Celebrating America's 250th in Guernsey County

The Historic National Road – Guernsey County

Travel the route that helped build a nation. The National Road, America's first federally funded highway, runs through the heart of Guernsey County—linking early pioneers, commerce and communities. Today, this **All-American, National Scenic Byway** invites visitors to explore charming towns, historic architecture and the enduring spirit of westward expansion.

Guernsey County Courthouse

A striking centerpiece of downtown Cambridge, the **Guernsey County Courthouse** was completed in 1883 and features beautiful Second Empire architecture. Its clock tower and detailed stonework reflect the county's pride and prosperity—and during the holidays, it comes alive with a dazzling light show that draws visitors from near and far.

Mosser Glass

Carrying on Cambridge's rich glassmaking tradition, Mosser Glass has been producing handmade art glass since 1971. As the **only pressed glass factory in the United States**, Mosser blends time-honored

techniques with vibrant, modern designs. Visitors may take a free factory tour and watch skilled artisans bring this timeless craft to life.

Kennedy's Bakery

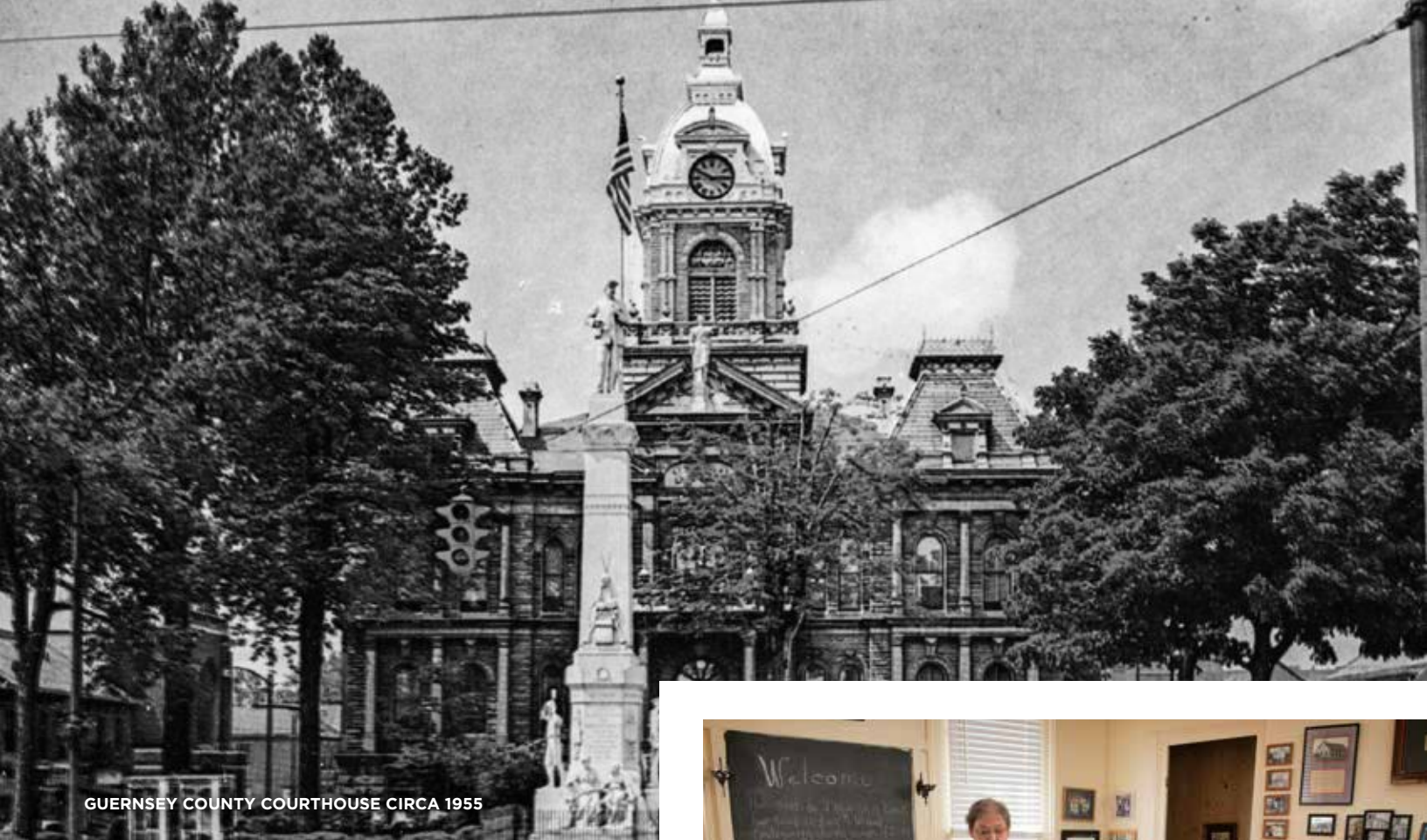

OUR STORY

Guernsey County: A Legacy of Heritage & Growth

Founded in 1810, Guernsey County takes its name from the Isle of Guernsey, the homeland of early settlers who brought their pioneering spirit to Ohio's frontier. Nestled along key routes like Zane's Trace and the National Road, the area quickly grew from dense forest to a thriving hub of coal mining, glassmaking and commerce.

