AWS WORK EXPERIENCE

Project Name: **Investing in PayPal**

Students **analyzed PayPal's stock market value**. PayPal has remained at the forefront of the digital payment revolution for more than 20 years. Through their valuation and sensitivity analysis, the team argued that PayPal is in fact undervalued in the current stock market and hence, is worth investing in.

PERENNIAL WORK EXPERIENCE

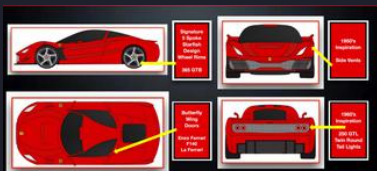
Project Name: **Investing in Coca Cola**

Students analyzed **Coca Cola's stock market value**. As Coca Cola is worth over \$250 billion USD, the team's analysis suggested that they are worth investing in. The team owed this decision to the brand being reputable and stable with expected growth in revenue and net income.



FERRARI WORK EXPERIENCE

Project Name: **Ferrari 523 Ravenna**



Students designed the Ferrari 523 Ravenna - **the first electric Ferrari**. The team opted for 5743 cells; 210kWh Solid State Battery that provides greater energy storage density, increased reliability and wear resistance, faster charging, and improved operational safety. This team's production elements were unmatched with the 523 Ravenna made to amplify motor sounds to create an authentic Ferrari sound. The team also employed digital modeling and were the only team to present a complete 3D rendering of the car.

UBER WORK EXPERIENCE

Project Name: **Uber Teens**

A **prototype** for a version of the Uber ride sharing app catered specifically to teenagers with a speedometer where the rider can limit their ride's speed. The speedometer also notifies parents when the ride goes above a certain speed.

AWS WORK EXPERIENCE

Project Name: **Forest Cover Type**

Partnering with Colorado State University to create a classification model that **predicts the forest cover type for Roosevelt National Forest** and later for all national forests in the US! The team utilized AWS Sagemaker, stored in S3 buckets, processed multiple algorithms and used ml.t2 to run algorithms.

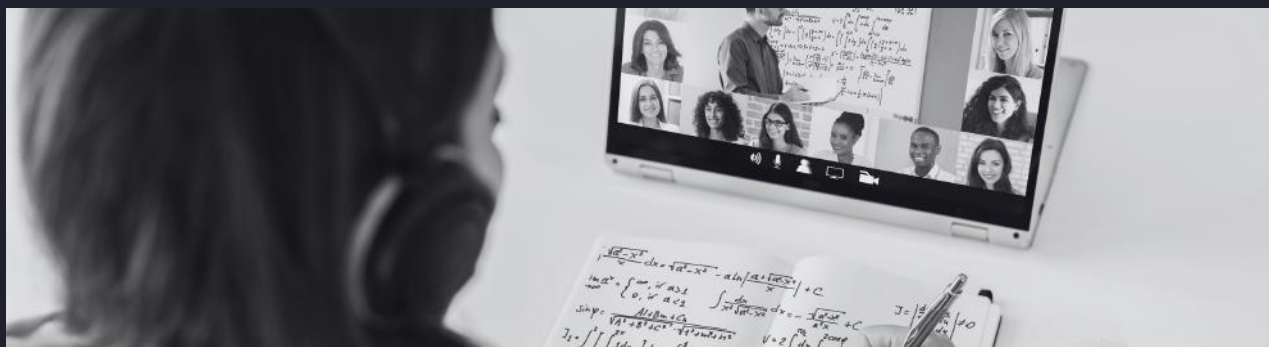


SPACE TECH WORK EXPERIENCE

Project Name: **Artemis Red**

Partnering with Icehouse Ventures in Space Tech to **design a descent system for a crewed mission to Mars**. The team analyzed Martian atmospheric conditions, terrain challenges, and propulsion efficiency, developing a proposal that integrates precision landing systems, aerodynamic drag reduction, and propellant management for safe, controlled descent.

