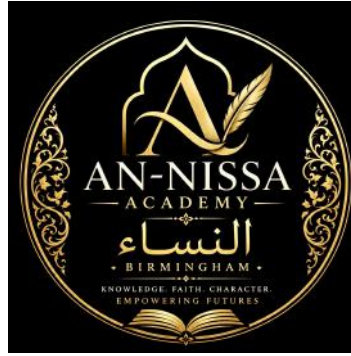

At An-Nissa Academy, every learner follows a pathway suited to their age, ability, previous learning and future aspirations. Our programmes are designed to develop knowledge, faith, character and confidence while supporting students to progress at a manageable and meaningful pace.

CHILDREN & YOUNG PEOPLE

Our provision for children and young people builds strong foundations in Qur'an, Islamic knowledge, worship and good character. Students learn in a safe, nurturing and encouraging environment where lessons are matched to their age and level of understanding.

Alongside Qur'an reading, memorisation and Islamic Studies, students are taught to develop respect, honesty, responsibility, self-discipline and confidence. Younger learners receive clear, engaging and age-appropriate instruction, while older students are encouraged to explore Islamic teachings more deeply and understand how Islam guides the challenges they face at school, online, at home and within wider society. Progressive levels, regular assessment and individual support allow every student to build upon previous learning and work towards clear goals. Where additional learning needs are identified, teaching may be adapted through structured routines, visual resources, repetition and personalised targets. Our aim is to nurture young Muslims who are confident in their identity, committed to their faith and prepared to make positive contributions to their families and communities.

ACADEMIC SUPPORT

At An-Nissa Academy, we believe that Islamic education and academic achievement should work hand in hand. Seeking beneficial knowledge, developing discipline and striving for excellence are important values that apply to both religious and secular education.

Our academic provision supports students across SATs, Key Stage 3, GCSE and A Level. Teaching is aligned with the UK curriculum and relevant examination boards, with support available through one-to-one tuition and selected small-group classes.

Students receive help to strengthen subject knowledge, close learning gaps, improve examination technique and become more confident, independent learners. They are also guided in developing transferable skills such as reading, writing, critical thinking, problem-solving, organisation, time management, revision and effective communication.

These same skills support Islamic learning. A student who can read carefully, organise notes, explain ideas, evaluate evidence and manage time effectively is better prepared to study Qur'an, Hadith, Fiqh, Arabic and the wider Islamic sciences.

By connecting academic development with Islamic values, we encourage students to approach all beneficial learning with sincerity, effort, responsibility and high aspirations.

SCHOLARLY PATHWAYS

Our scholarly pathways are designed for students who wish to move beyond foundational Islamic learning and undertake a deeper, more structured study of the Islamic sciences.

Students progress gradually through subjects such as Arabic language, grammar and morphology, Fiqh, Uṣūl al-Fiqh, Hadith, Tafsīr, 'Aqīdah, Sirah and Islamic history. Teaching combines traditional scholarship and recognised texts with clear explanations, guided reading, revision and regular assessment.

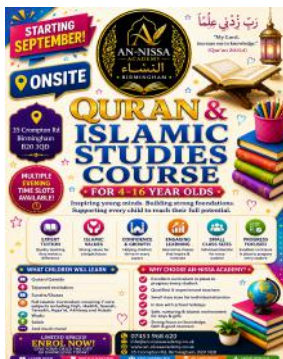
These pathways are not limited to gaining information. Students are encouraged to develop the sincerity, humility, patience and discipline required of a true seeker of sacred knowledge. Strong emphasis is placed upon Adab, responsible scholarship, spiritual development and applying knowledge with wisdom.

Different levels and study formats allow learners to begin from an appropriate starting point and progress according to their ability, experience and personal responsibilities. Whether a student seeks a strong foundation, personal development or preparation for a life of teaching and service, our scholarly pathways provide a carefully structured route towards deeper understanding.

