

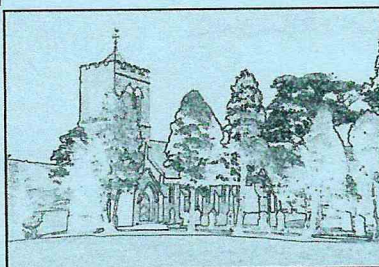

Dear Friends,

Lying in a hot tub lazily reading a good book, glass of something to hand Lovely!

In September I hope to be licensed as a Lay Reader in Carlisle diocese and, although the hot tub, may be an attractive proposition, it doesn't describe the nature of what I am about! I won't be reading in a horizontal position (!) but will be recognised by the church as having an authentic calling and ministry as a lay person.

My own calling, over 30 years ago was, first and foremost, a call to preach and teach which led me to Lay Reader training and then licensing in Durham cathedral. The words of the prophet Jeremiah summed up my own feelings at that time, 'But if I say, "I will not mention him or speak any more in his name," his word is in my heart like a burning fire, shut up in my bones. I am weary of holding it in; indeed I cannot.'

Some years ago Lavinia Byrne wrote a book about the pioneer missionary women in the 19th and 20th century who had achieved so much. One woman, Mildred Cable, found herself one day in a remote village in China, faced with a very young girl, whose behaviour suggested that she was demon-possessed. Mildred knew that only priests dealt with exorcisms and she was a lay woman on her own. In that situation, she said, she remembered 'the mighty ordination of the pierced hands' and she felt able to pray for the girl.

Those words struck me greatly, pointing, as they do, to the fact that if we have personally encountered the one 'whose hands were pierced' on the cross, then we have also been 'set aside' by God for a particular task in his church. In this season of Pentecost perhaps we could reflect on what God is calling us to do and be assured that his Holy Spirit will supply us with all that we need.

Getting to know Jesus better...

This month we are finishing Mark chapter 13 and beginning chapter 14, where we start to read the section in Mark that is all about Jesus death and everything that leads up to it
New Living Translation of the Bible - Notes by Matt Rich

34 "The coming of the Son of Man can be illustrated by the story of a man going on a long trip. When he left home, he gave each of his slaves instructions about the work they were to do, and he told the gatekeeper to watch for his return. 35 You, too, must keep watch! For you don't know when the master of the household will return—in the evening, at midnight, before dawn, or at daybreak. 36 Don't let him find you sleeping when he arrives without warning. 37 I say to you what I say to everyone: Watch for him!"

In this story Jesus is the "man who has gone on a long trip" but who is coming back to the earth one day. We are the "slaves" who have been given instructions in His Bible about how He wants us to live. One of those instructions is that we are to make sure we are living lives that show we are ready for Him to return at any time. Sometimes it is useful to ask ourselves the question, if Jesus came back now and I was doing this, watching this, reading this, thinking this, would I be happy or ashamed? Are you ready? Are you following Him? Are you watching for His return?

Mark 14

It was now two days before Passover and the Festival of Unleavened Bread. The leading priests and the teachers of religious law were still looking for an opportunity to capture Jesus secretly and kill him. 2 "But not during the Passover celebration," they agreed, "or the people may riot."

The reason that they didn't want to capture Jesus during the Passover was because He was very popular with the average person - these people liked what He said, they liked what He did and they liked that He mixed with them and showed them that He cared about them.

3 Meanwhile, Jesus was in Bethany at the home of Simon, a man who had previously had leprosy.

While he was eating, a woman came in with a beautiful alabaster jar of expensive perfume made from essence of nard. She broke open the jar and poured the perfume over his head. 4 Some of those at the table were indignant. "Why waste such expensive perfume?" they asked. 5 "It could have been sold for a year's wages and the money given to the poor!" So they scolded her harshly. 6 But Jesus replied, "Leave her alone. Why criticise her for doing such a good thing to me? 7 You will always have the poor among you, and you can help them whenever you want to. But you will not always have me. 8 She has done what she could and has anointed my body for burial ahead of time. 9 I tell you the truth, wherever the Good News is preached throughout the world, this woman's deed will be remembered and discussed."

10 Then Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve disciples, went to the leading priests to arrange to betray Jesus to them. 11 They were delighted when they heard why he had come, and they promised to give him money. So he began looking for an opportunity to betray Jesus.

People didn't normally recover from leprosy so it is probably specifically mentioned because he was someone who Jesus had healed at some point

Jesus wasn't upset or angry that this lady had wasted a lot of money that could have been used to help people in need. Jesus really appreciated what she had done for Him - this was something that was only normally reserved for the very wealthy, it was an extreme luxury to use that amount of perfume on someone. As Jesus is really the ruler of the whole universe it was actually very appropriate to do this to Jesus! Jesus knew that it was nearly time for Him to be killed. We need to remember that this was the big plan that He had - the whole reason that He had come to this earth in the first place was not just to be nice to people, heal people and show them a new way to live - He had come to die in their place so they could go free.
