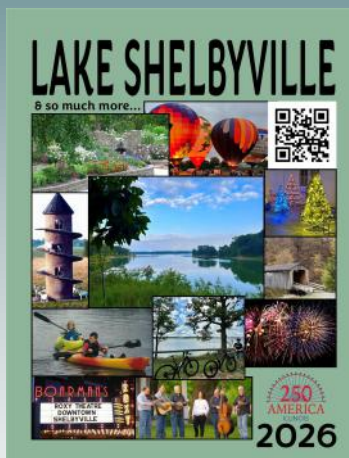

Boat Ramp and Beach admittance is free for those displaying their registered Corps camp tag, America the Beautiful Pass, or USACE Annual Day Pass.

A USACE Annual Day Use Pass may be purchased for \$40.00 at the Lake Shelbyville Project Office/Visitor Center and at all campground fee booths. USACE annual passes expire one year from the month of purchase and are honored nationwide at USACE managed facilities.

America the Beautiful Passes (ATB)

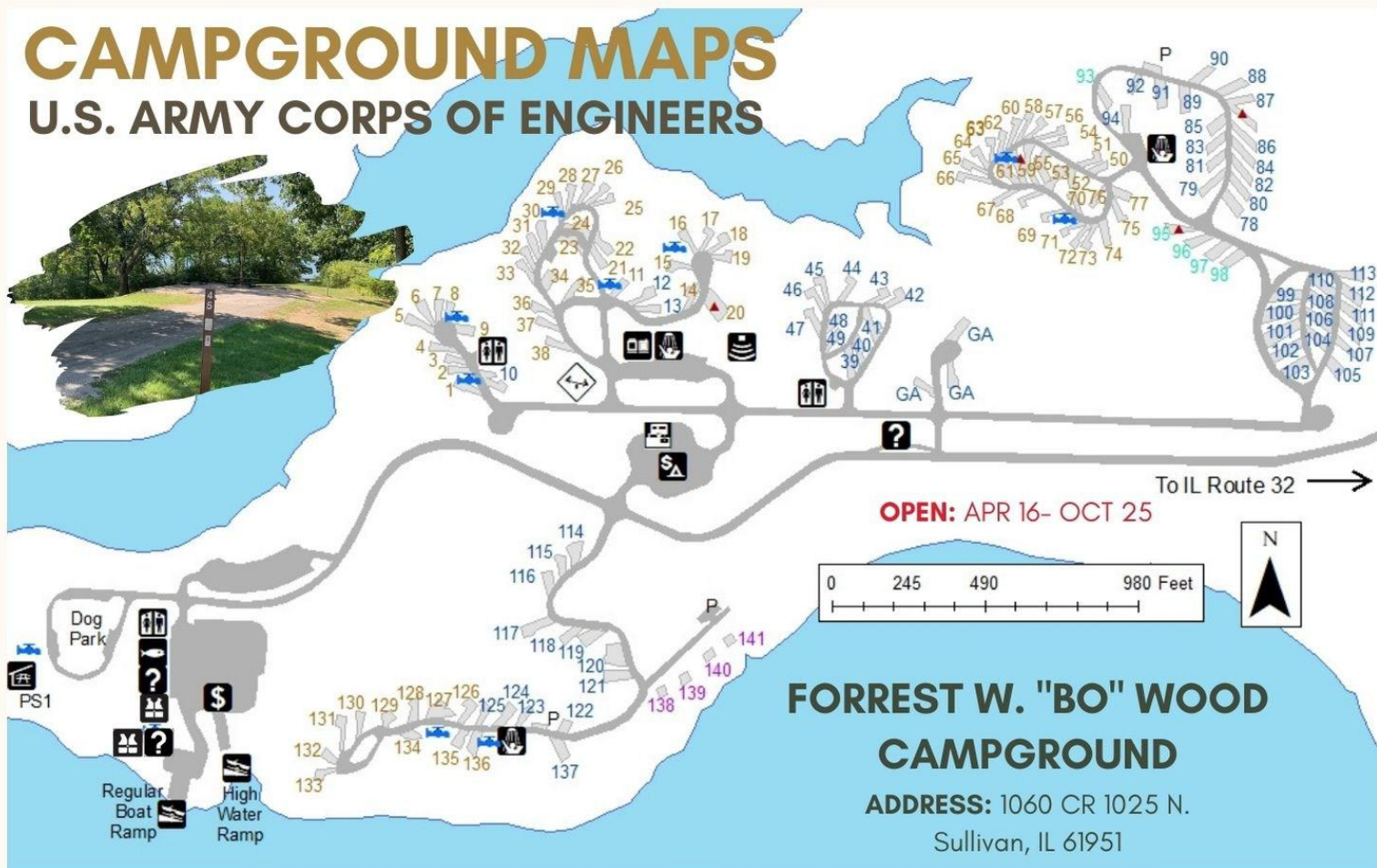


USACE CAMPING REGS.

