CODE OF CONDUCT FOR MEMBERS

- k) Show concern, empathy and caution towards others that may be sick or injured
- l) Be a positive role model to all
- m) Respect and protect confidential information obtained through SLS activities or services; whether individuals and/or organisational information
- n) Maintain the required standard of accreditation and/or licensing of professional competencies, as applicable to the role(s)
- o) Ensure that any physical contact with others is appropriate to the situation and necessary for the person's skill development
- p) Refrain from intimate relations with persons over whom you have a position of authority
- q) Agree to abide by the codes
- r) Maintain a duty of care towards others
- s) Be impartial and accept the responsibility for all actions taken

Person in Position of Authority (PPA):

PPA include everyone who holds a position of authority in SLS, whether paid or unpaid, and includes, but is not limited to, all SLS Entity Individual Members. For the avoidance of doubt, PPA also includes Child or Young Person (CYP) who may hold a position of authority in SLS over other CYP.

AGE AWARDS

Each Age Group has a specific "Age Award" to complete throughout the duration of the season. Lessons will be completed and marked off by the Age Manager each Sunday.

Children must complete all the lessons of their Age Award, attend at least 5 Nipper days and complete their Run-Swim-Run evaluation **BEFORE THE END OF DECEMBER 2026** to receive a Surf Life Saving Queensland Age Group Certificate at the End of Season Presentation Day.

NEW CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS POLICY



Club Championships is an intra club championship held at least once over the 2026/27 Season. The championship is open to Under 8s to Under 14s. Points are awarded to the Top 6 Competitors in each event (*i.e. 1st-6 points, 2nd-5 points, 3rd-4 points etc.*). Age Champion trophies are awarded at our Final Nipper Presentation Day.

- Flags, Sprints, Wade, 1km Beach Run, Swim & Board

JUNIOR CARNIVALS

Surf Sports Competition



Surf Sports Competition begins from the Under 8 Age Group. Carnivals are inter club championships between Gold Coast and Queensland clubs.

- Under 8 to Under 10 carnivals are held over a single day (Saturday/Sunday).
- Under 11 to Under 15 carnivals can be held over a single day or a weekend (or 3 days for QLD Youth State Titles).

- 3.Competition Swim Evaluation
- 4.Age Award (before the end of December 2026)

**Steps 2, 3 & 4 automatically occur at Sunday Nippers*

PLEASE BE AWARE THAT IF YOUR CHILD IS INTENDING ON COMPETING THIS 2026/27 SEASON, ONE PARENT/GUARDIAN MUST HOLD EITHER THEIR SURF RESCUE CERTIFICATE, TECHNICAL OFFICIALS OR FIRST AID QUALIFICATION AND BE WILLING TO VOLUNTEER THEIR TIME AT CARNIVALS TO ASSIST WITH THE QUOTAS SET BY SURF LIFESAVING QUEENSLAND.
