Le Kempferhof Golf

Set across 85 hectares of scenic Alsatian countryside, it features mature woodland, 13 strategic water hazards, contoured greens, and views of the historic clubhouse and Château-Hôtel.

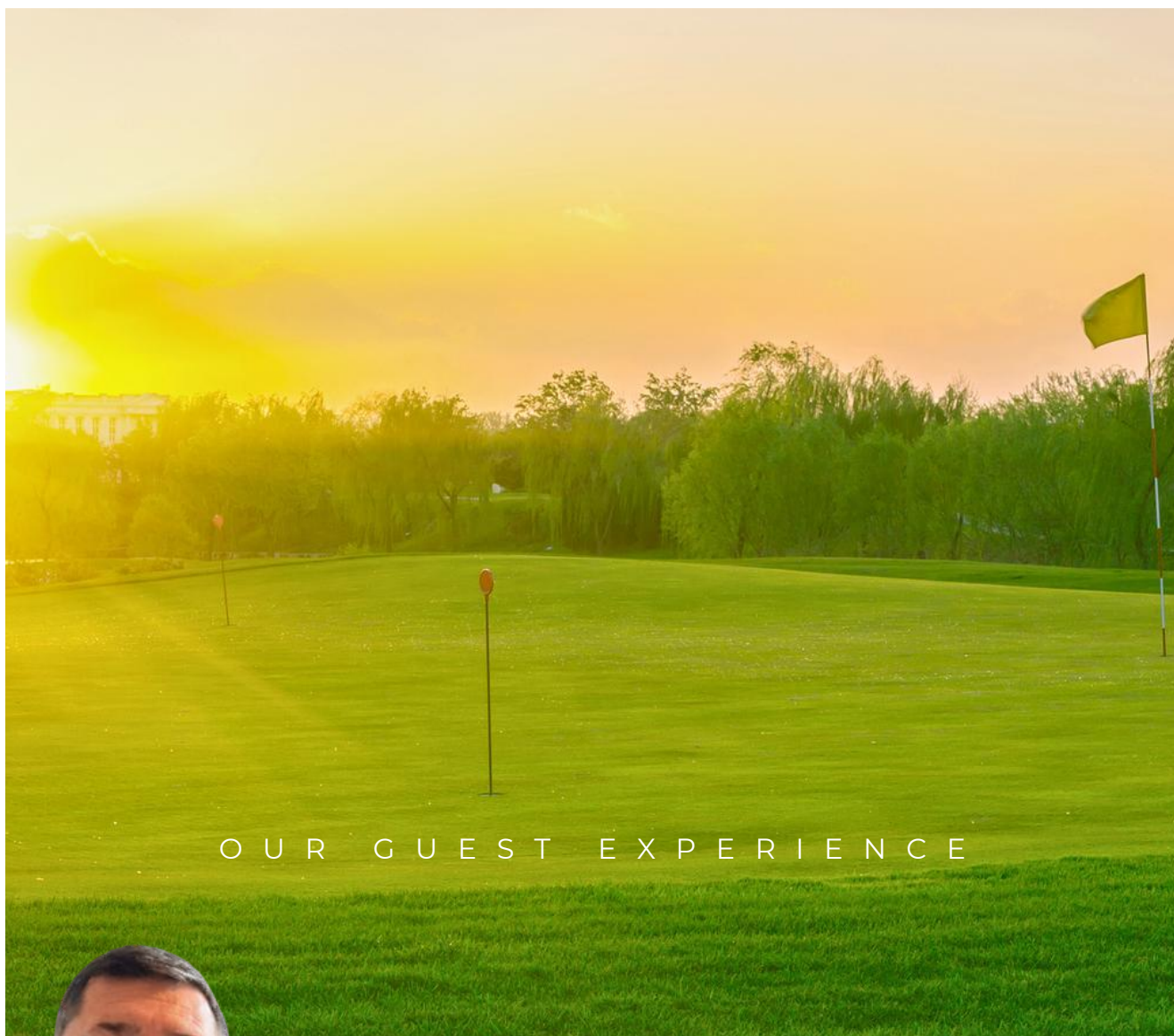
Jakobsberg Golf Resort

The resort has also served as a training base for Germany's national golf squad and hosted several German PGA events.

Kölner Golf Club

Opened in 2012, Kölner Golf Club is a modern golf complex set within Cologne's Outer Green Belt. The club features two 18-hole courses and a 9-hole short course, offering varied challenges for golfers of all levels. Its Championship Course combines broad fairways, strategically placed bunkers, water features and large, undulating greens, complemented by extensive practice facilities including a driving range and dedicated putting and chipping areas.