1. For reservation only campsites, a responsible person must register and pay fees prior to setting up on a campsite. Check out time is 4 p.m. Reservation sites will be available for occupancy when available, but no later than 5 p.m. The maximum number of campers per site is eight.
2. At Lake Shelbyville the majority of sites are classified as single capacity sites. The only exceptions are designated buddy sites, which are double capacity sites.
 - a. The total number of camping units for single capacity sites are limited to one recreational vehicle or trailer and three additional tents. If no recreational vehicle or trailers are on the site, a maximum of four tents will be permitted.
 - b. The total number of camping units for double capacity sites are limited to two recreational vehicles or trailers and six tents. If no recreational vehicles are on the site, a maximum of eight tents will be permitted.
 - c. The maximum number of people permitted to stay overnight on a single capacity site is eight. Up to 16 people are permitted to stay overnight on double capacity sites.
3. Campground roads and facilities are to be used by registered campers and their visitors only. Interfering with, or restricting the use of the shoreline by boaters or other lake users is prohibited.
4. All wheeled vehicles, including but not limited to mopeds, mini-bikes, boat trailers, motorcycles, and other vehicles, must be kept on camping pads registered to vehicle users or in designated parking areas. All motor vehicles must be parked lengthwise on the camp pad except at sites with irregularly shaped pads. Empty boat trailers may be stored on the grass provided that they are moved onto and off the grass by hand.
5. Picnic tables and lantern holders must remain on gravel surfaces at campsites with gravel impact areas.
6. To avoid tree damage, hanging lanterns are to be suspended a minimum of 8" from the side of trees and 24" from overhead limbs. Do not drive axes, nails, or other objects into trees.

LAKE SHELBYVILLE IS HOME TO MANY WILDLIFE SPECIES

Whitetail deer are abundant throughout the area with plenty of sightings at Eagle and Wolf Creek. During the summer, the butterfly houses at Eagle Creek and the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers Visitor Center delight all ages. There is also a Heron Rookery, The Guzy Prairie and Pothole Area, as well as a Coneflower Prairie. The Lake has designated wildlife areas at Wolf Creek and the Okaw Bluff Group Camp. West Okaw River and the Kaskaskia River are Fish and Wildlife Management Areas. The lake is home to Bald Eagles, turkey, fox, Canadian Geese, several duck species, quail, pheasant, dove, raccoons, opossums, osprey, and pelicans.

Photo Ops: There are plenty of areas for wildlife photos in our state and COE parks, City parks, recreation areas, and the lake itself.

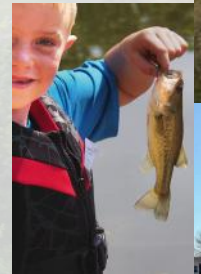

Boarman's Roxy Theatre

in downtown Shelbyville reopened in 2003 after being closed in 1966. A donation from Bob Boarman in 2003 and the Dove family donating the original building to the Chamber; the community came together and donated labor, money, etc to remodel it from top to bottom. After 3 months, the Boarman's Roxy Theater re-opened on 11/6/2003. It has an award winning marquis w/ old fashioned running lights while inside curtains line the walls from floor to ceiling and the original stage remains from the early 1900's. The main auditorium seats 170 or on busy nights the balcony opens with 30 seats. Shelbyville & surrounding communities continue to support the Roxy with new seats in 2010 and a digital and Real 3D projection system in 2012. 2014 saw the balcony refurbished and the concession area/annex was upgraded in 2019. A new heating/cooling system was installed in 2024. The theatre can be reserved for private showings such as school trips, etc. Businesses can advertise on the scrolling screen before the movie. The Roxy Theatre is open daily with shows at 6:30pm, and Matinees at 2:00pm on Saturday and Sunday. Admission is **\$5.00** per person for all shows except 3D movies (**\$7.00** per person). Lincoln in Shelby County

