THE HISTORY OF MID-OHIO BIKEFEST

IT ALL STARTED WITH AN IDEA.

Five years ago, Mid-Ohio BikeFest wasn't even called Mid-Ohio BikeFest. It was simply a poker run in Lexington, Ohio, raising money for a local charity. The first year was humble—around 40 motorcycles, a beer truck, a food truck, and a handful of people who believed in the idea of bringing bikers together for a good cause.

A VISION TAKES SHAPE.

As the second year came to a close, Mike Seveigny looked at Jill Adams and Jason Rupp and said something that would change everything:

“ I THINK WE CAN MAKE THIS
SOMETHING REALLY SPECIAL.” ”

With the blessing of the two individuals who had organized those first two poker runs, we were entrusted with carrying the event forward. Then Mike made another prediction—he said the following year we'd have over 200 motorcycles. Jill laughed. She thought he was crazy. But instead of arguing, we got to work.



BIGGER THAN WE IMAGINED.

We started months earlier than ever before—meeting with local businesses, community leaders, sponsors, musicians, vendors, and volunteers. We planned a beautiful poker run, added live music, food trucks, a beer garden, raffles, and experiences that made the day feel like more than just another motorcycle event. When registration closed, Mike wasn't right—he was wrong. Because we didn't have 200 motorcycles. We had nearly 300. That was the moment we realized this event was becoming something much bigger than any of us had imagined.

A NEW HOME. A BIGGER PURPOSE.

The event had outgrown its home in Lexington, making a move to Downtown Mansfield a natural next step. It wasn't just about having more room—it was about creating an event that belonged to the entire community. Local businesses once again rallied behind the vision. Sponsors stepped forward. Volunteers showed up.



EXPANDING THE EXPERIENCE.

As we planned the following year, we asked ourselves one question: How do we make this event something the entire community can enjoy? Our friends at Richland Carrousel Park were no longer continuing the KidsFest they had successfully hosted before COVID. We saw an opportunity to bring that beloved event back while expanding BikeFest into something families could enjoy together.



STRONGER TOGETHER.

Challenges came—storms that cut our day short, and even the unexpected news that the charity who previously operated the event could no longer continue. But challenges don't define us. They motivate us. That's when we made another decision: we founded Mid-Ohio BikeFest, Inc. as an independent 501(c)(3) nonprofit, ensuring this event—and its mission—would continue for generations to come.

From 40 motorcycles to nearly 300... from a simple poker run to a festival that brings thousands together...

