What a year! Our community came together and achieved amazing things. We set an audacious goal for our capital campaign, and you all showed up huge, helping us hit our goal of \$3,500,000! This allowed us to pay off our 1st Street building completely, and will allow us to fully renovate it, as well as lease and renovate a storefront. The dream of reimagining what food relief looks like is becoming reality.

At the same time we celebrate, we acknowledge that need was higher than ever before in 2022. Thanks to all of our incredible volunteers we were able to welcome more guests with compassion and hospitality than ever before.

As exciting as 2022 was, we look forward eagerly to 2023, as we move closer to a completed warehouse and office space, and a storefront that will house our new Community Store and Kids Korner. Thank you all for your financial support, time, prayers and service. Together, we are The Giving Plate!

2022 will be a year I will never forget. It taught me many lessons about the power of stepping in faith toward our dreams and what is possible when we do, as well as the power of a community coming together around an idea.

I am still in awe of how you helped us keep ahead of the rapid growth we were experiencing in the need for our services and the generosity that poured in to help us raise \$3.5 million for our capital campaign in 15 months!

Thank you for partnering with us on behalf of our hardworking neighbors' next door. With over 90% of our guests housed, we are passionate about keeping them that way. We believe that with your help, we are helping prevent an increase in homelessness in Central Oregon. The groceries and food support we offer our guests can help them redirect dollars toward their rent, utilities, gas to get to work, or to navigating the unexpected curveballs life throws at us all.

2023 will be a fun year of watching dreams come to life as we reimagine food relief and create a Community Store, Kid's Korner Store, and finish the rehab of our warehouse. Thank you for positioning us to stay on the front lines of hunger in Central Oregon. You are The Giving Plate, and together, we are fighting hunger and feeding hope.

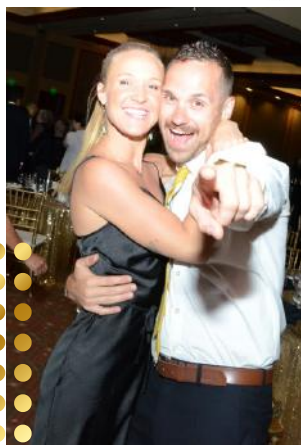

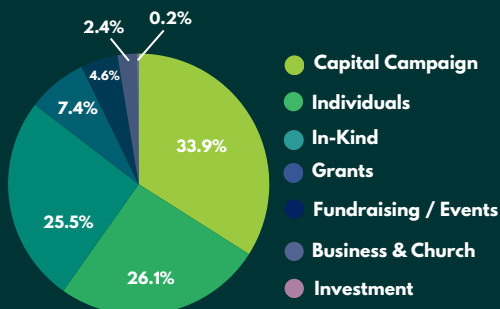

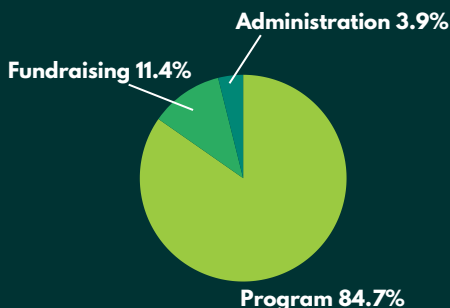
