3. Complete the sign-up process including the user pledge

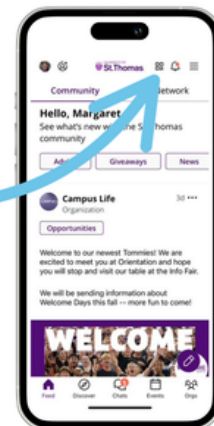

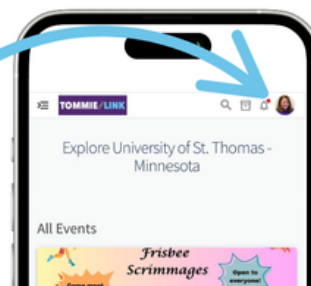

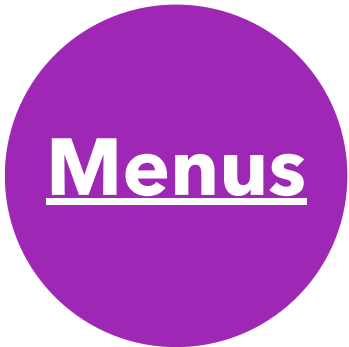
