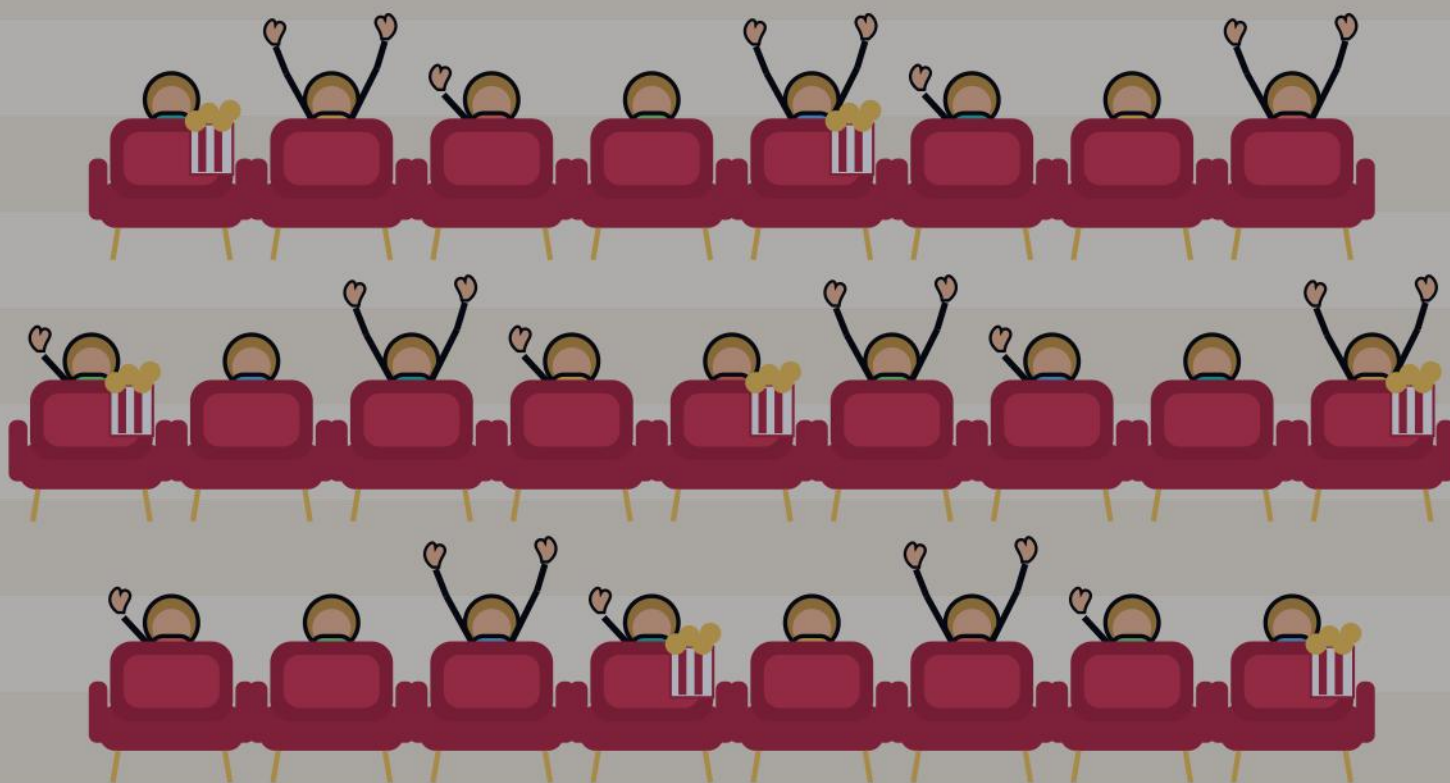