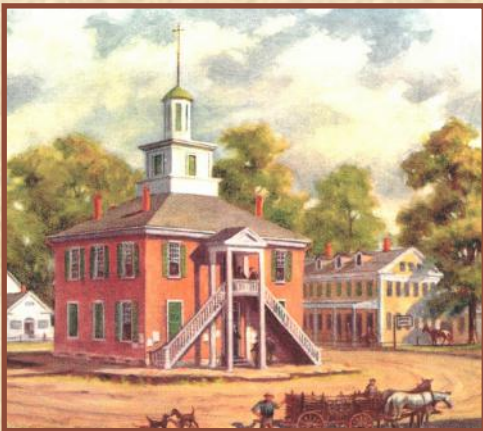

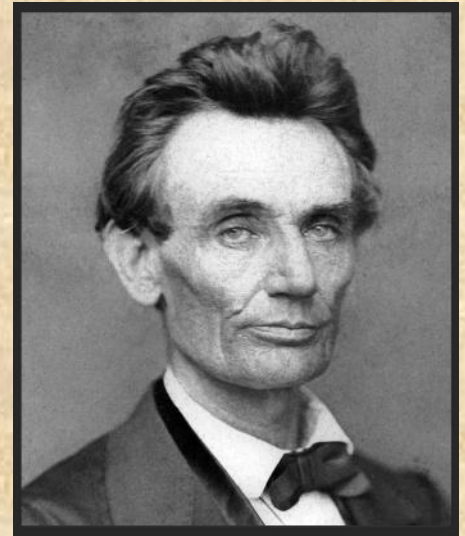
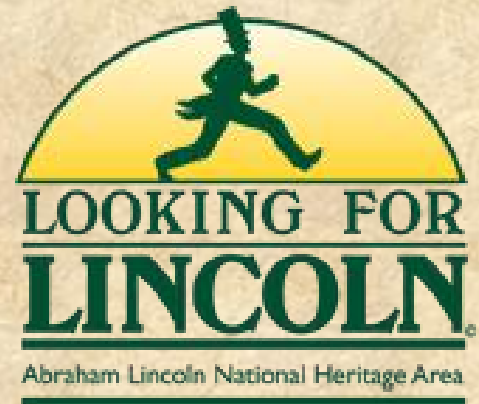
Shelby County was issued the first Passport stamp in the Abraham Lincoln National Heritage Area. The **Passport to Your National Parks** program allows visitors to collect passport stamps while exploring the communities where Lincoln Lived, worked, and traveled through before becoming our 16th President.

The Abraham Lincoln National Heritage Area

The Abraham Lincoln National Heritage Area (ALNHA) is a 43-county area of Central Illinois designated by Congress in 2008. The ALNHA works in partnership with the National Park Service and tells the stories of Lincoln's life and times in Illinois. It is the only National Heritage Area named for an American President. The Abraham Lincoln National Heritage Area is focused on the 30 years Lincoln lived in Central Illinois, raising his family and pursuing his passion for the law and politics. During this time, we now know he was unwittingly preparing himself to become the President who would hold the Nation together during a time of unprecedented challenges, that of a Civil War. It required enormous courage to save the Union and bind its wounds, while trying to cleanse the scourge of slavery from our national culture. He was ultimately successful in his goal but gave his last, full measure of devotion at Ford's Theater in 1865. We now believe that his journey is our enduring legacy.

The Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum

Located in Springfield, Illinois, the Abraham Lincoln Presidential Library and Museum is just a short, gorgeous drive from Lake Shelbyville. The downtown area is a mere 56 scenic miles away and the Library houses one of the largest collections of Lincoln material in the world and serves not only students and scholars researching Lincoln and Illinois history, but also genealogists from around the world. The museum is a world class institution in which visitors can journey through Lincoln's life; from his days in New Salem to his time as a candidate for president and on through his presidency in Washington DC wrestling with the Civil War and slavery, and finally his untimely death at the hands of an assassin's bullet.

ANTHONY THORNTON

ANTHONY THORNTON AND ABRAHAM LINCOLN LED FAIRLY SIMILAR lives. Both were born in Kentucky, were tall, and were Whigs.

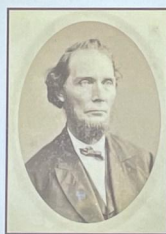
Both began practicing law in Illinois in 1836, even though Thornton was college-educated and read law in an uncle's law office while Lincoln had little schooling and was self-taught in the law. Both served in the Illinois legislature. Thornton served in the constitutional convention in 1847, when Lincoln was elected to the U. S. Congress. After 1854, the two men took different paths. The Kansas-Nebraska Act destroyed the Whig

Party, resulting in new party loyalties. Thornton, concerned about the anti-slavery zeal of the Republicans, chose the Democrats. Lincoln took several years before finally calling himself a Republican. Despite the party changes, the two remained friends. Thornton supported Stephen Douglas in the 1858 Illinois Senate race and was a presidential elector for Douglas in 1860. During the Civil War, Thornton was a pro-war Democrat, sold bonds to pay bounties for Shelby County volunteers, and won election to the U. S. Congress in 1864. He took office in March 1865, just one month before Lincoln's assassination.

