PutterAce is a fast, easy-to-use, and discreet app designed to help you improve your putting. It is based on Marcus Webb's proven coaching method, as outlined in *3-Step Method for Better Putting*.

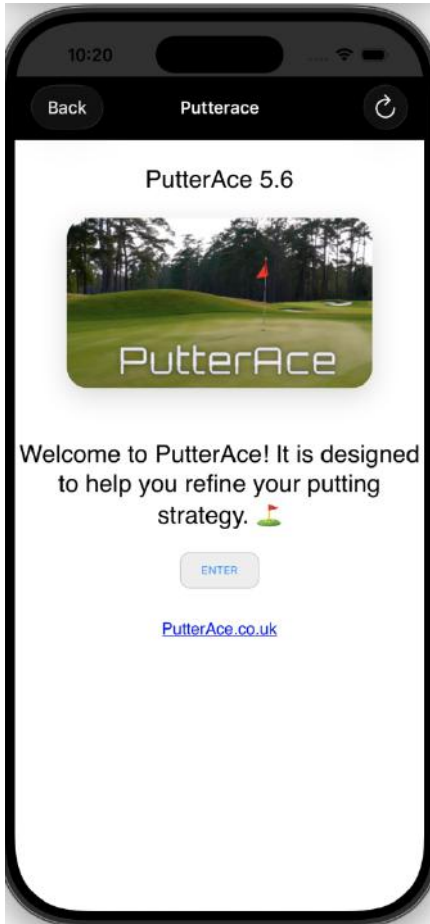
Before your round begins, you set up key conditions that create a **Round Modifier**. This correction factor is applied to every green during your round.

Tip box:

Complete setup before the first tee for best results.

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Screen 2: Weather Conditions

Content:

Choose **1 of 3** weather options

Reflects how conditions affect green speed

Callout:

Trust your judgement — accuracy improves results.

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Screen 3: Speed of the Green

Content:

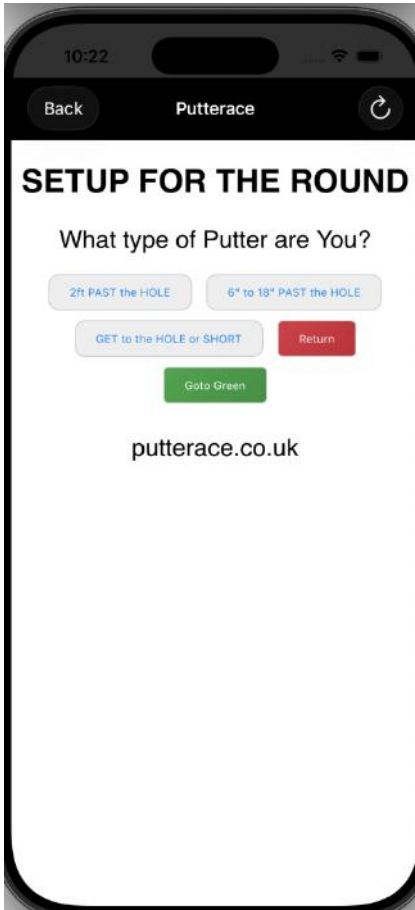
Simplified version of ***Stimp***

Based on your practice green assessment

Tip:

Be consistent, small errors compound.

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Screen 4: Your Putter Type

Content:

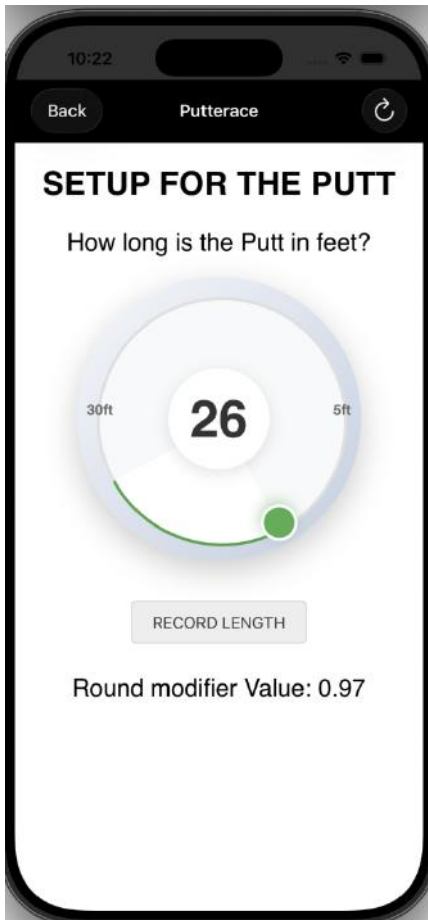
Choose 1 of 3 options reflecting your usual putting level

Generates the **Round Modifier Value**

important:

Note this number — it's useful for comparison on future rounds.