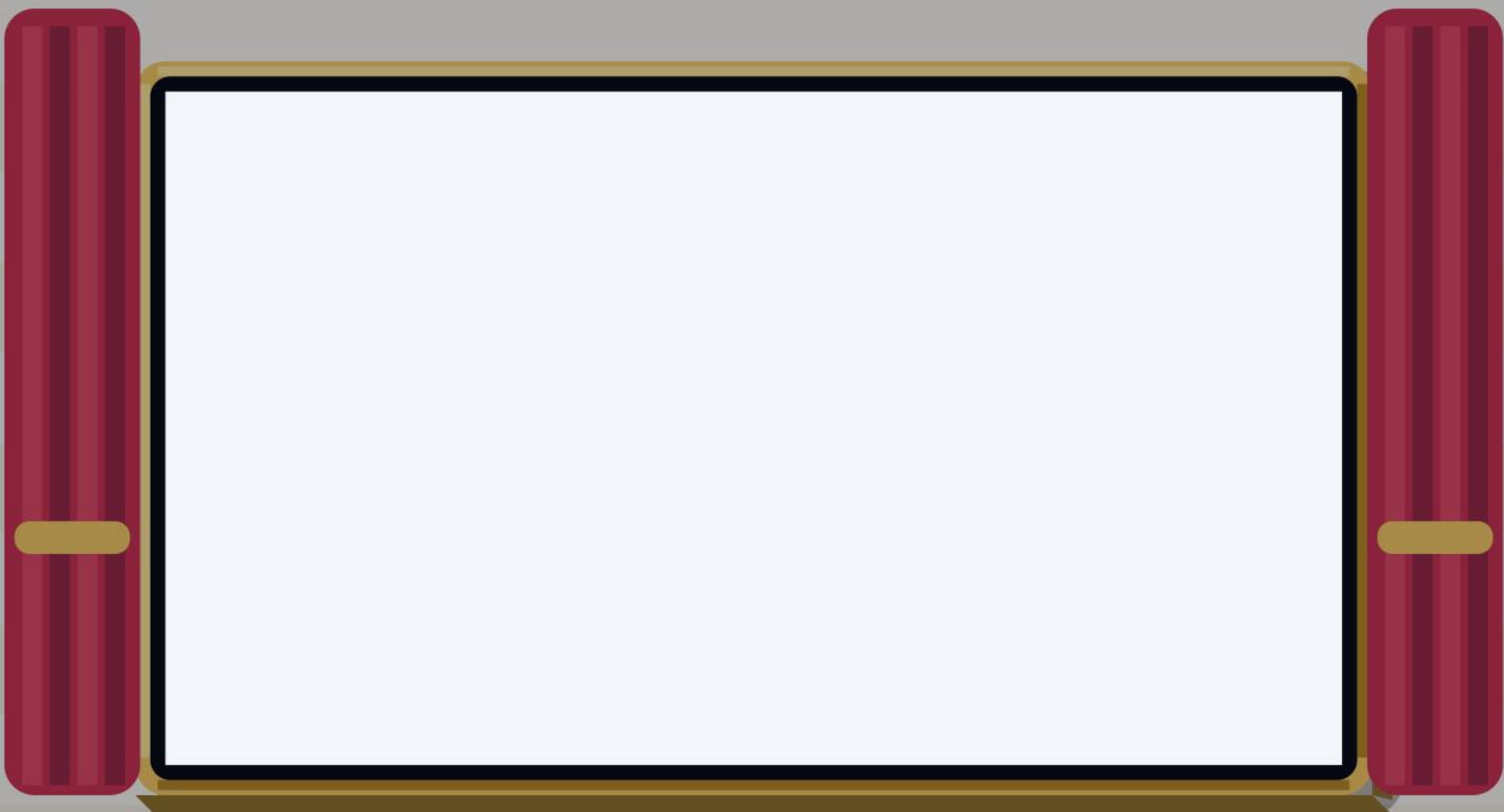

