Expectations

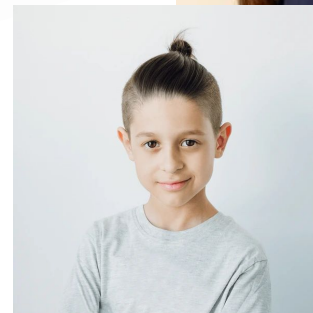
- Many of the notices come from the school office so keep an eye on your emails and Line messages

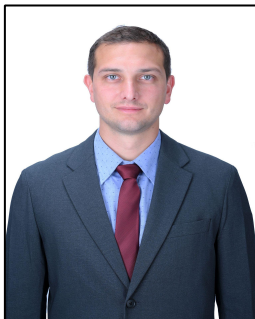

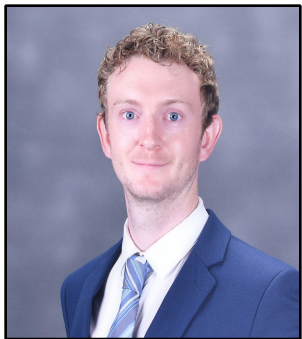

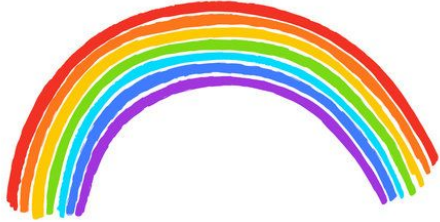