A structured Qur'an and Islamic Studies programme using the An-Nasirah Publications curriculum. Students develop Qur'an reading, Qaidah, Tajweed, daily duas, surahs, Fiqh, Aqaa'id, Akhlaq, Seerah, Islamic history, Hadith, Adaab and Wudu and Salah. A short assessment supports appropriate class placement and individual progress.

Course overview

The Online Qur'an and Islamic Studies Weekday Programme provides children with regular, structured learning in Qur'an, Qaidah and the essential Islamic sciences. It is designed for families who value consistent tuition but require the convenience and safety of learning from home. Students are placed according to age, ability and previous learning so that they can progress at a suitable pace.

What students will study

- Qaidah: Arabic letter recognition, joining, pronunciation and reading fluency.
- Qur'an recitation: accuracy, fluency, Makharij and age-appropriate Tajweed.
- Surahs and Duas: memorisation, meanings and use in daily life.
- Aqeedah: essential beliefs presented in a clear and age-appropriate way.
- Fiqh: Wudu, Salah, fasting and practical rulings.
- Seerah and Tarikh: the life of the Prophet ﷺ and important events in Islamic history.
- Hadith, Adaab and Akhlaaq: developing good manners, honesty, respect and responsibility.

Learning outcomes

- Read the Qur'an with increasing fluency and accuracy.
- Build secure knowledge of daily worship and Islamic beliefs.
- Memorise selected Surahs and Duas with understanding.
- Develop consistent study habits and confidence.
- Show Islamic manners within home, school and community life.

Teaching and support

Live lessons are taught by experienced Huffaz, Alimahs and qualified teachers. Small groups allow for individual listening, correction and feedback. Progress is monitored through ongoing assessment, revision and communication with families.

Weekend learning for children who need a strong Islamic foundation in a supportive and engaging environment. Lessons cover Qur'an and Qaidah, Tajweed, essential surahs and duas, Wudu, Salah and the correct number of rak'ahs, alongside faith, Islamic character and confidence in worship.

Course overview

The Weekend Online Qur'an and Islamic Studies course offers an engaging and manageable way for children to build essential Islamic knowledge alongside school and family commitments. The programme combines Qur'an learning with practical worship, memorisation and age-appropriate Islamic Studies. Lessons aim to help children enjoy learning, practise regularly and understand how Islam guides their everyday life.

What students will study

- Qur'an or Qaidah according to each child's reading level.
- Correct pronunciation, fluency and introductory Tajweed.
- Memorisation of short Surahs with selected meanings and lessons.
- Essential daily Duas and when to use them.
- Step-by-step Wudu and Salah practice.
- The number of Rak'ahs in the daily prayers.
- Basic beliefs, Seerah, manners and Islamic character.

Learning outcomes

- Improve Qur'an reading and recitation.
- Perform Wudu and Salah with greater confidence.
- Memorise and use important Surahs and Duas.
- Develop love for Allah, the Prophet ﷺ and Islamic learning.
- Build positive weekend routines and regular practice at home.

Teaching and support

Lessons are live, interactive and age-appropriate, with small class sizes, encouragement, repetition and opportunities for individual correction. Certificates, praise and rewards may be used to recognise effort and progress.

A structured memorisation pathway with personalised targets, daily Sabak, Muraja'ah, Tajweed correction, progress monitoring and parent communication. Students are supported to memorise accurately, retain securely and develop discipline, sincerity, Islamic manners and a lifelong relationship with the Noble Qur'an.

Course overview

The Boys' Qur'an Memorisation / Hifz Tutoring programme is for students who can already recite the Qur'an and are ready to begin or continue structured memorisation. Each student follows personalised targets based on his starting point, ability, pace and previous learning. Equal importance is given to accurate new memorisation, secure revision and recitation with correct pronunciation and Tajweed. Regular tuition helps students develop confidence, discipline and a lasting relationship with the Book of Allah.

