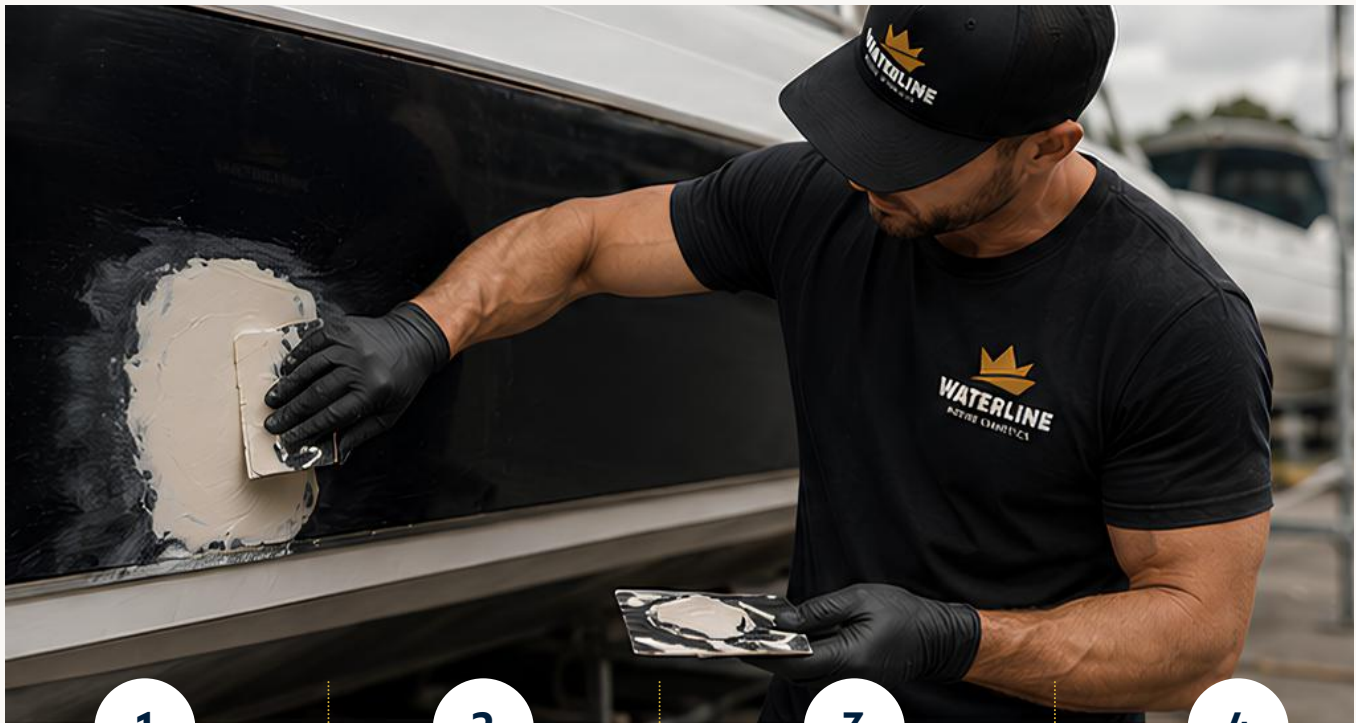

THE PROCESS

A CLEAN PROCESS BUILT AROUND ASSESSMENT, PREPARATION, REPAIR, AND FINISH.



Every Waterline project starts with a careful assessment. Before repair work begins, we review the damage, determine the materials required, and identify the best approach for restoring the surface properly. This helps set expectations clearly and ensures the repair is completed with the right method from the start.

ASSESSMENT

We inspect the damaged area, review the surrounding finish, and determine whether the repair is cosmetic, structural, or a combination of both. Photos, location, access, and boat condition are all considered before pricing and scheduling are finalized.

2

PREPARATION

The repair area is cleaned, protected, and prepared. Proper preparation is critical. This may include sanding, grinding, removing loose material, taping off surrounding surfaces, and creating a clean working area around the repair.

REPAIR & REBUILD

Depending on the damage, we rebuild the area using marine-grade materials. Fibreglass repairs may involve mat, resin, filler, shaping, and reinforcement, while gel coat repairs focus on filling, colour matching, layering, and surface correction.

BLEND & FINISH

Once the repair has cured, the area is shaped, sanded, blended, polished, and finished to restore a clean, consistent appearance. The goal is a repair that looks natural and professionally integrated with the surrounding surface.