Today, Guernsey County blends rich history with small-town charm—home to historic sites, scenic parks and cultural attractions. As we celebrate America's 250th anniversary, Guernsey County proudly honors its past while welcoming visitors to be part of its continuing story.

Guernsey County History Museum

Housed in an 1890s-era brownstone, the Guernsey County History Museum features 16 rooms filled with local artifacts, period furnishings and historic exhibits—including a one-room schoolhouse and a replica of a coal mine. It's a fascinating look at the people and industries that shaped Guernsey County.

PATRIOT PARK

Patriot Park in Byesville shines with a stunning mural honoring local heroes, a welcoming green space and annual events that celebrate community spirit. It's a heartfelt place to gather, reflect and enjoy small-town pride.

John Hunt Morgan Heritage Trail - Guernsey County

Follow the path of Confederate cavalry raider John Hunt Morgan through Guernsey County during his daring 1863 raid into Ohio. Interpretive markers trace his route through the area, where Union forces and local citizens played key roles in slowing his escape. It's a compelling glimpse into Civil War history—right where it happened.

National Museum of Cambridge Glass

Step into the shimmering legacy of one of America's finest glassmakers. The National Museum of Cambridge Glass showcases over 10,000 pieces produced by the renowned Cambridge Glass Company (1902-1958). Discover the artistry, craftsmanship and local pride behind the glass that once graced tables around the world—right here in Cambridge, Ohio.



ISLE OF GUERNSEY

Guernsey County takes its name from the Isle of Guernsey, homeland of the early settlers who brought their spirit to Ohio.

The Islands of Guernsey are a hidden gem. Situated just off the Normandy coast of France in the English Channel, Guernsey is just 65 square kilometers in size, which means there's nothing out of range during a stay, and there's lots going on.

As a beautiful archipelago of islands, there are not one but five to explore—Guernsey, Alderney, Herm, Sark, and Lihou—each naturally beautiful and wonderfully diverse. The islands are rich in history, natural beauty, and coastal allure. With their rugged cliffs, sandy beaches and quaint harbors, they offer a peaceful escape from the bustle of mainland life.

In Guernsey County, Ohio, the great outdoors isn't just scenery—it's an open invitation to adventure. With endless trails, shimmering lakes and unforgettable encounters, this is where life gives way to play, discovery and wide-open skies.

Start your journey at **Rocky Fork Ranch**, where rustic camping meets modern amenities. Canoe peaceful streams, test your aim at paintball or saddle up for a horseback ride across rolling hills.

For something truly wild, head to **The Wilds**, one of the nation's largest wildlife conservation centers and named one of the "10BEST" safari and wildlife parks by USA TODAY! Rhinos, giraffes and zebras roam pastures, while zipline tours add more thrills.

Cyclists, walkers and nature lovers will find joy on the **Great Guernsey Trail**—a 14-mile round-trip winding through woodlands and wetlands along a former rail line, that will be extending into downtown Cambridge. Families can dive into fun at **Deerassic Park Education Center**, home to interactive exhibits, live deer and the new Family Campground for RVs.

Craving lake life? **Seneca Lake** beckons with sandy beaches, boating, a kid friendly splash pad and some of the best fishing in Ohio. Nearby dining and sunsets make it unforgettable.

No trip is complete without visiting **Salt Fork State Park**, Ohio's largest. Swim, boat, hike or sled—this all-season escape blends adventure, relaxation and outdoor fun.

Guernsey County and its surrounding area casts a wide net for anglers of all skill levels.

At **Seneca Lake**, Ohio's third-largest inland lake, reel in bass, crappie, catfish and more. Launch your boat from one of several ramps or find a quiet spot along the shoreline.

Salt Fork State Park boasts a sprawling and scenic lake teeming with fish like bass, crappie, catfish and saugeye. Launch or rent a boat from the marina or join a guided fishing trip from area outfitters to discover the lake's hidden hotspots.

For a unique fishing experience head to **The Wilds**. Cast your line from Wilds-provided boats (only) or the bank in secluded ponds surrounded by exotic animals like zebras and giraffes, creating an unforgettable backdrop for your catch-and-release fishing adventure. (Note: an Ohio fishing license and reservations are required.)

Deerassic Park Educational Center offers a kid-friendly fishing pond where young anglers learn the basics and make lasting memories.

Rather learn about fish than catch them? Expand your knowledge of aquatic life at the **Senecaville Fish Hatchery** where you can learn about the process of raising fish for stocking Ohio's waterways.

Venture to the nearby **Jesse Owens Wildlife Area** where nearly 6,000 acres of diverse habitats offer prime fishing opportunities for bass, bluegill and more in peaceful ponds scattered throughout the area.

Be sure to check with local parks for information on upcoming fishing tournaments throughout the area including youth tournaments.