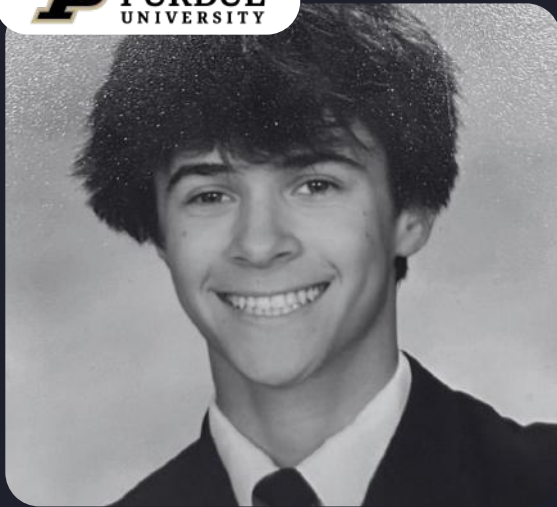
How personalized mentorship helps students build advanced, portfolio-ready projects

DEEPEN PROGRAM

Incoming **Mechanical Engineering** student
at **Purdue University**

“I find engineering extremely interesting, specifically the idea that I can bring my own ideas to life. I want to ask questions, get feedback, and see my ideas evolve from concept to execution.”

The project Connor worked on was the **Natural Disaster Imaging CubeSat**, a mission designed to demonstrate the feasibility of a small, low-cost satellite that could provide high-resolution imagery during natural disasters. The kind of imagery that helps response teams figure out where to go, what is flooded, where fires are spreading, and which roads are blocked.

Over the course of the programme, Connor worked through every major dimension of the mission. He defined orbital parameters, settling on a 500 to 600km altitude with a 95-minute orbital period and a 16-day repeat cycle, cross-referencing data from 10 real Earth observation missions including ALOS-2, COSMO-SkyMed, and the Atlantic Constellation.

Connor finished the programme with a mission portfolio that covers orbital mechanics, power system design, ground station network analysis, 3D CAD modelling, and a physical prototype. Skills that most students his age have never touched. He was accepted to five universities, including Virginia Tech, CU Boulder, UCF, San Jose State, and Purdue. He chose **Purdue to study Mechanical Engineering**, one of the strongest aerospace-adjacent programmes in the United States.

I feel like it gave me the opportunity to experience what it will be like to actually work in that industry. Deepen gave me a very valuable lesson in how to actually do the job."

Payton wanted to explore product management. Through hands-on exposure and mentorship, she gained clarity on the day-to-day responsibilities of a product manager, built a meaningful connection with an experienced mentor, and developed key skills such as cross-functional collaboration, user-centred thinking, and strategic decision-making. **This experience helped Payton take intentional steps toward a future career in product management.**

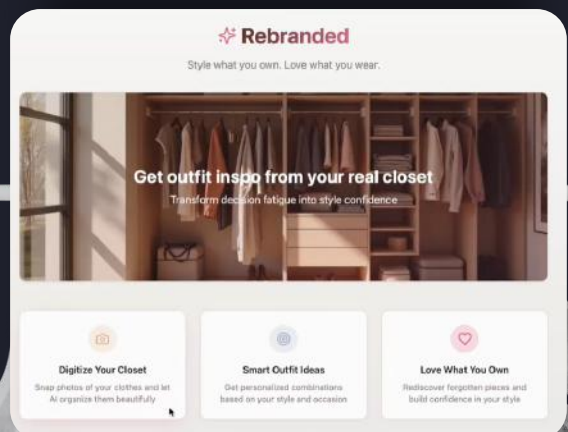
Payton developed an MVP that included a user journey and a demonstration video showcasing how it would be used. Her final project, **"Rebranded: Wardrobe — Taking Control of Your Own Wardrobe,"** focused on sustainability and personal ownership.

Together with TK, her mentor, she will continue exploring ways to make the product more scalable, **incorporating additional market research and considering how it could evolve into a real, sustainable business.** For example, the concept could be expanded into an app or website for a larger audience, such as clients at J.P. Morgan.

The experience helped me clarify my career interests within the sports industry and strengthened my confidence in pursuing opportunities in football management.”

Alongside the **LRO Athletic project**, Gala worked through the broader landscape of football business with Francisco. She studied **how clubs structure their revenue through broadcasting rights, sponsorships, and merchandise, and how regulatory frameworks like Financial Fair Play and Profitability and Sustainability Rules shape the decisions clubs can make**. She analysed real case studies on player branding and market positioning, and explored how data analytics and digital fan engagement are changing the commercial playbook for clubs at every level.

The core of the project was a three-year international expansion plan, starting the club in the Championship and charting a path to the Premier League while building a global brand. By Year 3, the plan targets three million international digital fans, two North American academies, 25 to 30 percent of commercial revenue from international markets, and at least one academy graduate established as a recognisable name in world football. The club's identity throughout is built on an academy-first philosophy, the belief that developing talent from within is not just ethically right but commercially sustainable.