# Editor's *Corner*

## *Being Salt, Being Light... Being Transparent*

*My father-in-law loved the Sermon on the Mount. In fact, he often challenged people to memorize all 111 verses in the King James Version. Anyone who succeeded received \$111! Not many completed the challenge, but it was a wonderful way to encourage people to learn and treasure God's Word.*

*Matthew 5:13 - 16 says: 13 You are the salt of the earth; but if salt has lost its taste, how can its saltiness be restored? It is no longer good for anything, but is thrown out and trampled under foot. 14 "You are the light of the world. A city built on a hill cannot be hid. 15 No one after lighting a lamp puts it under a bushel basket, but on the lampstand, and it gives light to all in the house. 16 In the same way, let your light shine before others so that they may see your good works and give glory to your Father in heaven."*

*Salt preserves, adds flavor, and creates thirst. In the same way, Christians are called to preserve what is good, bring the hope of Christ into difficult situations, and cause others to hunger for a relationship with God.*

*Being salt means refusing to become so comfortable with the world that our lives no longer look different. We should bring kindness where there is cruelty, peace where there is conflict, truth where there is deception, and hope where there is despair.*

*Light reveals what darkness tries to conceal. It provides direction, brings comfort, and helps people find their way. Jesus is the true source of this light:*

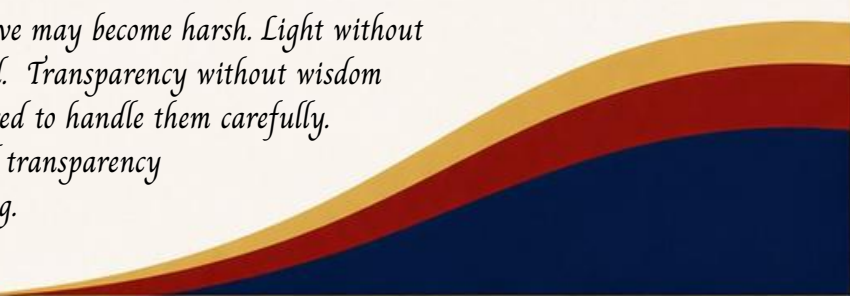
*"Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, 'I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness but will have the light of life.'" - John 8:12, NRSVUE*

*We do not create the light ourselves. We reflect the light of Christ. Just as the moon reflects the sun, believers are called to reflect Jesus through compassion, integrity, generosity, and faithful service.*

*Our light should not shine so that people will praise us. It should point them toward God. When we care for someone who is hurting, stand up for what is right, forgive someone who has wronged us, or quietly serve without seeking recognition, we allow others to see something of Christ in us.*

*Being transparent does not mean sharing every private detail of our lives with everyone. It means living honestly before God and others. It means allowing our faith to be genuine rather than hiding behind an appearance of perfection.*

*These three qualities must work together. Salt without love may become harsh. Light without humility may draw attention to ourselves instead of God. Transparency without wisdom may expose private matters to people who are not prepared to handle them carefully. However, when guided by the Holy Spirit, salt, light, and transparency become powerful expressions of authentic Christian living.*

## The Supremacy of Christ and the New Covenant

### Verse Outline

#### 1-4: Supremacy of Christ

Presents Jesus as the divine Son of God, greater than the angels and Moses. Believers are encouraged to remain faithful, enter God's promised rest, and trust Jesus as their compassionate High Priest.

#### 5 - 10: The New Covenant

These chapters present Jesus as the perfect and eternal High Priest of the new covenant. Through His once-for-all sacrifice, believers receive forgiveness, direct access to God, and confidence to remain faithful.

#### 11 - 13: The Life of Faith

Highlights the faithful examples of God's people and calls believers to persevere with their eyes fixed on Jesus. It concludes with practical guidance for holy living, love, worship, and service.

Although the writer of Hebrews is in question, traditionally it is attributed to Paul. Written around AD 60 - AD 69, it was a letter to the Hebrews to emphasize the superiority of Christ over the Old Covenant.

*"Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfecter of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning its shame, and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God." Hebrews 12:2*

## SYMBOLISM & IMAGERY



### High Priest

Jesus is the perfect High Priest who intercedes for humanity and offered Himself as the complete sacrifice, reconciling believers to God.

### Rest

Rest represents the spiritual peace and salvation found in Christ, inviting believers to stop striving and place their trust in God's promises.

### The New Covenant

The New Covenant represents the life-changing relationship believers have with God through Christ's sacrifice. It emphasizes grace and forgiveness rather than reliance on the law under the Old Covenant.
