Behavior Policy Form

The ASEP Program is available to all students selected through our prescreening process regardless of race, gender, or economic background. Because of this, all children must adhere to the behavior policy, a well-planned program with a positive and supportive atmosphere for children to maximize good student behavior. We use problem-solving techniques, with logical consequences when corrective measures must be taken.

Parental involvement is strongly encouraged. All efforts will be made to contact the parent/ guardian to discuss any behavioral issues. Please keep contact information current throughout the year and speak with the project manager about your child (ren).

Below are the procedures taken to handle behavior problems/ issues? Students may be removed from the program for poor attendance and disruptive behavior. At the discretion of the project manager, any **action step can be skipped** depending on the severity of the behavior problem/ issue, (i.e. fighting, constant disrespect, dress code non compliance, etc.)