What students will study

- Initial assessment of Qur'an reading, Tajweed, fluency and existing memorisation.
- A personalised Hifz plan with suitable daily and longer-term targets.
- Sabaq (سَبَق - new lesson): memorising new Ayat accurately.
- Sabqi (سَبْقِي - recent revision): strengthening recently memorised passages.
- Manzil (مَنْزِل - older revision) and Muraja'ah (مُرَاجَعَة - review): maintaining earlier memorisation securely.
- Makharij al-Huruf (مَخَارِجُ الْحُرُوف - articulation points), pronunciation and practical Tajweed.
- Waqf and Ibtida (الْوَقْفُ وَالْإِبْتِدَاء - correct stopping and starting) where appropriate.
- Adab of the Qur'an, sincerity, consistency and preparation for listening and revision checks.

Learning outcomes

- Memorise new portions accurately and at a suitable pace.
- Retain earlier learning through a consistent revision system.
- Improve fluency, Makharij, Tajweed and confident recitation.
- Develop discipline, patience and independent study habits.
- Build love, respect and a lifelong connection with the Noble Qur'an.

Teaching and support

Experienced and qualified teachers provide live listening, correction and step-by-step guidance. Each student's workload reflects his accuracy, retention and capacity, with secure learning valued above speed. Consistent attendance and daily home practice are essential. Teachers monitor new work and revision and may provide parents with progress guidance. Admission is subject to an assessment confirming readiness for structured Hifz study.

An adapted Islamic Studies programme for learners with SEND, including ADHD, autism, SEMH needs, moderate learning difficulties and communication needs. Teaching may include small-group or one-to-one support, visual resources, structured routines, multi-sensory learning, adapted pacing and personalised educational targets.

Course overview

Our onsite SEND Qur'an and Islamic Studies provision offers a structured, nurturing environment for children who may find mainstream class settings difficult. The programme recognises that every learner has an individual profile of strengths, needs, communication preferences and pace. Following an initial assessment, the Academy develops suitable learning priorities so that each child can make meaningful progress without being compared unfairly with others.

What students will study

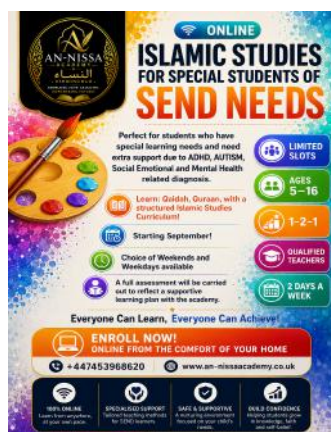
- Qaidah and Qur'an reading at an appropriate pace.
- Qur'an recitation and introductory Tajweed.
- Daily Duas and short Surahs through repetition and multi-sensory practice.
- Wudu and Salah taught through visual sequencing and practical demonstration.
- Basic Aqeedah, Seerah, Islamic manners and character.
- Communication, confidence and positive learning routines alongside Islamic study.

Learning outcomes

- Make measurable progress from an individual starting point.
- Develop confidence and a positive relationship with Islamic learning.
- Improve familiarity with Qur'an, worship and daily Islamic practice.
- Build routine, communication and independence where appropriate.
- Experience belonging within a safe and respectful Muslim learning environment.

Teaching and support

Teaching may include personalised learning plans, small groups, visual timetables, structured routines, short tasks, movement or sensory breaks, repetition, multi-sensory resources and positive reinforcement. Parents and carers are encouraged to share relevant information so that support can be planned responsibly. The Academy's educational provision does not replace clinical, therapeutic or statutory specialist services.

Course overview

The Online SEND Qur'an and Islamic Studies programme supports children who benefit from a quieter, more individualised learning environment at home. It may be suitable for learners with ADHD, autism, social, emotional or mental health needs, communication differences or other special educational needs. The programme begins with an assessment and discussion with parents or carers so that realistic learning goals and appropriate teaching methods can be agreed.

What students will study

- Qaidah and Qur'an reading broken into manageable steps.
- Pronunciation, basic Tajweed and supported recitation practice.
- Short Surahs and daily Duas using repetition, visuals and overlearning.
- Wudu and Salah through clear sequences and practical modelling.
- Core Islamic beliefs, Seerah stories and good character.
- Confidence, communication and positive participation within lessons.

Learning outcomes

- Progress at a pace that reflects the learner's needs.
- Increase confidence when reading or engaging with Islamic content.
- Build familiarity with worship and everyday Islamic practice.
- Reduce anxiety around learning through predictable routines.
- Celebrate achievable steps and develop a sense of success.

Teaching and support

Teachers may use simplified language, visual prompts, screen-based resources, repetition, choice, short tasks, planned breaks and consistent lesson routines. Parents may be asked to support with technology, transitions or practice between lessons. This is an educational programme and does not replace assessment or intervention from health, therapy or statutory SEND services.

Course overview

Teen 2 Deen is an engaging Islamic development programme created especially for young people. It provides a safe and respectful space where students can learn, ask honest questions and discuss the real issues they face at school, online, at home and among friends. The programme connects traditional Islamic knowledge with the challenges of modern teenage life, helping students understand not only what Islam teaches, but why those teachings matter.

What students will study

- Qur'an and Tafsir: selected verses connected to faith, identity, choices and character.
- Fiqh: practical rulings for worship, purity, Salah, fasting and everyday life.
- Puberty education: physical and religious responsibilities taught with sensitivity and appropriate boundaries.
- Aqeedah and Imaan: strengthening belief, answering common doubts and understanding a Muslim's purpose.
- Seerah: lessons in resilience, courage, compassion and leadership from the life of the Prophet ﷺ.
- Adab and Akhlaq: friendships, parents, social media, modesty, respect, confidence and responsible behaviour.
- Current issues: peer pressure, online influence, emotional wellbeing and making principled decisions.

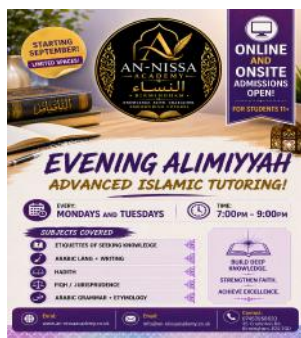
Learning outcomes

- Build confidence in Muslim identity and values.
- Develop the language and maturity to discuss faith-related questions.
- Make more informed choices in everyday situations.
- Improve Islamic knowledge, manners and personal responsibility.
- Feel supported by positive teachers and a healthy peer learning environment.

Teaching and support

Lessons are interactive and include guided discussion, scenarios, short activities, reflection and question-and-answer opportunities. Onsite students benefit from group interaction, while online students receive the same live teaching in a safe and convenient format.

A progressive Alimiyyah pathway for school-aged students who have completed Qur'an studies and possess foundational Islamic knowledge. Subjects include Arabic reading and writing, Nahw, Sarf, Qur'an translation, Fiqh, Hadith, Islamic etiquette, character development and study skills, progressing towards the major books of Hadith.

Course overview

The Evening Alimiyyah - Advanced Islamic Tutoring programme enables students aged 11 and above to pursue serious Islamic learning alongside school, college, university, employment or family responsibilities. Its focused two-evening timetable makes seeking knowledge more manageable while maintaining clear expectations and steady progression. Through guided study, revision and teacher support, students develop an informed understanding of Islam together with the discipline, character and Adab required of a sincere student of knowledge.

What students will study

- Adab Talab al-'Ilm (آداب طلب العلم - etiquettes of seeking knowledge): sincerity, respect, responsibility and beneficial study habits.
- Arabic language and writing: vocabulary, comprehension, translation and written expression.
- Nahw (النحو - Arabic grammar): sentence structure and the grammatical function of words.
- Sarf and Ishtiqaq (الصرف والإشتقاق - morphology and etymology): word patterns, roots and the formation of meanings.
- Hadith: selected Prophetic narrations with translation, explanation and practical lessons.
- Fiqh (الفقه - Islamic jurisprudence): worship and everyday rulings taught with correct application.

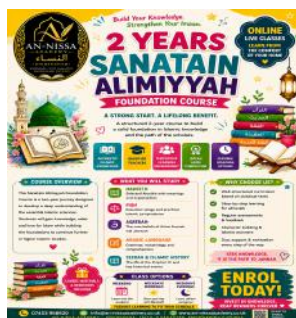
Learning outcomes

- Build a connected foundation in the core Islamic sciences.
- Use essential Arabic and Islamic terminology with growing confidence.
- Read and understand appropriately selected Arabic passages.
- Explain key Hadith and Fiqh lessons and apply them to daily life.
- Maintain sustainable study routines alongside other commitments.
- Grow in sincerity, Adab, discipline and love for sacred knowledge.

Teaching and support

Qualified teachers use explanation, guided reading, modelling, discussion and regular revision. The timetable helps busy learners progress consistently without an unmanageable weekly commitment, although preparation and review between lessons remain important. Online and onsite options improve accessibility. Placement and study level may be adjusted according to age, previous learning and readiness, with support for organising notes, revision and realistic learning goals.

Course overview

The Sanatain Alimiyyah Foundation Course is a carefully structured two-year programme designed to give students a strong and balanced introduction to the essential Islamic sciences. It is ideal for learners who want to deepen their understanding of Islam in a gradual and manageable way, whether as a meaningful course in its own right or as preparation for progression onto a full Alimiyyah programme. Students are guided through classical subjects in an accessible manner, helping them build sound knowledge, confidence and the study habits required for further Islamic learning.

What students will study

- Hadith: selected Ahadith with translation, explanation and practical lessons for daily life.
- Fiqh: essential rulings of worship and everyday Islamic practice, taught with clarity and application.
- Aqeedah: the core beliefs of Ahl al-Sunnah wa al-Jama'ah and how these beliefs shape a Muslim's outlook.
- Arabic language: introductory grammar, morphology, vocabulary and comprehension to support access to Islamic texts.
- Seerah and Islamic history: the life of the Prophet ﷺ, the development of the early Muslim community and key historical events.
- Islamic character and manners: developing sincerity, respect, discipline, responsibility and love for sacred knowledge.

Learning outcomes

- Understand the foundations of major Islamic subjects.
- Use key Arabic and Islamic terminology with growing confidence.
- Connect Islamic rulings and teachings to everyday life.
- Develop the discipline and learning skills needed for higher Islamic study.
- Progress with a stronger sense of faith, adab and responsibility.

Teaching and support

Lessons are delivered live by qualified teachers using a clear, step-by-step approach. Course materials and resources are provided, with regular assessment, feedback and pastoral encouragement. Students completing the programme may receive certification or Ijazah in accordance with the Academy's course requirements.

A traditional and comprehensive programme covering Qur'anic studies, Tafsir, Hadith, Fiqh, Usul al-Fiqh, Aqidah, Arabic, Nahw, Sarf, Balaghah, Seerah, Islamic history, principles of Hadith and Tafsir, Mantiq and other essential disciplines. Successful students graduate with a Sanad and certificate.

Course overview

The Alimiyyah Sisters Course is a comprehensive six-year programme for students who wish to undertake serious, traditional Islamic scholarship in a supportive female learning environment. The curriculum develops students gradually from foundational study to the guided reading and understanding of recognised Arabic and Islamic texts. Alongside academic knowledge, the programme places strong emphasis on sincerity, Adab, spiritual development, service and responsible leadership.

What students will study

- Arabic language: grammar, morphology, vocabulary, composition, translation and comprehension.
- Fiqh: detailed study of Islamic jurisprudence and its practical application.
- Usool al-Fiqh: the principles scholars use to understand legal texts and derive rulings.
- Hadith: selected collections progressing towards study of the major books of Hadith.
- Usool al-Hadith: terminology, classification and principles of Hadith study.
- Tafsir and Usool al-Tafsir: Qur'anic explanation and the principles required for sound interpretation.
- Aqeedah, Seerah, Islamic history, classical literature and character development.
- Research, presentation and study skills appropriate to advanced Islamic learning.

