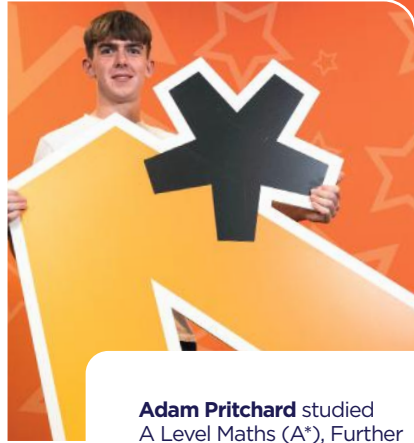

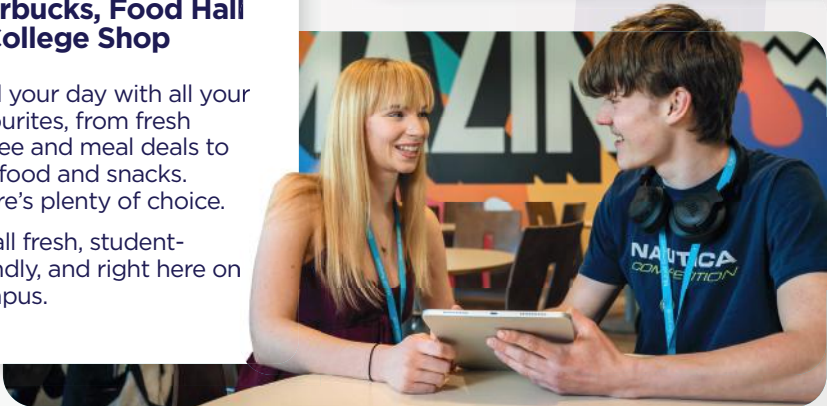

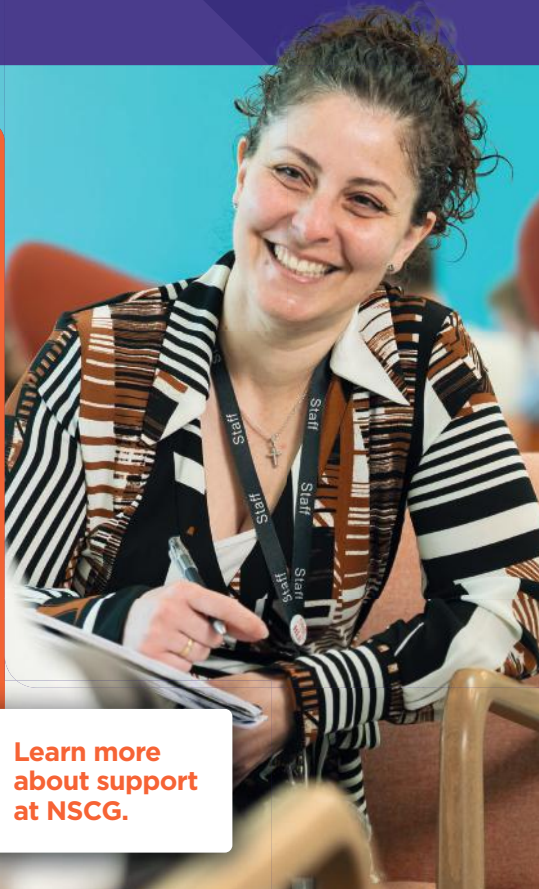

Introducing V Levels

As part of our commitment to providing innovative future-focused learning opportunities, we are excited to introduce V Levels from September 2027.

These new Level 3 qualifications are equivalent in size to one A Level and are designed to give you practical, career focused learning. V Levels can be studied alongside other qualifications such as A Levels, A+ Programmes or a Diploma to create a personalised study programme equivalent in size to three A Levels.

From 2027 we will offer V Levels in Accounting, Digital and Education, with more subjects planned from 2028.

A Levels

Level 3

Is this for me? Typically, students choose to study three A Level subjects over two years. However, you can choose to study two A Level subjects and one A+ Programme or a V Level (equivalent to one A Level) over two years.

What do I need? A minimum of five GCSEs at grade 5 or above including maths and English Language in subjects relevant to your chosen course.*

Where can it take me?

You can progress to university, a university-level course here at NSCG, a higher apprenticeship at NSCG or to employment.

T Levels

Level 3

Is this for me? T Levels are an industry-recognised two-year course that are an alternative to A Levels and vocational programmes, that bring classroom learning and an extended industry placement (at least 45 days) together on a course designed with businesses and employers.

What do I need? Typically, a minimum of five GCSEs at grade 5 or above including maths and English Language in subjects relevant to your chosen course.*

Where can it take me?

You can progress to university, a university-level course here at NSCG, a higher apprenticeship at NSCG or to employment.

Vocational / V Level Programmes

Level 3

Is this for me? Our vocational courses (three A Level equivalent) are practical, skills-based routes focused on employability and real-world experience in one subject area. Choose from a wide range of subjects, which you will study for two years.

What do I need? Four or more GCSEs at grade 4 or above, including maths and/or English Language at grade 4 or above.

