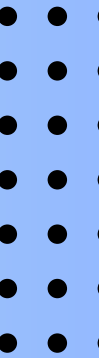

Facilities

Adult Education

Pastoral Care

Our Pastoral Care system supports the overall development of each student. Each year group has a Year Head and each class group has a Tutor. The Tutor meets the class group each morning for roll call and informal discussion. At weekly Assembly, the Year Head and Chaplain address the students for prayer and to re-enforce the ethos of the school. Our Year Heads, Chaplain, Guidance Counsellors, Tutors and teachers liaise to ensure a co-ordinated approach to supporting students. The Merit System in operation in the school also encourages students to strive to reach their potential in all aspects of school life.

Student Council

In Scoil Mhuire there are many opportunities where student involvement is encouraged such as Prefects, Mentors, Student Council and Leaders of Learning in our hubs.

The Student Council is an integral part of school life: it is comprised of elected representatives from each year group. These students meet regularly to discuss issues which affect students and to make a positive contribution to the development of the school.

Transition from Primary School

Our '**Step up to Secondary School**' programme helps our 1st year students find their feet in their new school and get to know their way around, become familiar with the building, their classrooms and teachers. The 6th yr. Mentors assist with this programme, being available to help the students get settled, deal with lockers, timetables and orientate themselves in the building.

School Chaplain

The role of the school Chaplain is one of caring for the spiritual needs of the whole school community. The Chaplain provides an open door where those in our school community and their families can come and receive support in a confidential and safe way.

Guidance and Counselling

Our Guidance Counsellors work with our students in a supportive role throughout their secondary education. Students are provided with the knowledge and resources to research career options open to them as well as being offered on-going support with educational and personal issues.