Learning outcomes

- Read and engage with classical Arabic texts under scholarly guidance.
- Develop a connected understanding of the major Islamic sciences.
- Explain Islamic teachings accurately and responsibly.
- Strengthen personal worship, character and service to others.
- Prepare for appropriate educational, community and further scholarly pathways.

Teaching and support

Students follow a progressive curriculum taught by qualified and experienced teachers. Assessment may include written examinations, oral reading, translation, class participation, assignments and revision. Completion and certification depend on meeting the Academy's academic, attendance and conduct requirements.

A certified course for busy learners seeking essential Islamic knowledge without a lengthy commitment. The programme includes translation and Tafsir of Juz 30, Hanafi Fiqh and Seerah, providing practical religious understanding, spiritual nourishment and a structured foundation for everyday Muslim life.

Course overview

The Islamic Essentials Course is a one-year foundation programme giving Muslim women the core knowledge needed for faith, worship and everyday life. It is suitable for beginners, students returning after a break and those wishing to organise knowledge gained informally. By bringing together Qur'an Tafsir, Fiqh and Seerah, the course helps students understand Islamic guidance and live it with greater confidence.

What students will study

- Qur'an Tafsir: meanings, themes and practical lessons of selected Surahs and verses.
- Applying Qur'anic guidance to faith, worship, character and decisions.
- Fiqh of purification: impurities, Wudu, Ghushl and Tayammum.
- Fiqh of Salah: conditions, essential actions and common errors.
- An introduction to fasting, Zakah and essential everyday rulings.
- Seerah: the life and mission of the Prophet Muhammad ﷺ.
- Lessons in patience, mercy, courage and reliance upon Allah.
- Islamic manners, sincerity, repentance and beneficial habits.

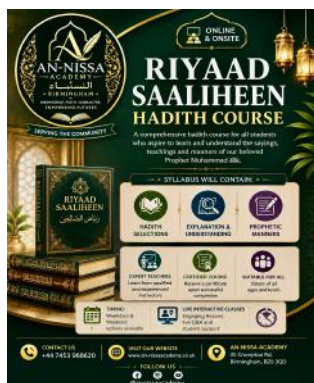
Learning outcomes

Qualified teachers deliver live, interactive lessons using clear explanations, practical examples, discussion and Q&A. Weekday and weekend options are available subject to enrolment. Assessment may include short tasks and revision activities. Certification is awarded in accordance with the Academy's completion requirements.

Students learn to understand the Prophet's ﷺ words and turn knowledge into positive changes in belief, worship and conduct.

What students will study

- Imam al-Nawawi رحمه الله and the purpose of Riyad-us-Saliheen.
- Selected Ahadith in Arabic with clear English translation.
- Important vocabulary, meanings and context.
- Relevant Qur'anic verses placed at the beginning of chapters.
- Sincerity, repentance, patience, truthfulness and reliance upon Allah.
- Humility, mercy, generosity, modesty and control of anger.
- Rights towards parents, relatives, neighbours and the community.
- Worship, Du'a, Dhikr, daily conduct and practical action points.

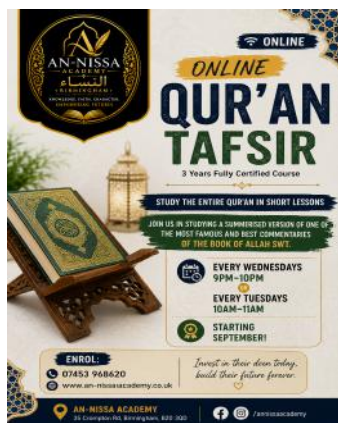

The course is designed for those who want to move beyond recitation and develop a meaningful understanding of Allah's Book without being overwhelmed by highly technical study. Students explore a summarised version of a recognised classical commentary, learning the main meanings, themes, guidance and lessons of each passage.