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Screen 5: Estimate the Distance

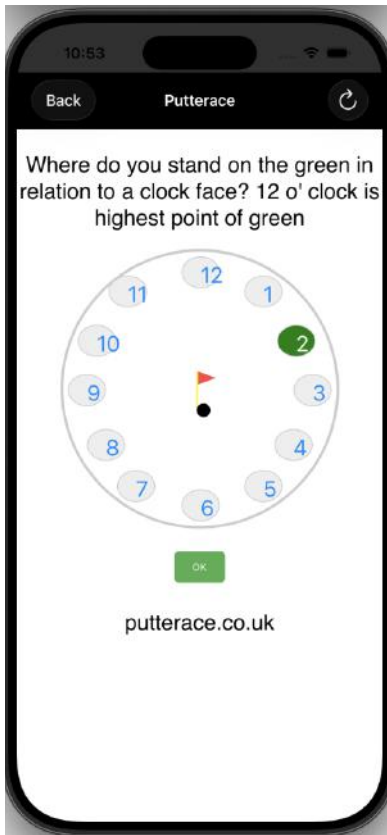
Content:

Enter your estimated putt length

Accuracy here directly improves the final recommendation

Note the Round modifier value for future rounds.

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Screen 6: Your Position on the Green

Key emphasis This is the **most important input**. Identify where you stand relative to the fall line. (I.e the highest part of the fall line is 12 o'clock and this is a straight line through to 6 o'clock)

Tip: Try to find the lowest part of the cup and view from here as this is your 6 o'clock position and you can identify where your ball is more easily on the clock face. Identify where you stand

relative to the high point. High point = 12 o'clock.

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Screen 7: Assess the Slope

As you approach the green, it is important to assess any natural contours that may affect your putt.

Options explained:

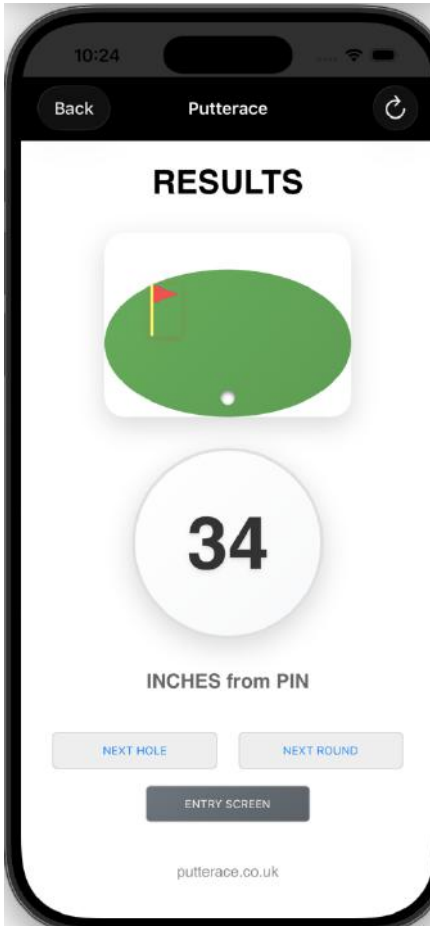
Flat: Choose this option if you cannot see much slope around or approaching the cup (hole).

Slight Slope: If unsure about how steep the slope is, pick this option.

Slope: if the ball is travelling over a part off the Green that the ball would not stop

off its own accord pick this option.

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Screen 8: Target Point Guidance

Content:

App displays inches left or right of the hole

Visualise the target point

Put your phone away

Square the putter and stroke smoothly

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Trust the Process

PutterAce guides you through thousands of possible combinations. Over time, patterns emerge. As your judgement improves, so will your scores.

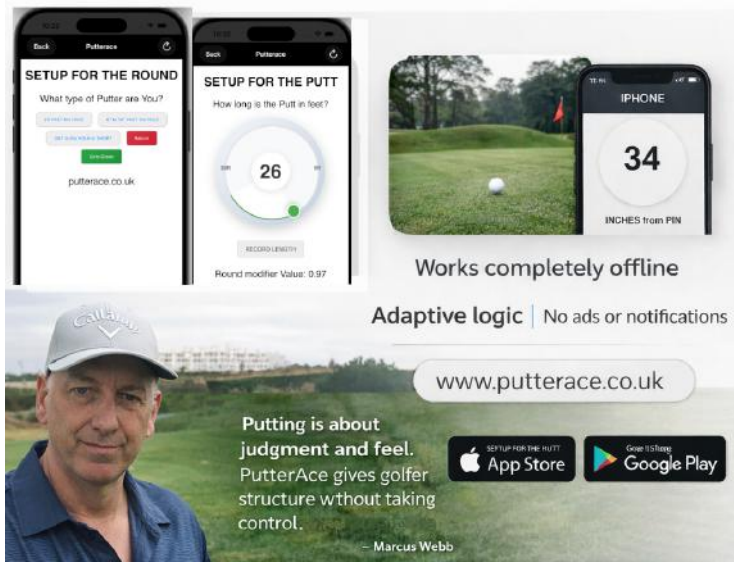