Where can it take me?

You can progress to university, a university-level course here at NSCG, a higher apprenticeship at NSCG or to employment.

Apprenticeships

Available at Levels 2 to 5

Is this for me?

Apprenticeships are great if you want to jump straight into the world of work, earn a wage and pick up technical and practical skills while you study for a nationally recognised qualification.

What do I need? Two or more GCSEs at grade 4 or above in subjects relevant to your course. However, in some sectors, employers ask for a minimum of grade 5 in maths and English Language.

Where can it take me?

You can progress to a higher level apprenticeship, full-time course at NSCG or full-time employment.

Progression Pathways

Available on Levels 1 to 2

Is this for me? If you're not quite ready to join a Level 3 programme, our vocational Progression Pathways allow you to study at Level 1 or Level 2 and will help you build confidence, knowledge and skills to help you progress to your next steps.

You can progress to a higher level course, or explore apprenticeship or employment opportunities.

Skills Pathways

Available on Levels 1 to 3

Is this for me? Skills-based pathways offer hands-on training and industry-recognised qualifications tailored directly to specific careers such as hairdressing, beauty and construction. They are ideal for students who prefer practical learning, want to fast-track their entry into the workforce, or are looking to build targeted, real-world expertise.

What do I need? You'll usually start at Level 1 to develop the core practical skills needed for the industry, regardless of your GCSE profile.

Where can it take me?

You can progress to a higher level course, or explore apprenticeship or employment opportunities.

Entry Level

Is this for me? Our Foundation courses are nurturing 12-month programmes designed to support and prepare learners for their next educational or career steps by building essential core skills. These supportive courses provide a welcoming environment to bridge skill gaps, boost confidence and establish a solid academic or practical foundation.

Where can it take me?

You can progress to a higher level course.

GCSE Maths & English

If you don't get a grade 4 or above in English and/or maths you'll continue to study these important subjects alongside your main study programme.

This excludes A Levels and T Levels as grade 5 and above are needed for those pathways.

If you enjoy academic study and are aiming for university or a higher apprenticeship, our two-year A Level pathway is an excellent choice.

Most students take three A Level subjects, but high achievers can choose four or add an EPQ.

Alternatively, you can combine two A Levels with an A+ Programme or a V Level to build a career-focused programme that offers a more balanced mix of exams and coursework.