THORNTON HAD A distinguished career after the Civil War. He served two terms in the U. S. House, working on the important Committee of Claims. In 1876, he was elected to the Illinois Supreme Court, serving more than 1,500 cases and writing approximately 200 opinions in his four-year tenure. In 1877, he became the first president of the Illinois State Bar Association, serving three terms. After a life of public service, he returned to the law, dying in Shelbyville in 1904.

ANTHONY THORNTON ASSISTED in protecting Lincoln's professional reputation. Oldham and Henningsen, partners with Lincoln's deceased father-in-law Robert Todd, sued Lincoln in a Kentucky court, alleging that Lincoln had failed to pay them money from a note that he had collected against Shelbyville residents William F. Thornton and his son-in-law, Marshall Bayne. Lincoln was angry at the suggestion that he purposefully withheld money from his father-in-law.

Lincoln came to Shelbyville in 1855 to take William Thornton's deposition. William Thornton was away, so Lincoln took the testimony of Anthony Thornton, who had served as an attorney for William Thornton and Bayne, was aware of the circumstances, and claimed that "Lincoln has never had anything to do with and none." Because of Thornton's testimony, the plaintiffs dismissed their lawsuit against Lincoln, helping to preserve Lincoln's very important reputation as a lawyer.

History Made

Horace Tallman Hay Baler

Horace M. Tallman was the inventor of the first successful mechanical Pick up Hay Baler. Tallman was born in 1863 in Shelby County and moved to Shelbyville. In 1905, he built small models of hay balers. He sold his first invention to the Ann Arbor Machine Co. in 1915, buying the company four years later when they went bankrupt. In 1922, he moved the company to Shelbyville. Mr. Tallman passed away April 17, 1929, and his sons continued the work. In 1930, a farmer bought and operated a brand new Ann Arbor pickup baler, setting a new record for getting such a radically new machine into production. By 1935, they were operating in 19 countries. Oliver purchase the company in 1943 and moved it in 1970. In 1980, the American Society of Agricultural Engineers dedicated a plaque in Shelbyville commemorating the importance of Tallman's hay balers to American Agriculture. Ken & Freddie Fry restored the Victorian Home which was placed on the National Registry in 1988. Forest Park is now home to a museum for the Oliver and Ann Arbor contributions to agriculture.



The Shelbyville Post Office has hosted this painting since 1941. "Shelby County Fair Mural" is by artist Sister Lucia Wiley. Dedicated on June 13, 1941, it was painted using egg tempera, a paint made by combining egg whites with pigments and oil. The mural was funded through the Treasury Department's Section of Fine Arts. Her art is displayed in many Post Offices around the nation.

Robert Root

Stop by the Shelby County Historical Society (SCHS) to learn more about the famous Shelbyville artist. A man prominent in the cultural life in Illinois—his most famous paintings include the Lincoln-Douglas Debate which hangs in the Illinois Capital Building and the Lincoln-Thornton Debate which hangs in the Shelby County Courthouse. Critics have declared that the artist's portraits of Lincoln are the best that have ever been done. Literature on Root can be found at the SCHS or the Public Library.



Dishwasher Invented

Josephine Cochrane had ingenuity in her genes. Her great grandfather was credited with the steamboat and her father John Garis helped build the original city of Chicago. Josephine is reported to have said, "If nobody else is going to invent a dishwashing machine, I'll do it myself." This was after servants had chipped her fine china as they washed it. In 1886, Josephine, of Shelbyville, patented the first dishwasher that was invented in a woodshed adjoining her home. This home still stands today as a private residence. For several years, she privately promoted her company, the Cochrane's Crescent Washing Machine Company. In 1893, she unveiled her invention at the World's Fair and won the highest award. Years later, with the purchase of the original patent, her company became the now famous KitchenAid Company. German Channel ARD filmed a documentary named Patents and Talents and were in Shelbyville for several days to film a reenactment of Josephine and her dishwasher using local residents.