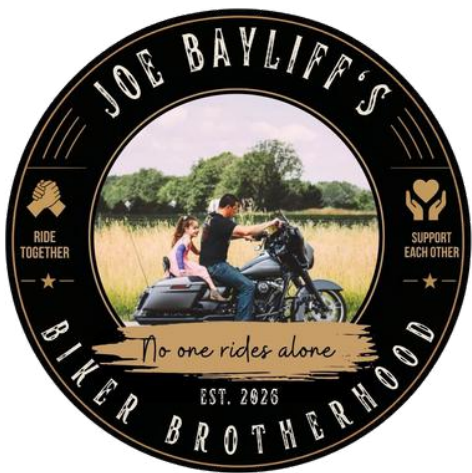

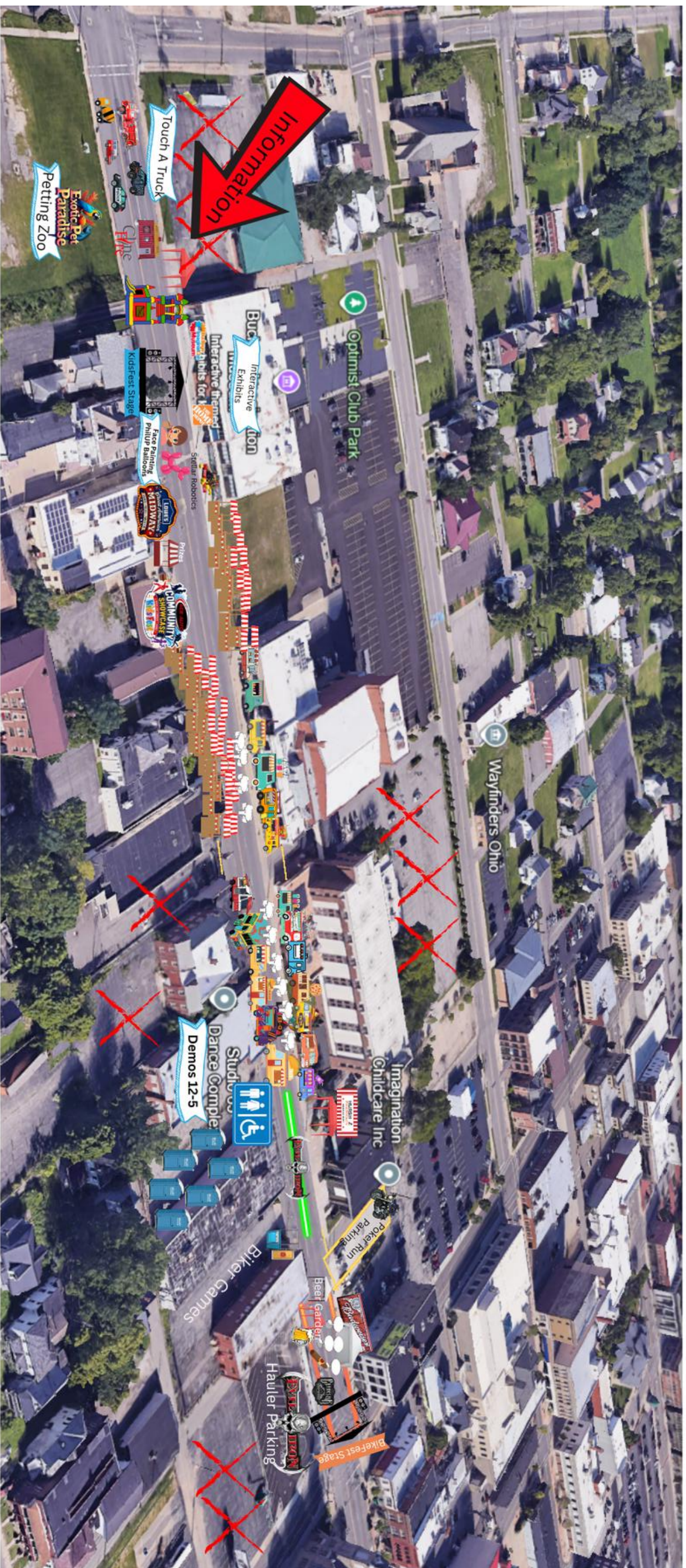

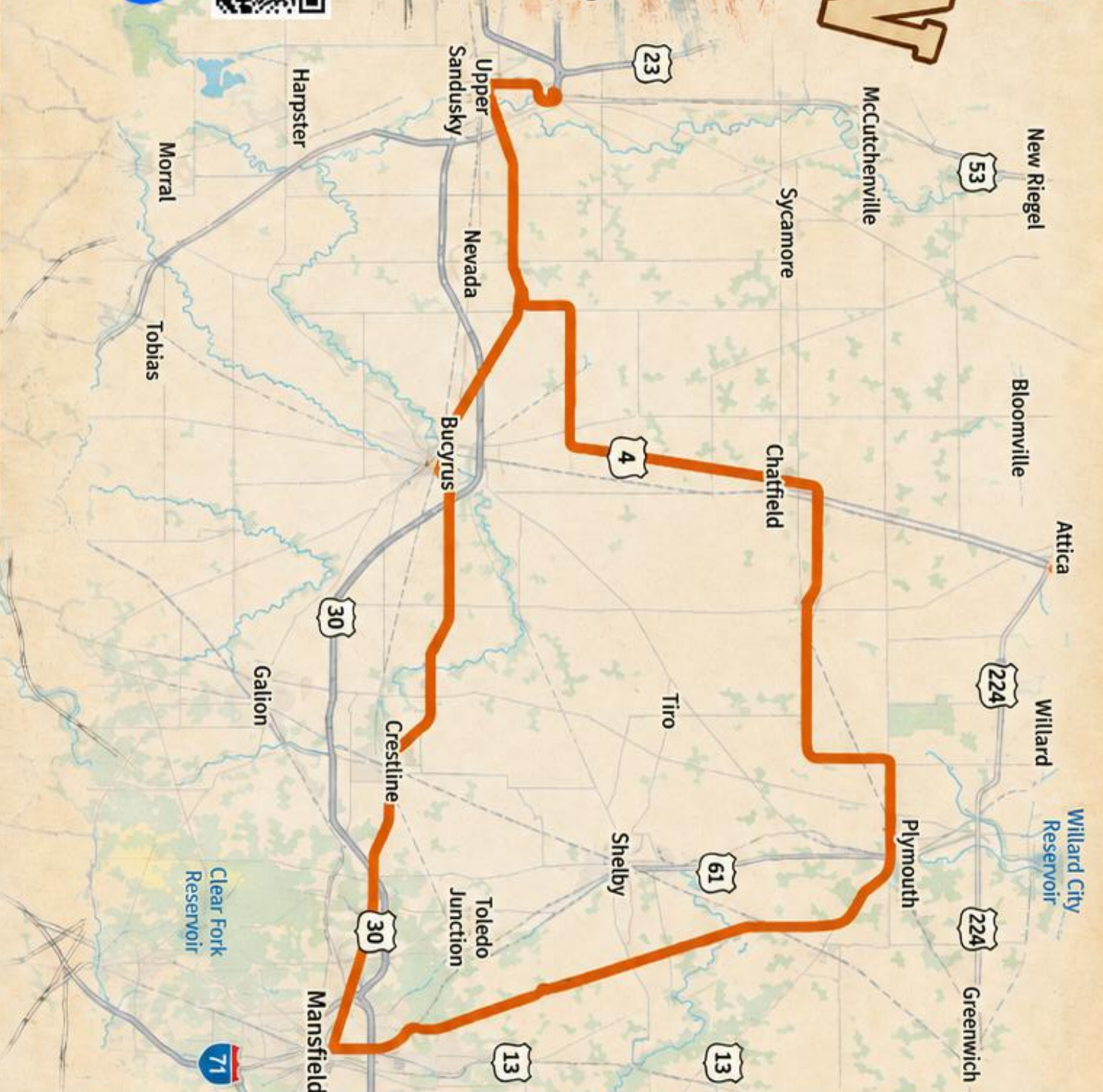

PARKING:
