- \$25 application fee as part of the online application process
- Official transcripts from your high school and any other higher education institutions you've attended
- Any ACT or SAT scores earned in the last five years*

Your application for admission also acts as your application for our renewable freshman academic scholarships. Complete your admission application before the priority date of Nov. 15 for the best chance at earning one.

COST & FINANCIAL AID

How much will an Austin Peay education cost?

To figure it out, you'll need to:

- Calculate the cost to attend.
- Learn how much financial aid you may receive.
- Apply for and estimate scholarship awards.

To start crunching the numbers, visit **apsu.edu/cost**.

Calculate the cost.

As you tally the cost to attend APSU, consider the following:

- Tuition.
- Program service fees.
- Books.
- Housing.
- Meal plans.
- Miscellaneous fees, such as coursework fees.

Apply for aid.

The Department of Education offers loans, grants and other types of financial aid to help fund your college education. Some types of aid must be repaid after you leave the University, and other types, like grants and work-study, do not.

Submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA), available in December, at **studentaid.gov** as soon as possible to learn how much and what kind of aid you are eligible to receive.

Take note!

- Don't hesitate to submit the FAFSA! You are not required to accept the aid offered to you. In fact, you'll have to let us know how much and what kinds of aid you want to accept.
- Do you expect to receive a **Tennessee Education Lottery Scholarship or Tennessee Promise?** Submit the FAFSA to be considered for these scholarships.
- The sooner you submit the FAFSA, the better! You'll need your – or your parents' – tax return information to complete the FAFSA, so file a tax return as soon as possible.

What careers interest me?

How many students will be in my classes?

Our average class size is 18 students, so you'll get to know your professors and your classmates.

Will my professors have time for me?

Will I be able to build a professional network?

Yes! Our academic and social student organizations offer plenty of opportunities to connect with professors, staff, alumni and classmates who can help you gain access to internships, jobs and other résumé-enhancing opportunities.

How will I stay on track to graduation?

At APSU, you'll have access to not only an academic adviser, but also the Degree Compass program we designed to help students map their path to graduation. Like Netflix recommends movies, this program will recommend classes in which you're most likely to succeed.

Can I earn my graduate degree at APSU?

Yes! In fact, some of our graduate programs can be completed in as few as 12 months. Depending on the program, you may be able to complete some graduate-level courses before you finish your bachelor's degree!