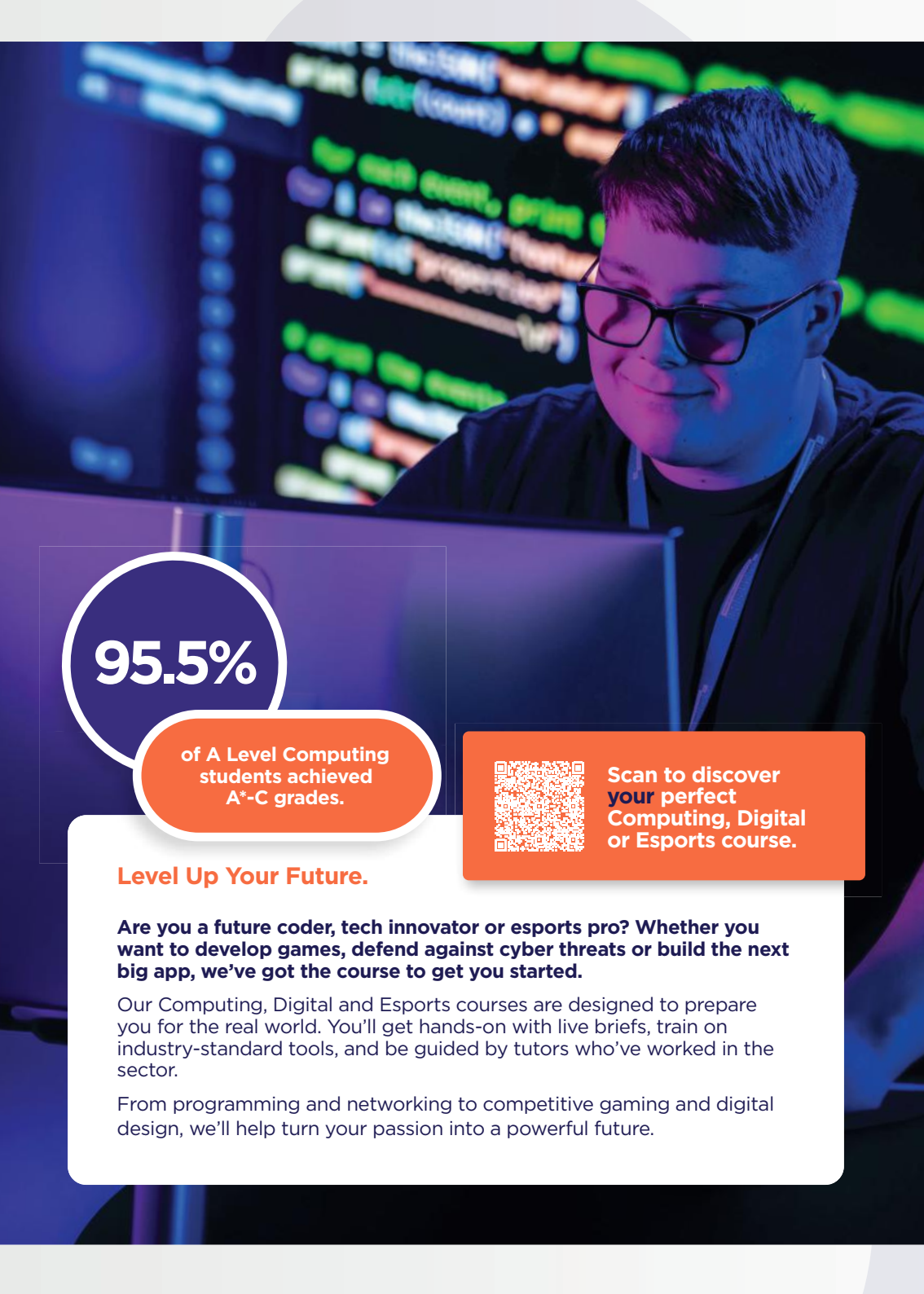

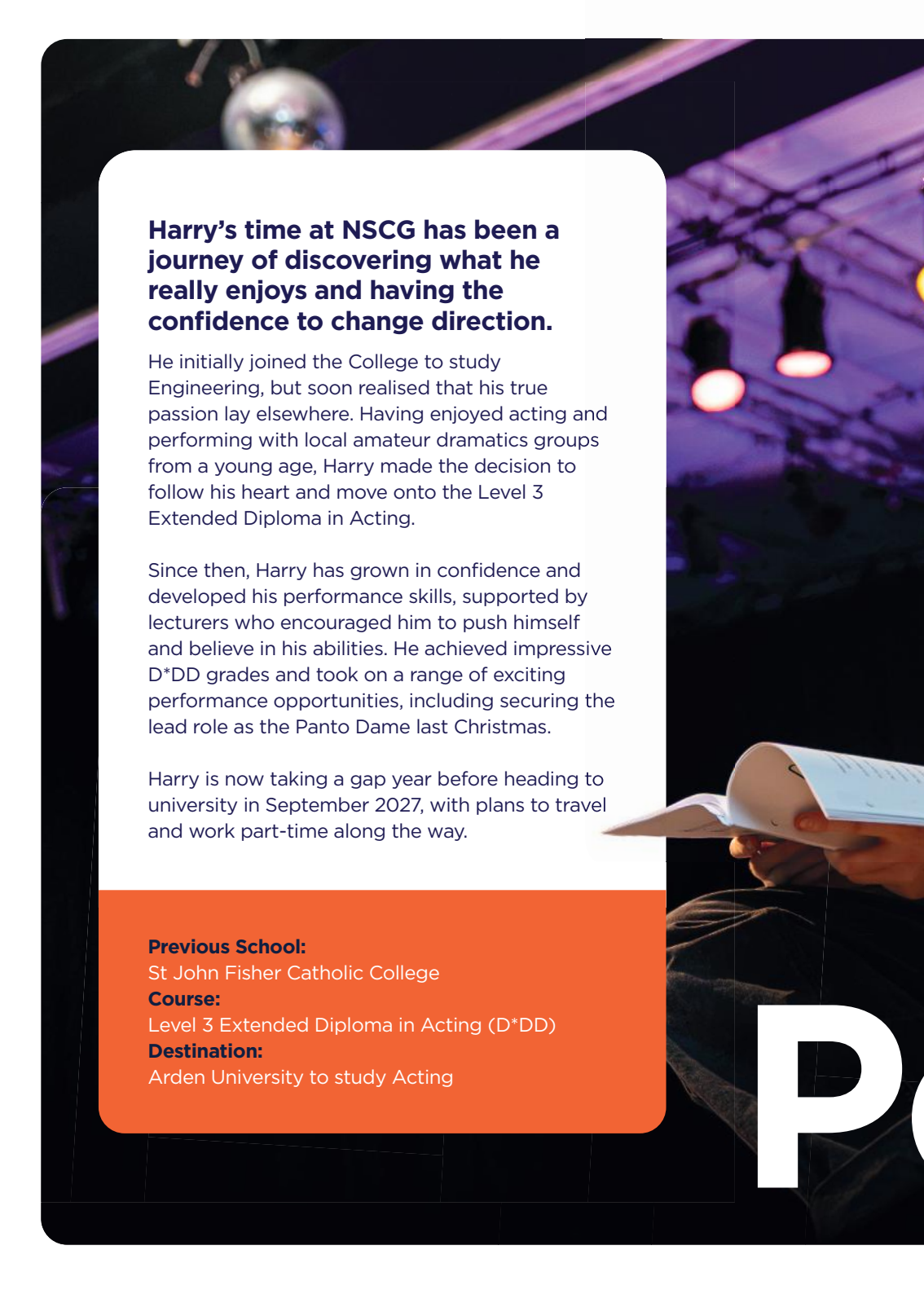