Sta-Rite

Since 1917 Sta-Rite has been manufacturing hair pins. They helped develop the bobby pin and started manufacturing in 1926. During WWII business shifted production to supply millions of metal safety clips and arming wires for bombs in support of the US war effort. Their employees received an Army-Navy "E" for excellence award in 1943 & 1944. Sta-Rite employed 1000 persons during WWII. Sta-Rite is owned and operated by Robert & Noel Bolinger II of Shelbyville.

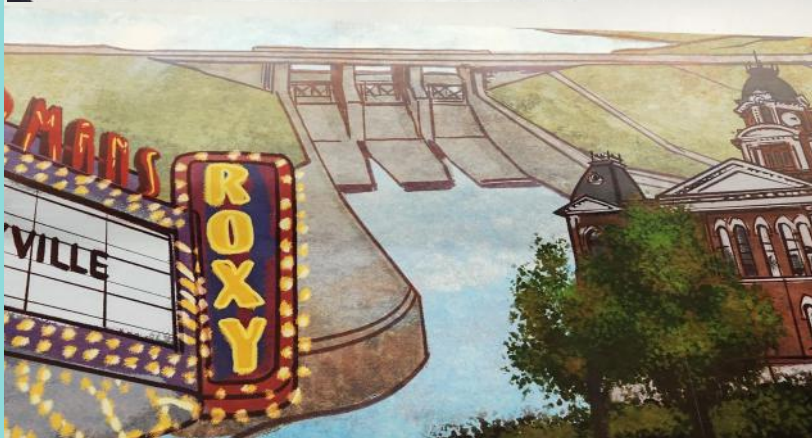

The Lincoln Public Square houses the Soldiers & Sailors Monument designed by Robert Root. The square was erected in 1907 in memory of the military men in the county. The square houses plaques to honor Abraham Lincoln who practiced law in Shelby County & Horace Tallman, inventor of the 1st mechanical pickup hay baler. In 2002, an eternal flame was dedicated to the military who have served. The granite base contains etchings, one of which is General Douglas MacArthur wading ashore in the Philippines in 1945 and alongside him is Shelbyville resident August West.



Shelby County Courthouse

was built in 1879 & dedicated in 1883. The upper courtroom houses historic paintings including Robert Root's depiction of the Lincoln-Thornton debate in Shelbyville that launched Lincoln's national political career. A Looking for Lincoln Wayside Exhibit and Lincoln and Thornton statues grace the front of the courthouse. Courtrooms are open for viewing when court is not in session. Open M-F 8am-4pm.



Shelbyville Public Library was dedicated in 1905. The library was built with a Carnegie Grant in French Renaissance style. It has computers, a video library, and plenty of reading and learning experiences for children throughout the year. 154 N Broadway.

The Pam and Bob Boarman Chevy BelAir Museum

224 W Main St, Shelbyville

This museum opened in 2005 with Bob's private collection of Chevy's. It's decorated in 50's sock hop style with black and white checkered floors. The walls are lined with 50's memorabilia, Chevy clocks and neon signs. A jukebox takes you back to the era. The museum has eight vintage cars, & was built so the cars could be in a controlled environment. Mr. Boarman restored most of the cars himself and collected cars for over 30 yrs.



Goat Tower The Tower of Baa is the largest goat tower in the U.S. It is modeled after a tower that Dave and Marcia Johnson saw in a wine magazine from S. Africa. The original goat tower was in Portugal. The Johnson's tower is 31 ft tall and has 5,000 bricks with 276 spiral steps that encompass the tower. Their property also contains unique musical stones, aviary sculptures, and more. Located at 1968 N 2500 E Rd.,



Thompson Mill Covered Bridge

was built in 1868 to span the Kaskaskia River. This 157 foot bridge is one of only five covered bridges remaining in Illinois. Although, traffic is no longer allowed on the bridge, you can still drive up & see how the bridge was built & admire the natural setting. 1718 E 300 N Rd., Cowden

The Moweaqua Coal Mine Museum

has displays and memorabilia from a bygone era in Midwestern prairie history. Most well-known for the December 24, 1932 disaster that killed 54 workers, the coal mine itself closed in 1935. The Moweaqua Coal Mine Museum was dedicated on May 25, 1986. The museum has been awarded a certificate of excellence for a Special Project by Congress of Illinois Historical Societies. 129 S Main St., Moweaqua, 1-4 pm Saturday & Sunday.

Moweaqua Living Memorial Tree Park is planted with native Illinois trees, prairie grasses and native wildflowers. Each year a new tree is planted in a person's honor.
