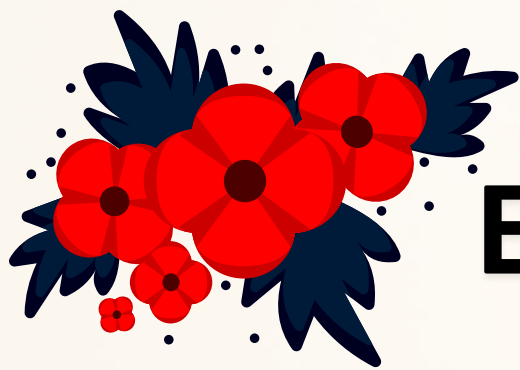

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Itinerary-

Day 1: Welcome to Amsterdam! After our transfer from the airport to our accommodations, we will fall in love with Amsterdam on a canal cruise through the city's canals and marvel at the beautiful historic merchant houses, picturesque canal bridges, monumental Westerkerk, Ann Frank House, and more. Later, celebrate with a welcome dinner with our Tour Director.

Day 2: After a good night sleep, we travel to Arnhem to visit the John Frost Bridge, Groesbeek Canadian War Cemetery. After lunch we arrive at the Freedom Museum for a tour and a Groesbeek Market Garden Tour. After arriving at our hotel, the evening is at your leisure.

Day 3: Today's travel takes us to Dunkirk, where we spend some time in the Dunkirk War Museum and visit Dunkirk Beach where soldiers queued for evacuation, as well as the Dunkirk Memorial and Commonwealth War Cemetery. After arriving at our hotel, the evening is at your leisure.



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Day 4: On our way to Ypres today we will visit the Tyne Cot Cemetery, the Passchendaele memorial, the Brooding Soldier and the Essex Farm Cemetery – a World War I Commission burial ground with the John McCrae Memorial Site. After dinner we will attend the Last Post Ceremony at the Menin Gate Memorial before returning to our Dunkirk hotel.

Day 5: This day to remember sees us visit the Canadian National Vimy Memorial, the Commonwealth War Graves Commission in Beaurains, Dury Memorial – a WWI Canadian War Memorial which commemorates Canadian Corps in the Second Battle of Arras, and the Bourslon Wood Canadian Memorial. After arriving at our hotel in Amiens the evening is at your leisure.

Day 6: From Amiens we will visit the Thiepval Memorial and the Lochnagar Crater, and we stop at the Beaumont-Hamel Newfoundland Memorial to walk the Battle of the Somme. After arriving back to our Amiens hotel, the evening is at your leisure.



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Day 7: We depart Amiens this morning and travel to Dieppe to visit the Dieppe Canadian War Cemetery and the beaches at Puys and Pourville. After arriving at our hotel in Amiens the evening is at your leisure.

Day 8: While traveling from Dieppe to Caen we will visit the Juno Beach Memorial Museum and park, followed by some free time to walk on the beach. We will also visit Saint-Aubin and the Bernieres-sur-Mer Canadian War Cemetery with a stop to take photos of Canada House thought to be the first house liberated by the Canadian troops who landed on Juno Beach. After arriving at our hotel in Caen the evening is at your leisure.

Day 9: This morning, as we travel to Paris, we visit the Memorial Pegasus Museum and see the Bridge (one of the events enacted in the movie "The Longest Day"). We reach Paris this evening and enjoy a Seine River Cruise giving us a whole new perspective of the City of Light. This evening we will enjoy a Farewell Dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 10: Travel day. After breakfast we will be transferred to Charles de Gaulle Airport for our flight home.
