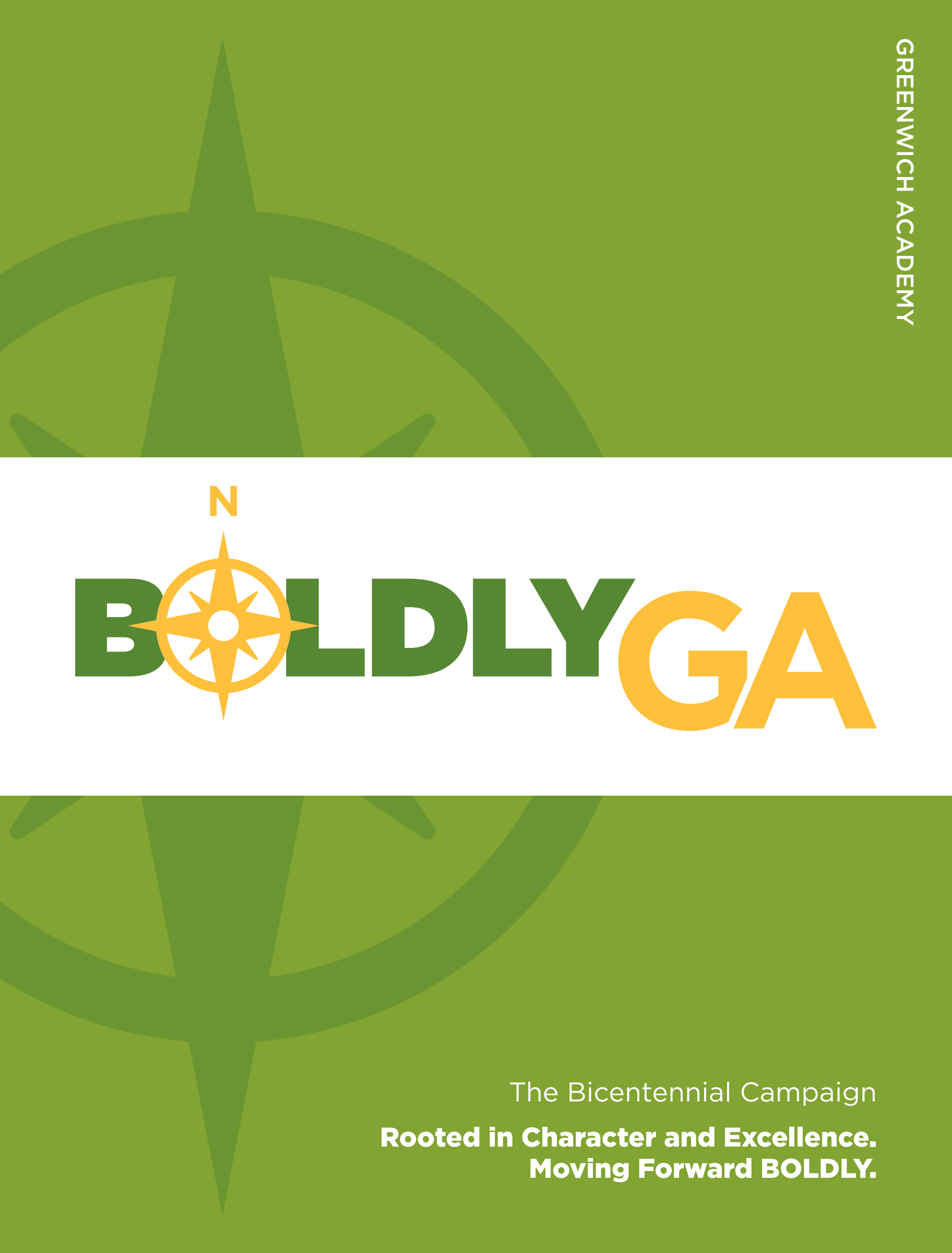

▶ **Glenville Campus Build**

Phase I brings infrastructure, a new building for two Lower School grades, a premier squash center, and faculty housing to the 54-acre Glenville property, opening the door for GA's next chapter.

▶ **Main Campus Enhancements**

Relocating spaces to Glenville allows for renovated and reimagined spaces on main campus, making way for new and expanded programs that give every division modern, flexible classrooms built for collaboration and the way girls learn today.

▶ **Athletic Facilities**

State-of-the-art spaces and equipment bring GA's competition and practice facilities on all campuses up to the level of our champions.

Inspired learning happens in inspired spaces. When students step foot onto the wooded campus at Glenville, they instantly see the world around them through a different lens. They are open to and ready for new challenges. With 14 buildable acres and 40 that will be preserved in nature, the interplay between indoor and outdoor learning is limitless.

As the scope and depth of our programs have advanced over the years, GA has made substantial facility and green space enhancements to meet evolving programmatic needs and to ensure our students have access to vanguard programs taught by the best faculty. With no remaining FAR (Floor Area Ratio) on our 34-acre main campus and an enrollment cap that has reached its maximum limits, it is vital for GA to move forward with the ambitious plans for what lies ahead.

A visionary undertaking, GA is engaging in a strategic, measured, and phased approach to rolling out our footprint at Glenville.

What Phase 1 Makes Possible



Lower School Classrooms at Glenville

A new two-grade academic building at Glenville begins the Lower School's move to its future home, giving our young eager learners a campus that is truly theirs while opening much-needed space on GA's main campus. It is a crucial first step in making measured, mission-aligned enrollment growth across all divisions possible.



A Squash Center Built for Champions

Moving the squash program to Glenville does double duty: it gives GA's nationally-ranked squash team the world-class home it deserves, and it frees up valuable space on the North Maple campus for new MS and US programming.



Breaking New Ground

At Glenville, curiosity has room to roam. Surrounded by nature, students in every grade will gain space to reflect, recharge, and approach learning from a different perspective. It is a living laboratory for science research, outdoor wellness, and experiential activities, and it expands the horizons for faculty.



Supporting Faculty Who Shape Girls' Lives

Enabling teachers to live within close proximity to campus encourages engagement to be involved with the full life of the school. Phase I will provide additional faculty housing units.

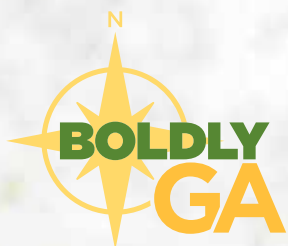

A Vision for the Next Century

Phase I of Boldly GA is the beginning of GA's Future

As the Glenville Campus takes shape, it sets something larger in motion: a school with the space, the resources, and the flexibility to grow in ways that were not possible before. That flexibility keeps GA nimble: ready to launch the next signature program, hire the next exceptional teacher, and meet whatever the next generation of girls need, anticipating leading-edge innovations still on the horizon. This is how GA has stayed at the forefront for 200 years: by continuing to grow, continuing to ask what comes next.

On the North Maple campus, that growth means more room for programs that define a GA education across every division: more space for the sciences, the arts, and disciplines that don't exist yet. More capacity to bring together the talented, diverse community of girls that makes GA extraordinary. More room for our girls to discover what they are capable of. Across all campuses, it means faculty who are supported, retained, and inspired. It means a school with the endowment to sustain its promise, not just for the girls here today, but for every girl still to come.

A Phased Approach

On the horizon, GA's long-term aspirational concept beyond Phase I includes plans for a full scope lower school and faculty housing build, indoor turf and training center, outdoor field, nature center, amphitheater, and thoughtful increased enrollment to ensure GA's financial stability and to gain student parity in the GA/Brunswick coordinate program, with each phase moving forward as the campaign's progression allows.