What students will study

- The central message and main themes of each Surah.
- Clear explanation of selected verses and important vocabulary.
- Relevant background and reasons of revelation where appropriate.
- Beliefs, rulings, moral lessons and spiritual guidance found in the verses.
- Connections between Qur'anic passages and the life of the Prophet ﷺ.
- Practical reflection: how the Qur'an guides worship, character, family life and community conduct.

Learning outcomes

- Gain an overview of the complete Qur'an and its major themes.
- Understand selected verses within their context.
- Develop a stronger personal connection with the Qur'an.

Eligible students may progress towards Ijazah certification upon completing the Qur'an to the required standard.

Course overview

The Sisters' Qur'an Tajweed course provides women with dedicated time to strengthen their recitation and deepen their connection with the Qur'an in a supportive, sisters-only environment. Daytime classes are especially suitable for mothers and women who wish to study while children are at school, although places remain subject to the Academy's admissions arrangements. Whether a student is developing basic fluency or refining existing recitation, teaching is adapted to help her progress with confidence and care.

What students will study

- Qur'an reading: improving fluency, accuracy and confidence.

Students examine historical origins, beliefs and methodologies, including Sunni schools, Ash'ari and Maturidi theology, Salafiyyah, Shi'a Islam, Ibadiyyah and contemporary movements, while developing informed and respectful discussion.

Course overview

This course provides a balanced study of major theological, legal and reform movements associated with Muslim history. Students examine how groups developed, the beliefs or approaches for which they became known, and the historical settings that shaped them. The aim is to replace assumptions with informed understanding, distinguish significant doctrinal differences from valid juristic diversity, and encourage principled discussion without abuse, mockery or unnecessary division.

What students will study

- Ahl al-Sunnah wa al-Jama'ah and the development of Sunni scholarship.
- Ash'ari and Maturidi theology, and discussions surrounding the Salafi approach.
- The four Sunni schools of law: Hanafi, Maliki, Shafi'i and Hanbali.
- Shi'a history and major branches, including the Ithna 'Ashari tradition.
- Ibadi history and beliefs in their historical context.
- South Asian movements including Deobandi, Barelwi, Jama'at Tabligh and related trends.
- The Ahmadi/Qadiani movement and the Islamic doctrine of finality of Prophethood.
- Isma'ili traditions and selected modern movements and organisations.
- How creed, jurisprudence, spirituality and political history differ as categories.
- Respectful disagreement, addressing misconceptions and protecting Muslim unity.

The programme combines authentic knowledge with spiritual reflection and preparation.

Course overview

The Islamic Eschatology course explores the journey to the Hereafter from death and Barzakh through resurrection, judgement and the final abodes. It also examines the signs preceding the Last Day as described in the Qur'an and authentic Sunnah. Rather than encouraging speculation or sensationalism, the course aims to build sound belief, spiritual awareness and practical preparation through repentance, worship and good deeds.

What students will study

- Death, the departure of the soul and the believer's preparation for death.
- Life in the grave (Barzakh), questioning, comfort and punishment.
- Minor signs of the Hour and how scholars understand their reports.
- Major signs: al-Mahdi, al-Dajjal, the descent of 'Isa عليه السلام and Ya'juj and Ma'juj.
- Other major signs including the smoke, Beast, landslides and the sun rising from the west.
- Resurrection, gathering, accountability, records, Mizan and Sirat.
- Intercession (Shafa'ah), the Pond (Hawd) and Allah's perfect justice and mercy.
- Jannah and Jahannam: their reality, descriptions, levels and lasting consequences.
- Divine decree, responsibility and avoiding unsupported predictions about the unseen.
- Practical preparation through faith, repentance, worship and service.

Learning outcomes

- Develop a sound overview of Islamic teachings concerning the Hereafter.
- Explain the main stages from death to final judgement.
- Identify the major signs using responsible, source-based understanding.
- Avoid sensational claims, date-setting and unreliable narrations.

Topics are taught respectfully, with appropriate privacy and the opportunity to ask questions in a sisters-only learning environment.

