PLINTH

A foundation for every table.

A plinth is an architectural base, the quiet structural element that supports everything placed upon it. It does not seek attention. Yet without it, nothing stands.

The Plinth Collection by Clay Craft, designed by Lagavi, takes its cue from this principle. Four glazes. One design language. An obsessive attention to rim profile, foot diameter, and the way light moves across a surface.

The chef is the artist. The diner is the audience. And the table is where the performance happens.



DESIGN PHILOSOPHY

Form as Function.

The Plinth Design Language

Clean silhouettes with raised foot rings, a restrained rim profile, and surface finishes developed for the demands of commercial hospitality.

Made for Hospitality

Chip-resistant, stackable, calibrated for service. Glaze chemistry resists cutlery marking and remains consistent after repeated dishwasher cycles.

Four Glazes, One Intention

Frost. Basalt. Amber. Ink Blue. Each carries its own personality while remaining part of the same quiet family. Mix on a table, or use alone, both work.



GLAZE STORY

Frost

Matte White Glaze · A warm matte white with crystalline nodules that catch light like morning ice.

Frost is a warm matte white with crystalline nodules that catch and diffuse light differently depending on angle and source, the same piece reads differently under pendant light or candlelight. Not blank white. Material character, depth, warmth. Equally at home across breakfast service and fine dining.

GLAZE CHARACTERISTICS

- Warm matte white finish
- Crystalline nodule texture catches light
- Food-safe, dishwasher stable
- Resists cutlery marking
- Consistent colour across production runs





GLAZE STORY

Basalt

Matte Black Glaze · Depth without heaviness. Black that serves the food.

Basalt is a deep matte charcoal-black that absorbs light rather than reflecting it. It photographs beautifully, makes food colour pop, and holds its character under warm restaurant light. The matte surface develops a micro-patina with use that only deepens its quality.

GLAZE CHARACTERISTICS

- Deep matte charcoal-black
- Non-reflective, absorbs ambient light
- Enhances food colour contrast
- Food-safe, dishwasher stable
- Resists cutlery marking

FIVE REASONS

Why Plinth.

01

Rims Designed to Frame

Dimensioned to contain the food composition — a visual frame built into the form.

02

Stacking Architecture

Recessed geometry and calibrated foot rings make every piece dimensionally stackable.

03

Glaze-Consistent Production

Glaze chemistry tested for colour consistency across large batches and repeated dishwasher cycles.

04

Cutlery-Resistant Surface

Both matte and gloss finishes resist grey metal marks from everyday cutlery.

GLAZE STORY

Amber

Gloss Amber Glaze · A warm, kiln-fired glaze with caramel undertones.

Amber is a kiln-fired gloss with caramel undertones that shift from golden to deep terracotta depending on how light catches the surface. Inspired by the moment molten earth cools. Suited to farm-to-table dining and craft-forward menus where tableware is part of the story.

GLAZE CHARACTERISTICS

- Warm gloss finish, caramel to terracotta
- Shifts under different light sources
- Pairs with wood, linen, stone surfaces
- Food-safe, dishwasher stable
- Resists cutlery marking

Plinth is where food takes centre stage. Rims that frame the composition. Forms that create depth and hierarchy on the table. A glaze vocabulary that rewards close attention without announcing itself.



GLAZE STORY

Ink Blue

Gloss Blue Glaze · Depth meets refinement. A glaze that commands the table.

Ink Blue is a deep ocean blue with a full gloss finish that brings quiet authority to the table. The colour shifts between midnight and teal depending on the light, composed under warm restaurant lighting, luminous in natural daylight. It suits elevated tasting menus, upscale casual dining, and hotel F&B environments where the table is part of the guest experience. It pairs with silver, brass, and stone, and with any food plated with intention.

GLAZE CHARACTERISTICS

- Deep ocean blue, reactive speckle finish
- Full gloss — elevates the silhouette
- Suited to fine dining environments
- Pairs with metal cutlery and stone
- Food-safe, dishwasher stable
- Resists cutlery marking
