural Complex, Sanctuary of the Arts, and Miami Beach Bandshell — creating original repertory and reconstructing iconic works from the 20th and 21st centuries.