What students will study

- Taharah: purification, types of water, impurities, Wudu, Ghusl and Tayammum.
- Menstruation, postnatal bleeding and irregular bleeding: recognising the rulings and their effect on worship.
- Salah and missed prayers: conditions, common mistakes and female-specific matters.

- Tawbah (التَّوْبَةُ - repentance), hope in Allah's mercy and commitment to change.
- Humility, seeking help, honest self-reflection and personal accountability.
- Salah, Du'a, Dhikr and Qur'an engagement for stability and spiritual strength.
- Triggers, healthier routines, managing setbacks and relapse-prevention strategies.
- Boundaries, trustworthy support networks, renewed purpose and service to others.

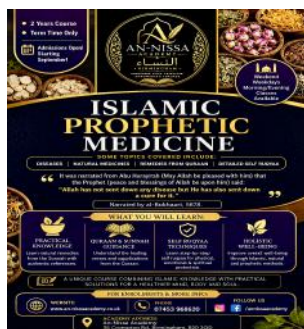

- Step-by-step self-Ruqyah, protection and common misconceptions.
- Ethics, safeguarding and recognising when qualified medical help is required.
- Evaluating evidence and avoiding exaggerated or unverified treatment claims.

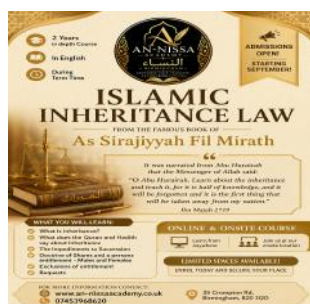

Course overview

The Islamic Inheritance Law course is an in-depth two-year study of the principles of Mirath and Fara'id through the recognised classical text As-Sirajiyyah fi al-Mirath. The subject combines Qur'anic rulings, Prophetic guidance and precise legal calculation. Students learn how an estate is prepared for distribution, which relatives may inherit, the shares allocated to different heirs and the circumstances that affect entitlement. The programme is suitable for serious learners seeking structured knowledge of an important and often neglected area of Islamic law.

What students will study

- The meaning, importance and sources of Islamic inheritance law.
- Rights connected to the estate before distribution: expenses, debts and valid bequests.
- Causes of inheritance and impediments that may prevent succession.
- Fixed-share heirs (Ashab al-Furud) and their Qur'anic entitlements.
- Residuary heirs ('Asabah) and the order in which entitlement is considered.
- Male and female heirs, including spouses, parents, children and siblings.
- Exclusion (Hajb), increase ('Awl), return (Radd) and selected special cases.
- Bequests (Wasiyyah), common misconceptions and the limits of testamentary freedom.
- Step-by-step inheritance calculations and worked examples.
- Applying the principles of As-Sirajiyyah under qualified scholarly guidance.

Learning outcomes

- Explain the main principles and terminology of Islamic inheritance.
- Identify common heirs and their possible entitlements.
- Recognise factors that exclude or change a person's share.
- Complete structured inheritance calculations in standard cases.
- Understand when a case requires specialist scholarly and legal advice.

Course overview

The Arabic Language Diploma is a structured two-year programme for non-Arabic-speaking learners who wish to understand and use Modern Standard Arabic. Using the Bayna Yadayk / Arabic for All series, students develop the four connected language skills of listening, speaking, reading and writing. Communication is placed at the centre of learning, while vocabulary, grammar and written accuracy are introduced progressively through meaningful situations. The course also offers insight into Arabic expression and cultural contexts, including language used across the Muslim world.

What students will study

- Listening comprehension through dialogues, instructions and everyday situations.
- Conversation and speaking practice to develop useful expressions, confidence and accurate responses.
- Reading Arabic passages with increasing fluency, understanding and attention to pronunciation.
- Writing words, sentences and short passages with correct spelling and structure.
- Modern Standard Arabic vocabulary for personal, educational, social and cultural topics.
- Grammar and sentence patterns taught in context rather than as isolated rules.
- Bayna Yadayk textbook and workbook activities, including guided exercises, cultural contexts and revision.

Learning outcomes
