Google Classroom

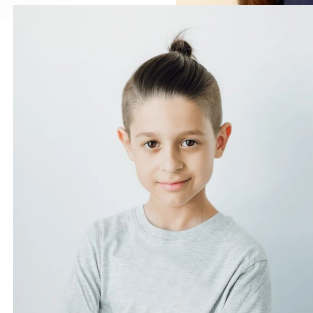
- There will be reading and spelling practice every week

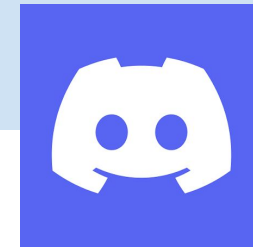
5 Trusted Adults



What are 5 Trusted Adults?

- A grown-up who you feel safe with and who listens to you.
- They are people you can talk to if you are **worried, sad, confused, or unsafe**.
- They will **take you seriously** and **help you get the right help**.
- 3 in school
- 2 out of school

Screen Time and Wellbeing



- We are a ***phone-free*** Primary School
- The same applies to ***smart watches***
- If you need to contact your child please contact the front office or the class teacher directly.
- **Importance of sleep - primary children need between 9-12 hours (NOW AND INTO KS3 - Miss Searles Reminder)**
- **Downtime, relaxation, play, and hobbies - they are critical for balanced growth, wellbeing, and lifelong learning.**
